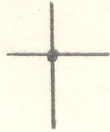

BISHOP COUNTY.

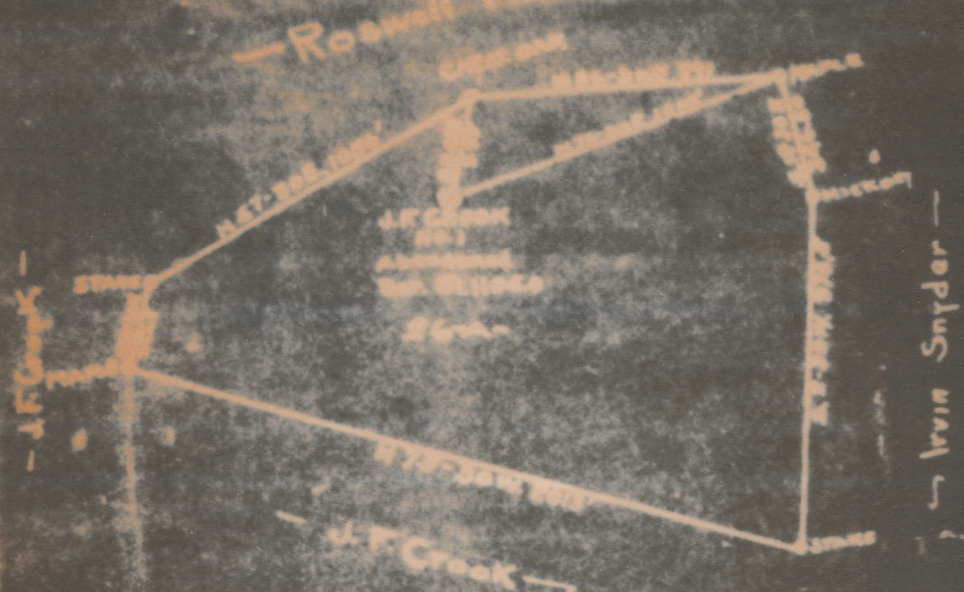

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by W. Va. Production Co., well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 20 day of January, 1934, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged: Well was cased from packer to 1340' parted tubing at 1340'. Placed plug 1340 - 1337 and cemented to 1327. Filled with red clay to 1100, placed plug and cemented to 1037. Removed a 1/4" casing and filled to surface with clay. There was no water in any of the sands above casing point.
