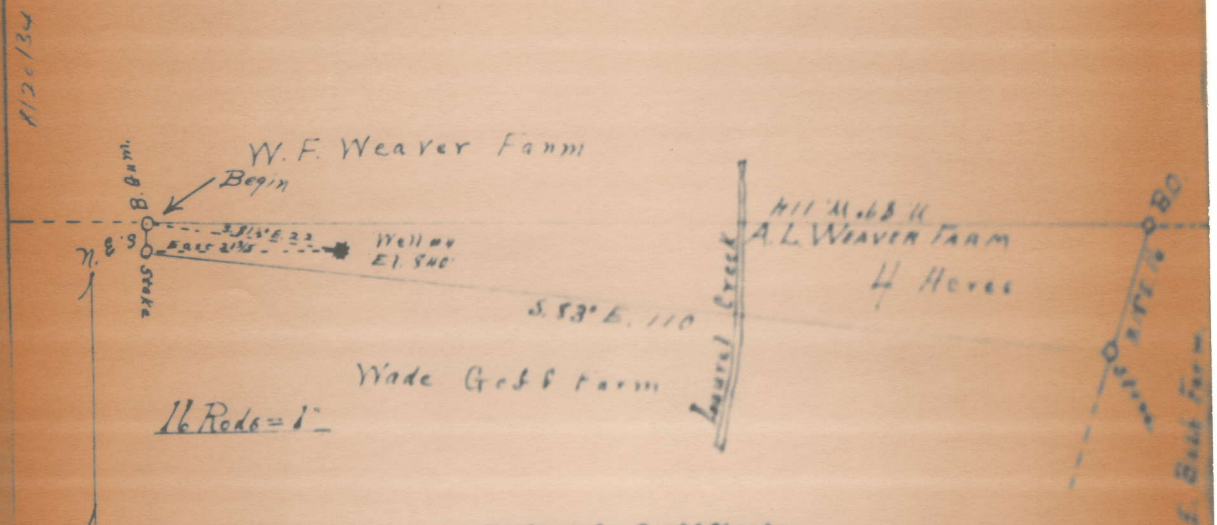

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by T. C. Zinn, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 21st day of August, 19 34, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which said well was plugged:  
Filled the hole from 1734' with red clay to 1632' drove wood plug from 1632 to 1629', cemented from 1629' to 1619', filled with Clay 1619 to 1057', Drove wood Plug from 1057' to 1054' Cemented 1054' to 1044'  
Filled with red Clay from 1044 to 950', Drove wood plug from 950' to 947', filled with red Clay from 947' to 937', Permanent bridge at 260', and filled to surface with red Clay.

Erected a Marker such as described in rule #18,1931 Regulations  
All done in workman like manner.

Made out of Casing and Cement.
