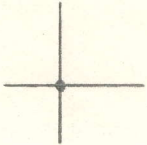

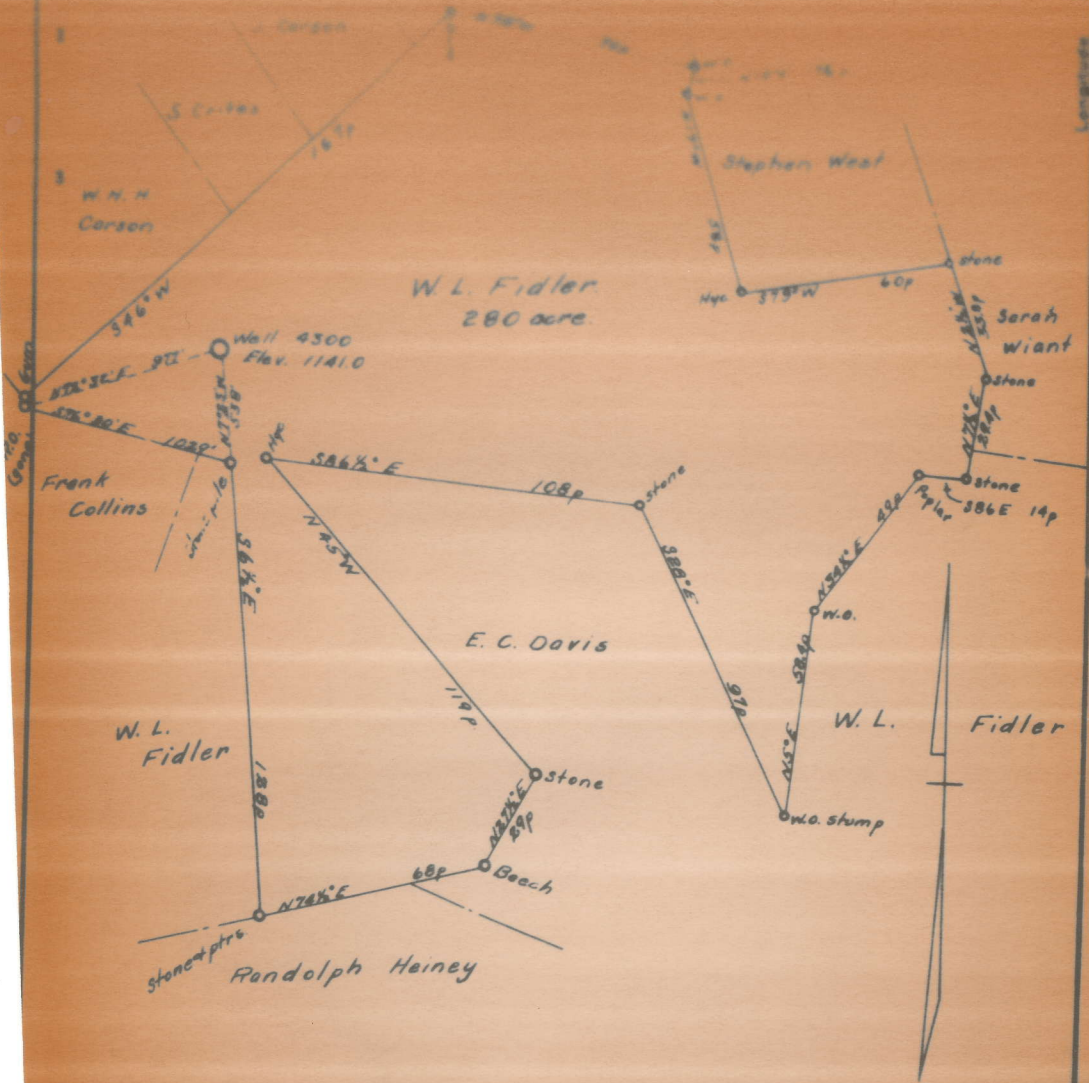

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by F. S. Daam, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 2nd day of June, 1936 and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged: Filled with clay 1980 to 1760
drove wooden plug 1760 to 1757;
poured cement plug 1747 to 1726; PULLED 1726' 6 5/8" casing;
filled with clay 1726 to 1090; drove wooden plug 1090 to 1087;
cement seal plug 1087 to 1077; Parted 8 1/2" casing at 580' was
unable to get the balance; Filled with clay 1077 to 246;
cement seal plug 246 to 196; filled with clay to the surface and
erected marker as described below.

Manner in which coal was plugged:

Description of monument: Set piece of casing filled with cement in the ground so as to extend 30" above and inscribed the following:
J.S. #4300 PSD 6/9/36
