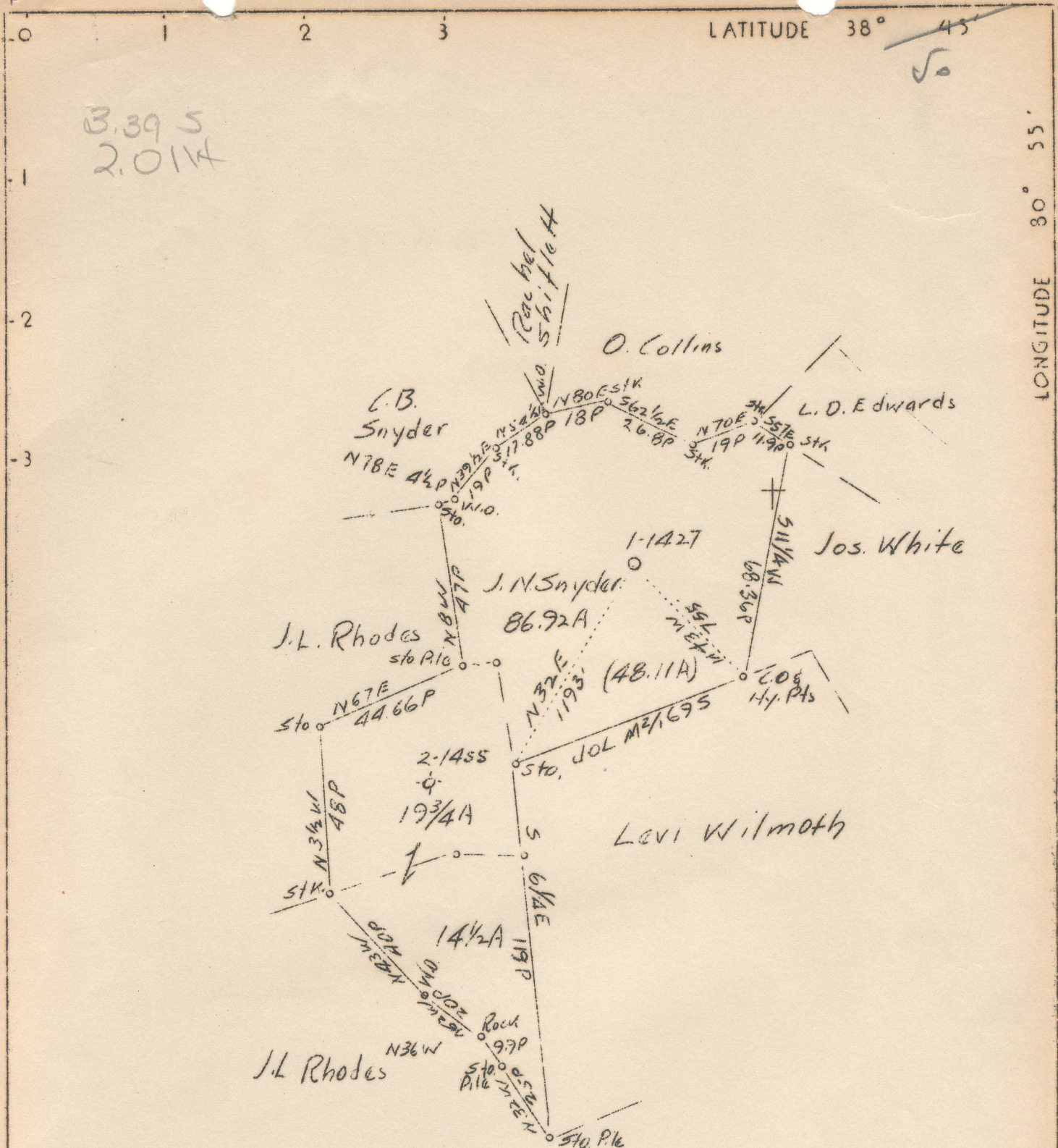

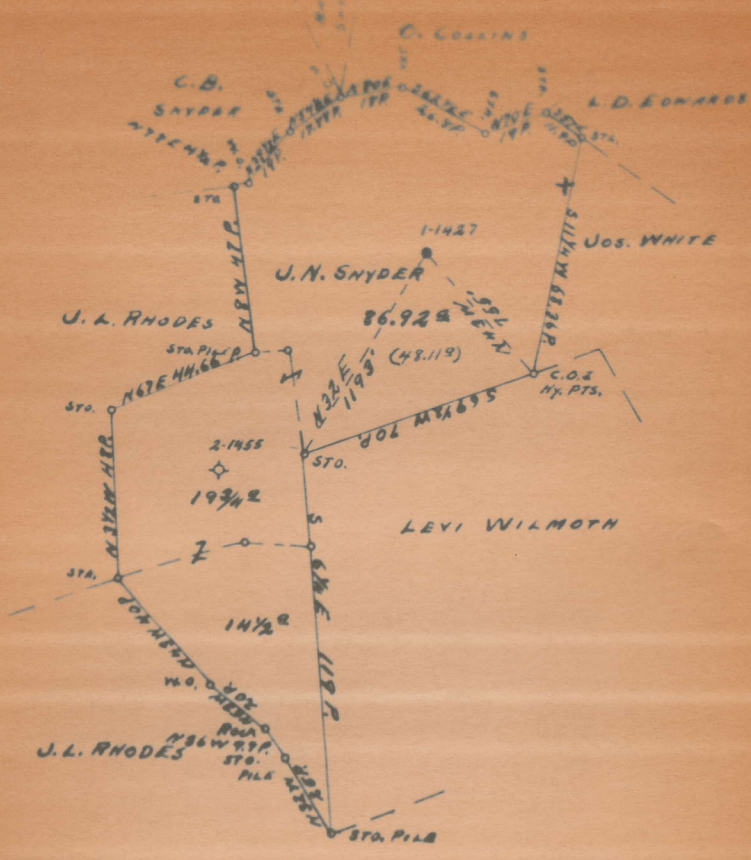

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging

and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Carnegie Natural Gas Company, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the

12th day of June, 1937, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which said well was plugged: Total depth of well - 1848'

Pulled 1867' of 2" Tubing.

Filled with clay to 1848' - Set 6 1/2" Wood Plug at 1848' to 1845' and filled with cement from 1845' to 1838' - Sealing Waxen Sand.

Pulled 6 1/2" Casing - Set at 1838'

Filled with clay from 1838' to 1810' Set 8 1/2" Wood Plug from 1810' to 1807'

Filled with cement from 1807' to 1797' - Sealing Waxen Sand.

Filled with clay from 1797' to 1244' - Drove 8 1/2" Wood Plug from 1244' to 1240' & filled with cement from 1240' to 1244'

Filled with clay from 1244' to 779' - Drove 8 1/2" Wood Plug from 779' to 775' and filled with cement from 775' to 766'.

Pulled 8 1/2" Casing - Set at 769' - Filled with clay from 766' to 120'

Drove 10" Wood Plug from 126' to 123' and put 1-bag cement on top of plug.

Pulled 10" Casing - Set at 116'

Filled with clay from 120' to surface. Gas would not light when plugging was completed.

Description of monument: Concrete Marker - 15" base - 10" Top - 2' High with Brass Tag showing well number secured in Marker.
