Notification shall be given by the operator to the Oil and Gas Inspector at least 24 hours prior to the construction of roads, locations, and/or pits for any permitted work. In addition, the well operator shall notify the same inspector 24 hours before any actual well work is commenced and prior to running and cementing casing. Spills or emergency discharges must be promptly reported by the operator to 1-800-642-3074 and to the Oil and Gas Inspector.

Please be advised that form WR-35, Well Operators Report of Well Work is to be submitted to this office within 90 days of completion of permitted well work, as should form WR-34 Discharge Monitoring Report within 30 days of discharge of pits, if applicable. Failure to abide by all statutory and regulatory provisions governing all duties and operations hereunder may result in suspension or revocation of this permit and, in addition, may result in civil and/or criminal penalties being imposed upon the operators.

PERMIT CONDITIONS

West Virginia Code § 22-6A-8(d) allows the Office of Oil and Gas to place specific conditions upon this permit. Permit conditions have the same effect as law. <u>Failure to adhere to the specified permit</u> conditions may result in enforcement action.

CONDITIONS

- 1. This proposed activity may require permit coverage from the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE). Through this permit, you are hereby being advised to consult with USACE regarding this proposed activity.
- 2. If the operator encounters an unanticipated void, or an anticipated void at an unanticipated depth, the operator shall notify the inspector within 24 hours. Modifications to the casing program may be necessary to comply with W. Va. Code § 22-6A-5a (12), which requires drilling to a minimum depth of thirty feet below the bottom of the void, and installing a minimum of twenty (20) feet of casing. Under no circumstance should the operator drill more than one hundred (100) feet below the bottom of the void or install less than twenty (20) feet of casing below the bottom of the void.
- 3. When compacting fills, each lift before compaction shall not be more than 12 inches in height, and the moisture content of the fill material shall be within limits as determined by the Standard Proctor Density test of the actual soils used in specific engineered fill, ASTM D698, Standard Test Method for Laboratory Compaction Characteristics of Soil Using Standard Effort, to achieve 95 % compaction of the optimum density. Each lift shall be tested for compaction, with a minimum of two tests per lift per acre of fill. All test results shall be maintained on site and available for review.
- 4. Operator shall install signage per § 22-6A-8g (6) (B) at all source water locations included in their approved water management plan within 24 hours of water management plan activation.
- 5. Oil and gas water supply wells will be registered with the Office of Oil and Gas and all such wells will be constructed and plugged in accordance with the standards of the Bureau for Public Health set forth in its Legislative rule entitled *Water Well Regulations*, 64 C.S.R. 19. Operator is to contact the Bureau of Public Health regarding permit requirements. In lieu of plugging, the operator may transfer the well to the surface owner upon agreement of the parties. All drinking water wells within fifteen hundred feet of the water supply well shall be flow tested by the operator upon request of the drinking well owner prior to operating the water supply well.
- 6. Pursuant to the requirements pertaining to the sampling of domestic water supply wells/springs the operator shall, no later than thirty (30) days after receipt of analytical data provide a written copy to the Chief and any of the users who may have requested such analyses.
- 7. 24 hours prior to the initiation of the completion process the operator shall notify the Chief or his designee.
- 8. During the completion process the operator shall monitor annular pressures and report any anomaly noticed to the chief or his designee immediately.
- 9. If any explosion or other accident causing loss of life or serious personal injury occurs in or about a well or well work on a well, the well operator or its contractor shall give notice, stating the particulars of the explosion or accident, to the oil and gas inspector and the Chief, within 24 hours of said accident.
- 10. During the casing and cementing process, in the event cement does not return to the surface, the oil and gas inspector shall be notified within 24 hours.

ORDER ISSUED UNDER WEST VIRGINIA CODE, CHAPTER 22, ARTICLE 6A

INTRODUCTION

This Order (hereinafter "Order") is issued by the Office of Oil and Gas (hereinafter "OOG"), by and through its Chief, pursuant to the authority of W. Va. Code §§ 22-1-1, 22-6-1 and 22-6A-1 et seq. to Mountaineer Keystone, LLC (hereinafter "Operator"), collectively the "Parties."

FINDINGS OF THE CHIEF

In support of this Order, the Chief hereby finds the following:

- 1. OOG, an office within the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, is the agency with the duty and authority to execute and enforce W. Va. Code §22-6-1 and §22-6A-1 et seq., and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder.
- 2. Mountaineer Keystone, LLC is a "person" as defined by W. Va. Code §22-6-1(n), with a corporate address as 6031 Wallace Road Extension, Suite 300, Wexford, Pennsylvania.
- 3. On December 8, 2016 Mountaineer Keystone, LLC submitted well work permit applications identified as API#s 47-033-05885, 47-033-05886, 47-033-05887 and 47-033-05888. The proposed wells are to be located on the Goff 5-55 Pad in Clark District of Harrison County, West Virginia.
- 4. On December 1, 2016, Mountaineer Keystone, LLC requested a waiver for Wetlands WL 5, WL 6, WL 7, WL 10, WL 11, WL 17, WL 18 and WL 19 outlined in Attachment 1, from well location restriction requirements in W. Va. Code §22-6A-12(b) for the well work permit applications identified as API#s 47-033-05885, 47-033-05886, 47-033-05887 and 47-033-05888. Wetlands WL 18 and WL 19 are excluded from the waiver.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. West Virginia Code §22-1-6(d) requires, in part, that "[i]n addition to other powers, duties and responsibilities granted and assigned to the secretary by this chapter, the secretary is authorized and empowered to...(3) Enter private lands to make surveys and inspections for environmental protection purposes; to investigate for violations of statutes or rules which the Office of Oil and Gas is charged with enforcing; to serve and execute warrants and processes; to make arrests; issue orders, which for the purposes of this chapter include consent agreements; and to otherwise enforce the statutes or rules which the Office of Oil and Gas is charged with enforcing."
- 2. West Virginia Code §22-6A-2(a)(6) requires, in part, that "Concomitant with the broad powers to condition the issuance of well work permits, the secretary should also have broad authority to waive certain minimum requirements of this article when, in his or her discretion, such waiver is appropriate: *Provided*, That the secretary shall submit a written report of the number of waivers granted to the Legislature commencing January 1, 2013, and each year thereafter."
- 3. West Virginia Code §22-6A-12(b) requires, in part, that "[n]o well pad may be prepared or well drilled within one hundred feet measured horizontally from any perennial stream, natural or artificial lake, pond or reservoir, or a wetland, or within three hundred feet of a naturally reproducing trout stream. No well pad may be located within one thousand feet of a surface or ground water intake of a public water supply. The distance from the public water supply as identified by the Office of Oil and Gas shall be measured as follows: (1) For a surface water intake on a lake or reservoir, the distance shall be measured from the boundary of the lake or reservoir. (2) For a surface water intake on a flowing stream, the distance shall be measured from a semicircular radius extending upstream of the surface water intake. (3) For a groundwater source, the distance shall be measured from the wellhead or spring. The Office of Oil and Gas may, in its discretion, waive these distance restrictions upon submission of a plan identifying sufficient measures, facilities or practices to be employed during well site construction, drilling and operations to protect the waters of the state. A waiver, if granted, shall impose any permit conditions as the secretary considers necessary."

ORDER

West Virginia Code §22-6A-12(b) requires, in part, that "[n]o well pad may be prepared or well drilled within one hundred feet measured horizontally from any perennial stream, natural or artificial lake, pond or reservoir, or a wetland. The Office of Oil and Gas grants the request for a waiver for Wetlands WL 5, WL 6, WL 7, WL 10, WL 11 and WL 17 from well location restriction requirements in W. Va. Code §22-6A-12(b) for the well work permit applications identified as API#s 47-033-05885, 47-033-05886, 47-033-05887 and 47-033-05888. The Office of Oil and Gas hereby **ORDERS** that Mountaineer Keystone, LLC shall meet the following site construction and operational requirements for the Goff 5-55 Well Pad:

- a. A berm shall be constructed around the perimeter of the pad to contain any potential spills and storm water runoff. Berm is to be at least twenty-four inches (24") in height;
- b. Erosion control blankets shall be installed on all slopes and down gradient locations of the pad as erosion and sediment controlling BMPs;
- c. Wetland WL 5, WL 6, WL 7 and WL 17 are all at the top of the cut slope. Diversion ditches will be used to redirect excess water away from the pad.
- d. Wetland WL 10 and WL 11 are up slope from the access road adjoining the pad, road side ditches will redirect any water from the road down slope away from the wetland.
- e. Disturbed areas not used for operations shall be seeded and mulched per the seeding tables in the WVDEP-OOG Erosion and Sediment Control Manual;
- f. Drill cuttings and associated drilling mud shall be disposed of in a permitted landfill;
- g. Waste generated by the flowback treatment systems shall be sent to offsite disposal at a permitted landfill;
- h. Weekly site inspections shall be conducted to monitor and maintain the integrity of the BMP storm water controls;
- i. Weekly storm water and spill prevention inspections shall be conducted focusing on storm water and spill prevention BMPs and maintenance of these BMPs;
- j. Inspections of the storm water and spill prevention measures shall be conducted after any major storm event defined as a half inch (½") rain within any twenty-four (24) hour period;
- k. Pad inspections shall be conducted no less than once a week to identify and mitigate potential deficiencies;
- l. All records from inspections shall be maintained on site for the life of the project and be available upon request.

This waiver shall be requested pursuant to Chapter 22 Article 6A Section 12 of West Virginia Code, which states:

§22-6A-12(b) No well pad may be prepared or well drilled within one hundred feet measured horizontally from any perennial stream, natural or artificial lake, pond or reservoir, or a wetland, or within three hundred feet of a naturally reproducing trout stream. No well pad may be located within one thousand feet of a surface or ground water intake of a public water supply. The distance from the public water supply as identified by the department shall be measured as follows:

- (1) For a surface water intake on a lake or reservoir, the distance shall be measured from the boundary of the lake or reservoir.
- (2) For a surface water intake on a flowing stream, the distance shall be measured from a semicircular radius extending upstream of the surface water intake.
- (3) For a groundwater source, the distance shall be measured from the wellhead or spring.

The department may, in its discretion, waive these distance restrictions upon submission of a plan identifying sufficient measures, facilities or practices to be employed during well site construction, drilling and operations to protect the waters of the state. A waiver, if granted, shall impose any permit conditions as the secretary considers necessary.

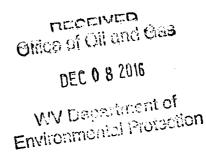

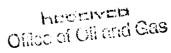

- 1. Describe the proposed project location, including unique identifying names of all wetlands, and the names of perennial streams for which the waiver is sought.
 - a. The proposed Goff 5-55 site is located on the waters of unnamed tributaries of the West Fork River in Clark District, Harrison County being on the south side of U.S. Route 19 being .72 miles southwest of the intersection of W.V. State Route 98 and U.S. Route 19 near Clarksburg, WV. The site consists of a gas well pad, 3 excess material stockpiles, one topsoil stockpile, and an associated pit. The pad site is located on the edge of a reclaimed coal strip mine where most of the wetlands and streams have originated. As shown on the plans, there are a total of 8 individual wetlands that are proposed to be impacted within 100 feet of the well pad LOD. These wetlands include WL 5, WL 6, WL 7, WL 10, WL 11, WL 17, WL 18, & WL 19. No perennial streams were delineated or proposed to be impacted for this site.
- 2. Justify the proposed activity by describing alternatives to this project that were considered.
 - a. Include a No-Action Alternative as to show "the future without the project"
 - i. The future of this site without this project would most likely continue as it is today. This site is a poorly reclaimed coal strip mine area and most likely would continue as such. However, being within a mile of Clarksburg and adjacent to U.S. Route 19 could prove to be ideal for some certain business ventures.
 - b. Location Alternatives must be shown
 - i. All areas in the vicinity of the well pad were thoroughly reviewed to determine that this area was the best area for construction, wetland and stream impact reduction, and avoidance of gas pipelines. Also avoided in this area, is the County Commission 1.27 acres that has historic value as it is known as the "Poor Farm" cemetery. Moving the well pad to the west would impact the "Poor Farm" cemetery and a Dominion gas pipeline. Moving the pad south would impact much more wetlands and a 12" gas pipeline. Moving the pad north would impact additional streams and Dominion gas pipelines. Moving the pad to the east would also impact more streams and Dominion gas pipelines. As shown on the attached map, our original spot for the was located south of where we show it now. This version would impact a large section of 12" gas pipeline but would also impact more wetlands.
 - c. Must demonstrate why a one hundred foot buffer cannot be maintained
 - i. As discussed in question one above, this site is an old poorly reclaimed coal strip mine that has many wetlands and streams that originate from excessive mine drainage. Due to the number of wetlands on this site, and avoiding the gaslines and the historic "Poor Farm" cemetery, there is no way to propose a feasible gas well pad without being within 100 feet or impacting wetlands or streams.

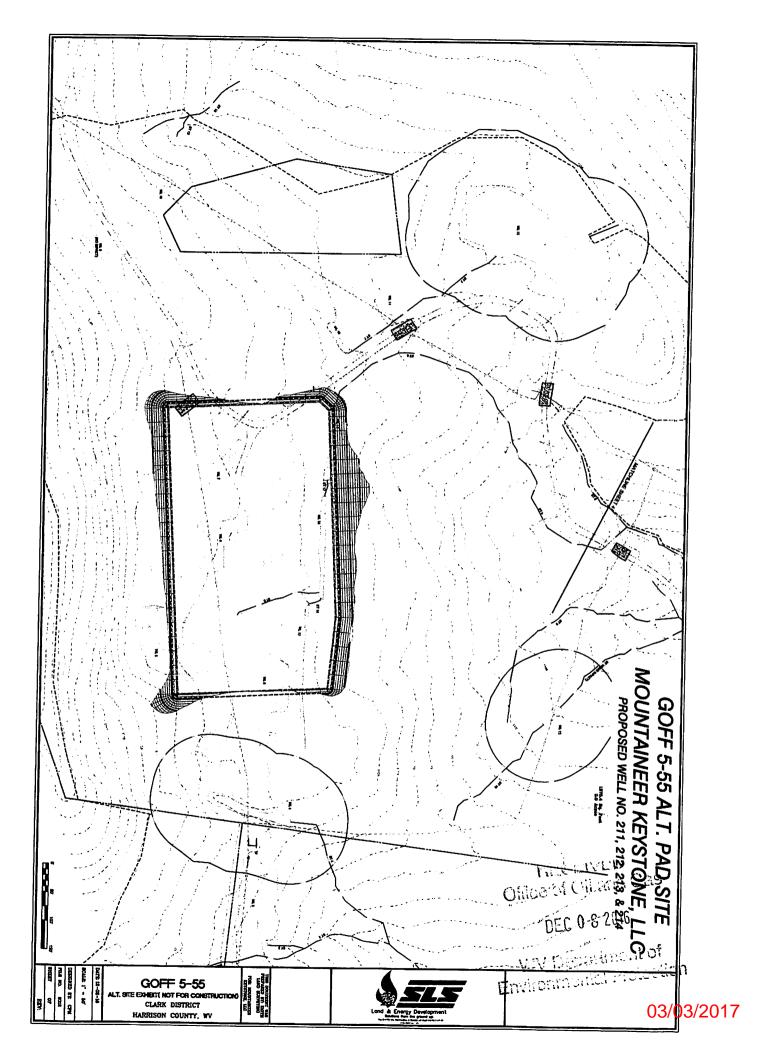


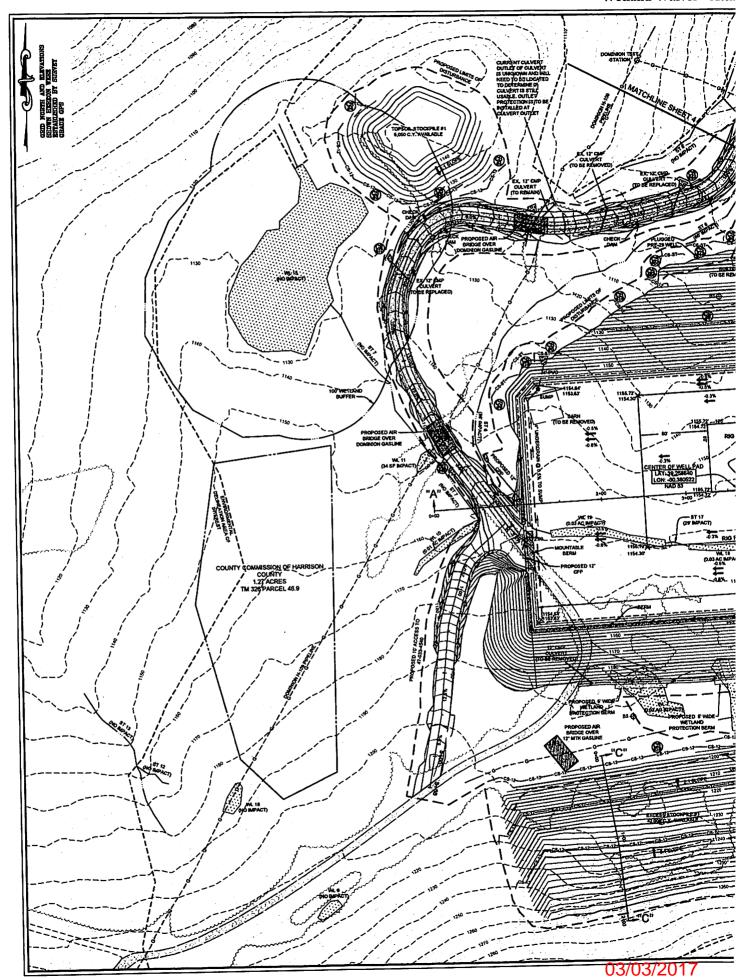
- d. Describe how the proposed project is the least environmentally damaging practicable alternative
 - i. As shown on the plans, the well pad is designed to impact as little wetlands and streams as possible. The pad is surrounded on the east and west by Streams ST 6 and ST 9. We have only partially impacted Wetlands WL 5, WL 6, WL 7, WL 10, WL 11, and WL 17. As shown on the plans, we have proposed wetland protection berms at the edge of wetland disturbance to avoid draining the wetlands.
- Identify sufficient measures, facilities or practices to be employed during well site
 construction, drilling and operations to protect the waters of the state. This description
 should include all additional erosion and sediment control measures and devices that well be
 used.
 - a. As shown on our plans, many measures were identified to ensure proper construction of this well pad along with sufficient erosion and sediment control. As you can see all culvert and keyway drains have proper outlet protection, all slopes greater than 3/1 shall have erosion control matting, all excess material stockpiles and fill slopes have keyways proposed with drainage in mind, all slopes are 2/1 or less, a diversion channel is proposed on the up-slope side of the well pad, and all disturbance is protected by sufficient compost filter sock recommendations. Also, please note the proper berms along with sumps with valves were proposed for this pad. During drilling these valves will remain closed to ensure protection from possible pollutants.
- 4. Provide mapping, plans, specifications and design analysis for the preferred alternatives to the project.
 - Specify in writing what additional controls, measures, devices, monitering, etc. will be used to protect these wetands and/or perennial streams for which the waiver is sought.
 - i. Please note that these plans have been reviewed and approved by all agencies. As shown on our plans and mentioned above, sufficient erosion and sediment controls will be installed. This includes sufficient "triple stack" compost filter sock, outlet protection on all culverts and key drains, rip rap diversion ditch on the upslope of the well pad. As shown on the plans, we have proposed wetland protection berms at the edge of wetland disturbance to avoid draining the wetlands. Please see sheet 2 of the site plan for compete construction standards, notes and sequence. See sheets 15-18 for construction details.

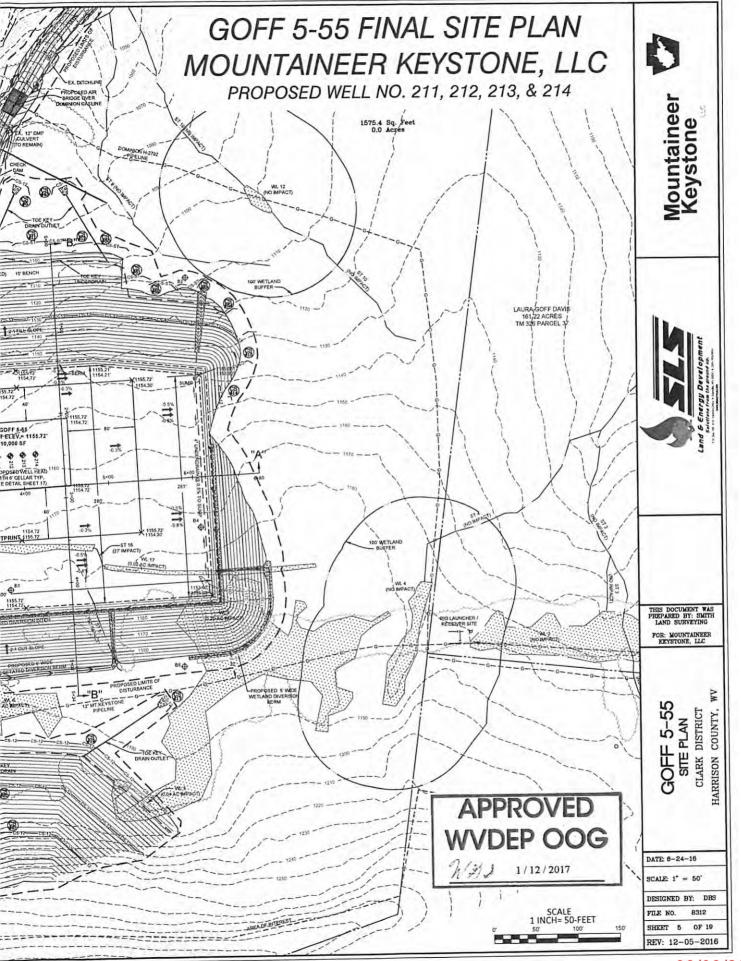

19) Describe proposed well work, including the drilling and plugging back of any pilot hole:

The well will be started with a conductor rig drilling a 36" hole to Conductor programmed depth then running 24" casing and grout cement back to surface. The conductor rig will move out and the drilling rig will move in and rig up. The drilling rig will then spud a 17 ½" hole and drill to fresh water casing (Surface) to the programmed depth, Run 13- 3/8" casing and cement to surface. The rig will continue drilling a 12-½" intermediate hole to the programmed depth, run 9- 5/8" casing and cement to surface. The rig with then continue to drill a 8- ¾" hole to a designed KOP and then start drilling the curve and lateral section to the programmed total measured depth, run 5 ½" casing and cement according to the program.

20) Describe fracturing/stimulating methods in detail, including anticipated max pressure and max rate:

The well will be completed using a plug and perforation method and stimulated with a slickwater and sand slurry. The anticipated maximum rate will be 90 bpm and the maximum pressure will be 9,500 psi.

21) Total Area to be disturbed, including roads, stockpile area, pits, etc., (acres): 23.05 acres

- 23) Describe centralizer placement for each casing string:

20"- No centralizers 13 3/8" – one bow spring centralizer on every other joint 9 5/8" – one bow spring centralizer every third joint from TD to surface 5 ½" – one semi rigid centralizer on every joint from TD of casing to end of curve. Then every other joint to KOP. Every third joint from KOP to 2,600'; there will be no centralizers from 2,600' to surface.

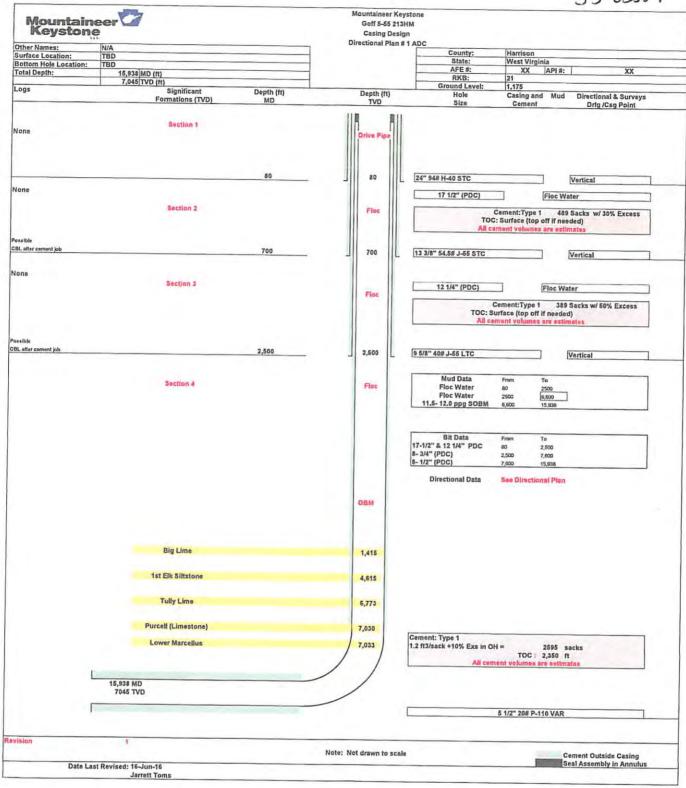

24" will be grouted from surface. The 13-3/8" casing will be cemented to surface with Class A cement and no greater than 3% CaCl (calcium chloride). The 9-5/8" casing will be cemented to surface with Type 1 cement, & no greater than 3% calcium chloride. The 5-1/2" production string will be cemented back to 2,350' (+/- 200' above the casing shoe for the 9-5/8") with Type 1 or Class A cement retarder (to extend pumpability) cellophane flaked for fluid loss, Bentonite gel as an extender (increased pumpability and fluid loss), a defoaming agent to decrease cement foaming during mixing to insure the cement is of proper weight to placement and possibly a gypsum gas blocking additive to aid in blocking/gas migration (in combination with other additive mentioned here, helps cement achieve a "right-angle" set) during the plastic phase of the cement set-up.

25) Proposed borehole conditioning procedures:

Top holes will be drilled with fresh water to KOP. At KOP, the wellbore will be loaded with synthetic oil based mud, barite-weighted mud system with such properties as to build a filter-cake on the face to the bore-hole. This will provide lubricity as well as stabilizing the well bore. We will begin rotating the drill string and mud will be circulated upon reaching TD until no further cuttings are observed coming across the shaker screens. Once clean mud is circulated back to surface, we will pull three stands of drill pipe, load the hole, pull three stands and load the hole. The weight indicator on the rig will be monitored for any occurrences of drag and if any are notices, we will re-run the previous stand file pulled across and circulate 2X bottoms up while watching the shakers for signs of cuttings. Once at the base of the curve, the string will be continuously rotated while pumping 2X bottoms up. We will pull three stands and fill the hole until we reach the vertical section of the well.

Purpose

The purpose of this pad-specific Hydraulic Fracturing Monitoring Plan is to identify and notify conventional well operators near Mountaineer Keystone hydraulic fracturing in Harrison County, WV prior to hydraulic fracturing at the following MK wells on the Goff 5-55 213 Pad.

Due to the apparent presence of unique geological conditions, the potential for communication between deep geologic zones exists in this area. This potential communication, via natural gas, water, or both, may occur between hydraulically fractured wells in the Marcellus formation (approximately 7,050'TVD) and existing conventional natural gas wells in the partially-depleted, relatively high permeability Benson formation (approximately 4,700' TVD).

The plan is being implemented as an additional safety measure to be utilized in conjunction with best management practices and emergency action plans for this site. These additional measures include pre-notification of conventional well operators of the timing and location of the hydraulic fracturing, establishment of measures conventional well operators should implement, and assurance that the Division of Oil and Gas is notified of the timeline, as well as any issues that may arise during fracturing.

1. Communications with Conventional Operators.

MK, using available data (WV Geological Survey, WVDEP Website, and IHS data service), has identified all known conventional wells and well operators within 500 feet of this pad and the lateral sections. A map showing these wells along with a list of the wells and operators is included in Attachment A.

Upon approval of this plan, MK will notify these operators, via letter, of the hydraulic fracturing schedule for these wells. A copy of this letter is included in Attachment B. The letter provides recommendations to these conventional operators to 1) increase their monitoring of their wells during that time period, 2) ensure that their well head equipment is sound, and 3) provide immediate notification to MK and the OOG in the event of any changes in their well conditions.

Specifically, the letter recommends that conventional well operators conduct the following activities during and after fracturing operations:

- 1. Inspect their surface equipment prior to fracturing to establish integrity and establish prefrac well conditions.
- 2. Observe wells closely during and after fracturing and monitor for abnormal increases in ED
- Inspect or install master valves rated to 3,000 psi or other necessary equipment for wellhead integrity.

2. Reporting

MK will provide information relating to the hydraulic fracturing schedule, communication with conventional operators, and ongoing monitoring of the work upon request of OOG or immediately after any event of any noted abnormalities.

Agreement to Drill, Complete and Operate Oil & Gas Wells

This Agreement to Drill, Complete and Operate Oil & Gas Wells (this "Agreement"), by and among Mountaineer Keystone LLC, a West Virginia limited liability company ("Mountaineer Keystone"), PDC Mountaineer, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("PDC"), and PDC Mountaineer Holdings, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("PDC Holdings"), is effective as of October 15, 2014. (the "Effective Date") and sets forth the terms pursuant to which Mountaineer Keystone will drill, complete and operate the Wells (as defined below) on behalf of PDC and PDC Holdings. Mountaineer Keystone, PDC, and PDC Holdings are each a "Party" and are collectively the "Parties". In consideration of the foregoing and the respective agreements hereinafter set forth and the mutual benefits to be derived therefrom, the Parties, intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Term: This Agreement is effective from the Effective Date until terminated by Mountaineer Keystone on the one hand or PDC and PDC Holdings on the other hand with 30 days' written notice to the other Party or Parties, as applicable (the "Term").
- 2. Authorization to Operate: PDC and PDC Holdings authorize Mountaineer Keystone to undertake and perform, on PDC and PDC Holdings behalf, all operations, including without limitation permit applications, well pad preparation, drilling and completing wells, and marketing gas, oil and other hydrocarbons therefrom with respect to all oil and gas wells to be drilled on oil and gas leasehold acreage held by PDC or PDC Holdings. PDC, PDC Holdings and Mountaineer Keystone are affiliates with a common parent. Mountaineer Keystone was formed to operate oil and gas leasehold acreage held by PDC, PDC Holdings and certain other affiliates. Mountaineer Keystone agrees that it shall, in a good and workmanlike manner and in accordance with industry standards as they prevail in the area, drill, complete and operate oil and gas wells on leasehold acreage owned by PDC or PDC Holdings from time to time as directed by PDC or PDC Holdings (collectively, the "Wells").
- 3. No Third Party Beneficiary: This Agreement is for the benefit of the Parties and is not for the benefit of any third party.
- 4. Counterparts: This Agreement may be simultaneously executed in several counterparts and via facsimile or similar electronic transmittal, each of which shall be deemed to be an original and taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

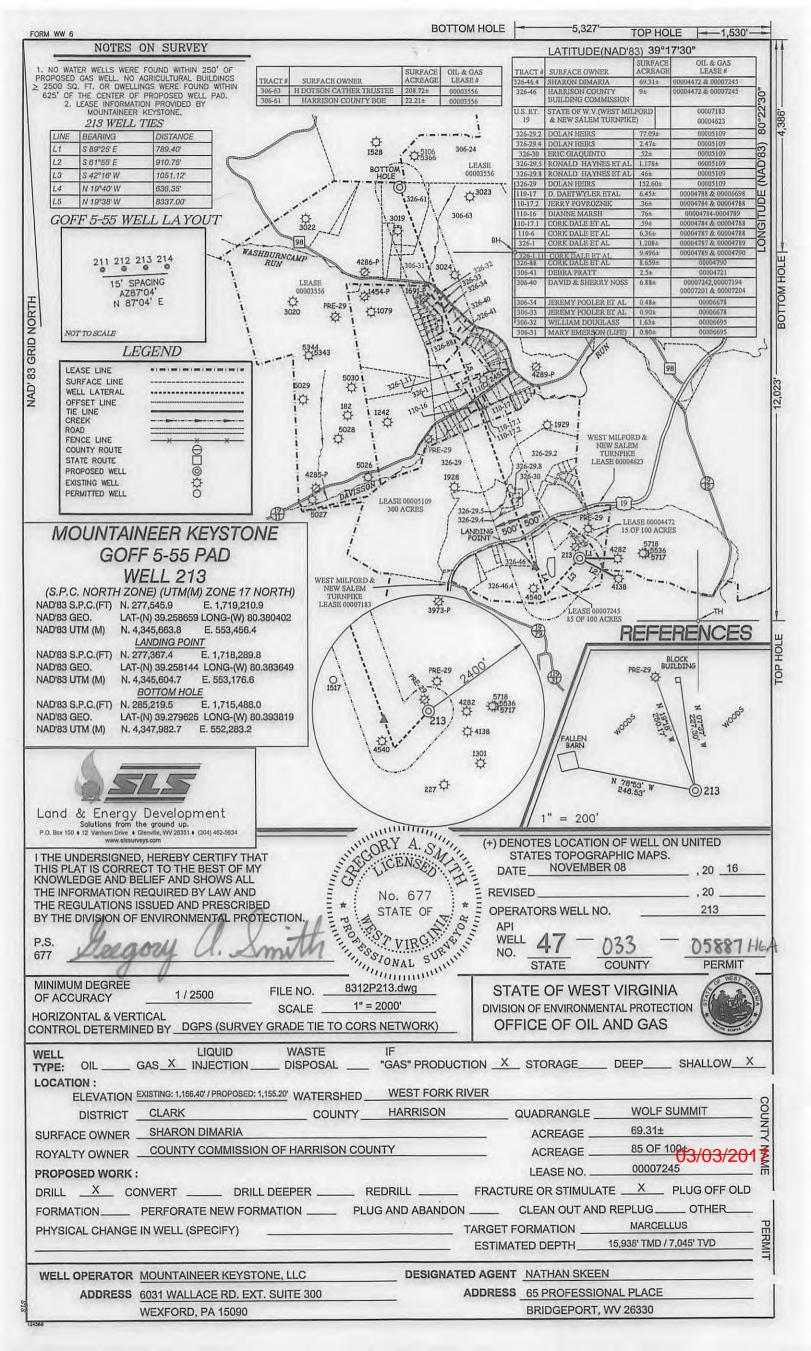

Code R. § 35-8-15.2.c, this notice shall: (1) contain a statement of the surface owner's and water purveyor's right to request sampling and analysis; (2) advise the surface owner and water purveyor of the rebuttable presumption for contamination or deprivation of a fresh water source or supply; advise the surface owner and water purveyor that refusal to allow the operator to conduct a pre-drilling water well test constitutes a method to rebut the presumption of liability; (3) advise the surface owner and water purveyor of his or her independent right to sample and analyze any water supply at his or her own expense; advise the surface owner and water purveyor whether or not the operator will utilize an independent laboratory to analyze any sample; and (4) advise the surface owner and or water purveyor that he or she can obtain from the Chief a list of water testing laboratories in the subject area capable of and qualified to test water supplies in accordance with standard acceptable methods.

Well Location Restrictions

Pursuant to W. Va. Code § 22-6A-12, Wells may not be drilled within two hundred fifty feet measured horizontally from any existing water well or developed spring used for human or domestic animal consumption. The center of well pads may not be located within six hundred twenty-five feet of an occupied dwelling structure, or a building two thousand five hundred square feet or larger used to house or shelter dairy cattle or poultry husbandry. This limitation is applicable to those wells, developed springs, dwellings or agricultural buildings that existed on the date a notice to the surface owner of planned entry for surveying or staking as provided in section ten of this article or a notice of intent to drill a horizontal well as provided in subsection (b), section sixteen of this article was provided, whichever occurs first, and to any dwelling under construction prior to that date. This limitation may be waived by written consent of the surface owner transmitted to the department and recorded in the real property records maintained by the clerk of the county commission for the county in which such property is located. Furthermore, the well operator may be granted a variance by the secretary from these distance restrictions upon submission of a plan which identifies the sufficient measures, facilities or practices to be employed during well site construction, drilling and operations. The variance, if granted, shall include terms and conditions the department requires to ensure the safety and protection of affected persons and property. The terms and conditions may include insurance, bonding and indemnification, as well as technical requirements. (b) No well pad may be prepared or well drilled within one hundred feet measured horizontally from any perennial stream, natural or artificial lake, pond or reservoir, or a wetland, or within three hundred feet of a naturally reproducing trout stream. No well pad may be located within one thousand feet of a surface or ground water intake of a public water supply. The distance from the public water supply as identified by the department shall be measured as follows: (1) For a surface water intake on a lake or reservoir, the distance shall be measured from the boundary of the lake or reservoir. (2) For a surface water intake on a flowing stream, the distance shall be measured from a semicircular radius extending upstream of the surface water intake. (3) For a groundwater source, the distance shall be measured from the wellhead or spring. The department may, in its discretion, waive these distance restrictions upon submission of a plan identifying sufficient measures, facilities or practices to be employed during well site construction, drilling and operations to protect the waters of the state. A waiver, if granted, shall impose any permit conditions as the secretary considers necessary. (c) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this section, nothing contained in this section prevents an operator from conducting the activities permitted or authorized by a Clean Water Act Section 404 permit or other approval from the United States Army Corps of Engineers within any waters of the state or within the restricted areas referenced in this section. (d) The well location restrictions set forth in this section shall not apply to any well on a multiple well pad if at least one of the wells was permitted prior to the effective date of this article. (e) The secretary shall, by December 31, 2012, report to the Legislature on the noise, light, dust and volatile organic compounds generated by the drilling of horizontal wells as they refate to the well location restrictions regarding occupied dwelling structures pursuant to this section. Upon a finding, if any, by the secretary that the well location restrictions regarding occupied dwelling structures are inadequate or otherwise require alteration to address the items

examined in the study required by this subsection, the secretary shall have the authority to propose for promulgation legislative rules establishing guidelines and procedures regarding reasonable levels of noise, light, dust and volatile organic compounds relating to drilling horizontal wells, including reasonable means of mitigating such factors, if necessary.

Water Well Testing:

Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-10(d), notification shall be made, with respect to surface landowners identified in subsection (b) or water purveyors identified in subdivision (5), subsection (b) of this section, of the opportunity for testing their water well. The operator shall provide an analysis to such surface landowner or water purveyor at their request.

Water Testing Laboratories:

Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-10(i), persons entitled to notice pursuant to subsection (b) of this section may contact the department to ascertain the names and locations of water testing laboratories in the subject area capable and qualified to test water supplies in accordance with standard accepted methods. In compiling that list of names the department shall consult with the state Bureau for Public Health and local health departments. A surface owner and water purveyor has an independent right to sample and analyze any water supply at his or her own expense. The laboratory utilized by the operator shall be approved by the agency as being certified and capable of performing sample analyses in accordance with this section.

Rebuttable Presumption for Contamination or Deprivation of a Fresh Water Source or Supply:

W. Va. Code § 22-6A-18 requires that (b) unless rebutted by one of the defenses established in subsection (c) of this section, in any action for contamination or deprivation of a fresh water source or supply within one thousand five hundred feet of the center of the well pad for horizontal well, there is a rebuttable presumption that the drilling and the oil or gas well or either was the proximate cause of the contamination or deprivation of the fresh water source or supply. (c) In order to rebut the presumption of liability established in subsection (b) of this section, the operator must prove by a preponderance of the evidence one of the following defenses: (1) The pollution existed prior to the drilling or alteration activity as determined by a predrilling or prealteration water well test. (2) The landowner or water purveyor refused to allow the operator access to the property to conduct a predrilling or prealteration water well test. (3) The water supply is not within one thousand five hundred feet of the well. (4) The pollution occurred more than six months after completion of drilling or alteration activities. (5) The pollution occurred as the result of some cause other than the drilling or alteration activity. (d) Any operator electing to preserve its defenses under subdivision (1), subsection (c) of this section shall retain the services of an independent certified laboratory to conduct the predrilling or prealteration water well test. A copy of the results of the test shall be submitted to the department and the surface owner or water purveyor in a manner prescribed by the secretary. (e) Any operator shall replace the water supply of an owner of interest in real property who obtains all or part of that owner's supply of water for domestic, agricultural, industrial or other legitimate use from an underground or surface source with a comparable water supply where the secretary determines that the water supply has been affected by contamination, diminution or interruption proximately caused by the oil or gas operation, unless waived in writing by that owner. (f) The secretary may order the operator conducting the oil or gas operation to: (1) Provide an emergency drinking water supply within twenty-four hours; (2) Provide temporary water supply within seventy-two hours; (3) Within thirty days begin activities to establish a permanent water supply or submit a proposal to the secretary outlining the measures and timetables to be used in establishing a permanent supply. The total time in providing a permanent water supply may not exceed two years. If the operator demonstrates that providing a permanent replacement water supply cannot be completed within two years, the secretary may extend the time frame on case-by-case basis; and (4) Pay all reasonable costs incurred by the real property owner in securing a water supply. (g) A person as described in subsection (b) of this section aggrieved under the provisions of subsections (b), (e) or (f) of this section may seek relief in court... (i) Notwithstanding the denial of the operator of responsibility for the damage to the real property owner's water supply or the status of any appeal on determination of liability for the damage to the real property owner's water supply, the operator may not discontinue providing the required water service until authorized to do so by the secretary or a court of competent jurisdiction.

Permit Denial or Condition

The Chief has the power to deny or condition a well work permit. Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-8(d), the permit may not be issued or be conditioned, including conditions with respect to the location of the well and access roads prior to issuance if the director determines that:

- (1) The proposed well work will constitute a hazard to the safety of persons;
- (2) The plan for soil erosion and sediment control is not adequate or effective:
- (3) Damage would occur to publicly owned lands or resources; or
- (4) The proposed well work fails to protect fresh water sources or supplies.

A permit may also be denied under West Virginia Code § 22-6A-7(k), the secretary shall deny the issuance of a permit if the secretary determines that the applicant has committed a substantial violation of a previously issued permit for a horizontal well, including the applicable erosion and sediment control plan associated with the previously issued permit, or a substantial violation of one or more of the rules promulgated under this article, and in each instance has failed to abate or seek review of the violation within the time prescribed by the secretary pursuant to the provisions of subdivisions (1) and (2), subsection (a), section five of this article and the rules promulgated hereunder, which time may not be unreasonable.

Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-10(g), any person entitled to submit written comments to the secretary pursuant to subsection (a), section eleven of this article, shall also be entitled to receive from the secretary a copy of the permit as issued or a copy of the order modifying or denying the permit if the person requests receipt of them as a part of the written comments submitted concerning the permit application. Such persons may request, at the time of submitting written comments, notice of the permit decision and a list of persons qualified to test water.
