#### Taylor,

I've been on the run today. Just getting to sit down for a minute.

Regarding wells 4703305993 & 4703305994 that are currently on our property owned by Mark A & Anne TM Jones in Harrison County WV, Clay District. My wife had received 2 certified letters addressed only to her from Diversified Energy, even though we are joint owners of the property. In trying to straighten out the error, I eventually arrived in a conversation with Taylor Brewer and have been instructed to reply by email with any concerns..

Starting with well 5993. The main concern I would have there is that our water and gas lines are under the proposed Primary and Secondary pit locations. In case any digging would be necessary, our lines could be disturbed. With the pits moved closer to the driveway, this would remove that possibility.

With well 5994, I know there are 2 gas lines going across the yard which would be in the proposed path up the hill. One of the lines is a steel line that feeds out to a commercial line. It is maybe a 3" line. Not sure of the depth but it doesn't seem to be very deep. The other gas line is a plastic line that feeds to neighbor's house that is adjacent to the front of our property. This line is not very deep at all. There are some segments that are above ground further out in the field by the driveway. My main concern with these lines is that you are aware of them before you proceed.

With both wells in question, we would expect that the reclamation of the yard be back to the present state, without dips or any rocks protruding. I keep both these areas mowed.

If any driveway repair would be needed, I have most recently used #4 size limestone gravel. We have had good success with this product. Would prefer this would be used in case replacement is necessary.

If you have any questions or clarification is needed please contact me. If needed, I can meet with anyone necessary on site to point out possible problem areas.

Mr. Kennedy,

Please see below our responses to the concerns outlined in your email:

- The permit applications for 4703305993 and 4703305994 have been updated and mailed via USPS Certified Mail, were mailed on 8/22/2025 and delivered on 9/3/2025 to include both owners, Mark A. and Anne T.M. Jones, along with all relevant attachments.
- Earth pits are proposed as a precaution and are unlikely to be needed. If required, they will be
  placed to avoid existing lines. Any accidental damage will be repaired promptly.
- We will contact 811 to locate underground utilities within the proposed disturbance area and request an onsite meeting with the surface owner to ensure all lines are identified.
- Shallow lines can be protected using composite ground matting. As noted, any damage will be addressed immediately.
- Our goal is to restore the property to its original or improved condition. Prior to seeding, we will rake
  mowed areas to remove rocks and debris. We welcome the surface owner's review of reclamation
  efforts before demobilization, though minor settling may occur.
- If additional stone is needed, we will match the existing material as closely as possible.
- We will maintain communication regarding our operations. Marking for 811 review is expected to begin this week.

We hope this addresses your concerns. Please don't hesitate to reach out with any further questions or requests.

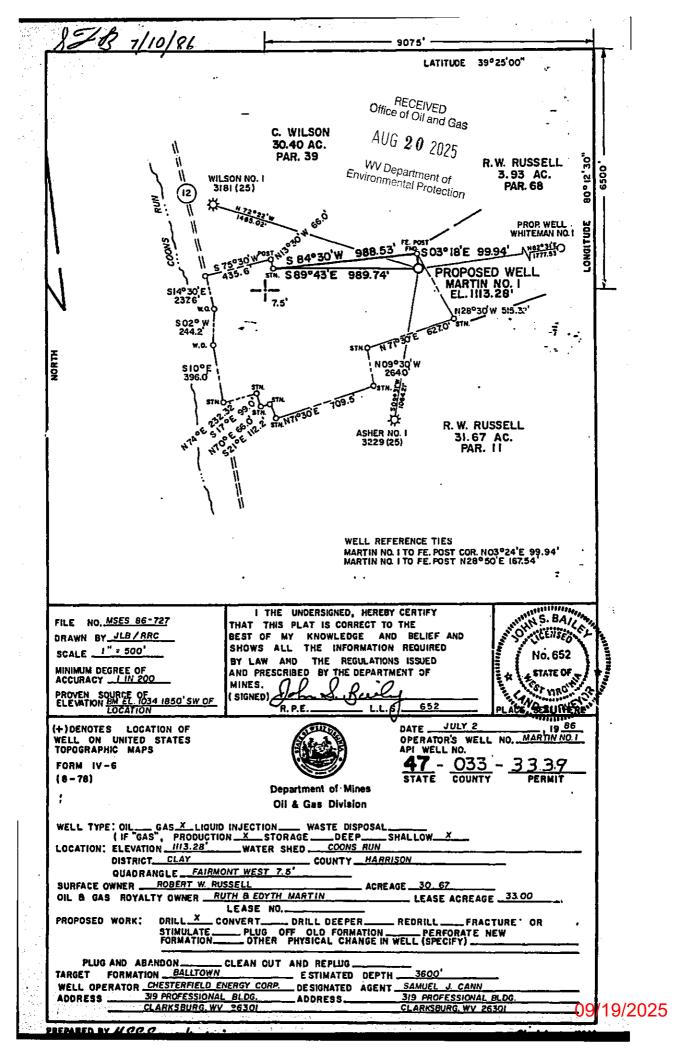
# **CONDITIONS**

In addition, the well operator shall notify the same inspector 24 hours before any actual well work is commenced and prior to running and cementing casing.

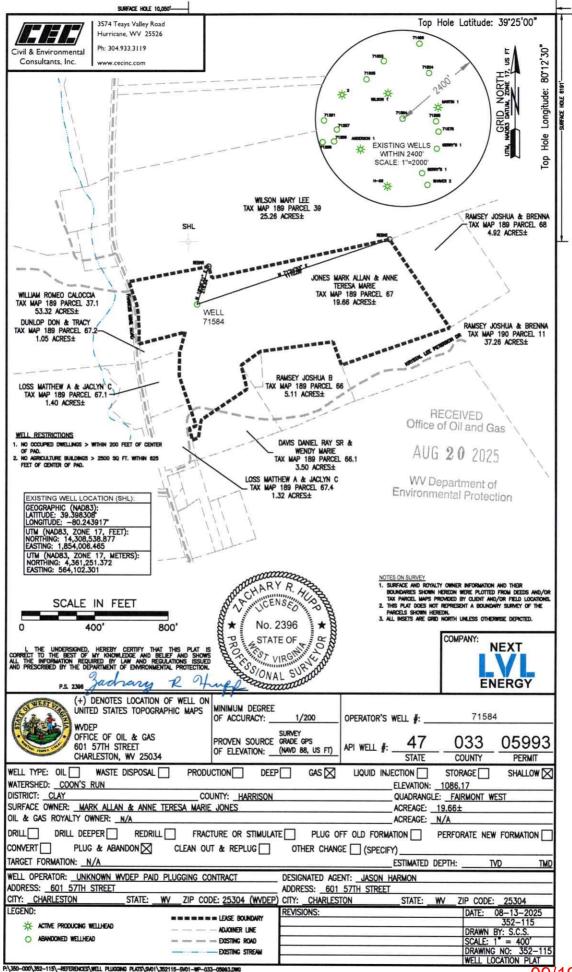

# REPORT OF THE OFFICE

In response to industry requests, the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, Office of Oil and Gas has reviewed the proposed use of American Petroleum Institute (API) Class L cement to be used in place of API Class A cement for well plugging.

# FINDINGS OF FACT

- On July 28, 2022, Diversified Gas & Oil Co. (DGO) submitted a variance request from Legislative Rule 35CSR4 for the use of API Class L cement in place of API Class A cement, relating to the plugging of conventional wells.
- Laboratory analysis submitted by DGO on July 28, 2022, indicates API Class L cement is comparable to API Class A cement and thereby satisfies the requirements of the West Virginia Code.
- Contemporaneously, the Chief of the Office of Oil and Gas also chose to consider a
  variance to Legislative Rule 35CSR8 Section 20.1., for the use of API Class L cement in
  place of API Class A cement, relating to the plugging of horizontal wells.

Promoting a healthy environment.

On August 18, 2022, the Office of Oil and Gas provided public notice of acceptance of
public comments on the variance consideration. During the 20-day public comment
period, no comments were received.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Pursuant to Article 6 and Article 6A, Chapter 22 of the Code of West Virginia, the Office of Oil and Gas has jurisdiction over the subject matter, and the persons interested therein, and jurisdiction to promulgate the hereinafter prescribed Order.

Pursuant to Legislative Rule 35CSR4, Section 18 and Legislative Rule 35CSR8, Section 14, the Chief of the Office of Oil and Gas may grant a variance from any requirement of these rules.

# ORDER

It is ordered that the Class L cement product approved and monogramed by API is approved for use in place of API Class A cement for well plugging subject to the provisions of Legislative Rule 35CSR4 and Legislative Rule 35CSR8.

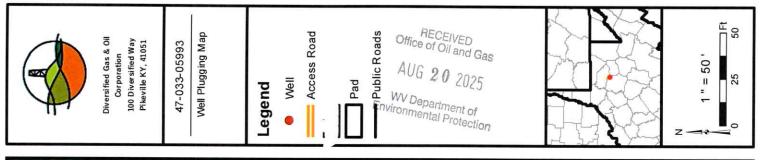

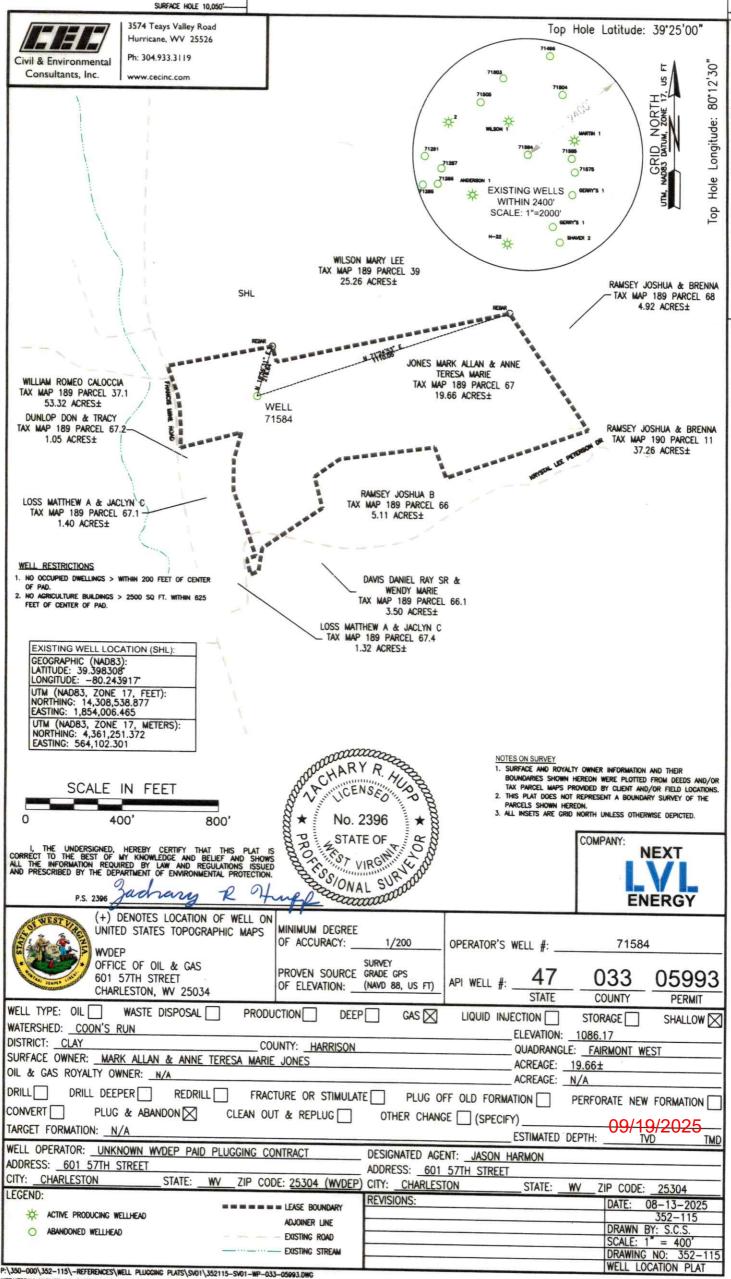

If you have been contacted by the well operator and you have signed a "voluntary statement of no objection" to the planned work described in these materials, then the permit may be issued at any time.

Comments must be in writing. Your comments must include your name, address and telephone number, the well operator's name and well number and the approximate location of the proposed well site including district and county from the application. You may add other documents, such as sketches, maps or photographs to support your comments.

The Chief has the power to deny or condition a well work permit based on comments of the Gollowing s: grounds: AUG 20 2025

- 1) The proposed well work will constitute a hazard to the safety of persons.
- 2) The soil erosion and sediment control plan is not adequate or effective;
- 3) Damage would occur to publicly owned lands or resources;
- 4) The proposed well work fails to protect fresh water sources or supplies;

5) The applicant has committed a substantial violation of a previous permit or a substantial violation of one or more of the rules promulgated under Chapter 22, and has failed to abate or seek review of the violation...".

If you want a copy of the permit as it is issued or a copy of the order denying the permit, you should request a copy from the Chief.
