being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by RAAD & MOSES well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the day of JUNE, 1935, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which said well was plugged:

Removed 2" Tubing and filled hole with clay to 1560' and
Placed cement plug on top of wood plug. Removed 1200' of

6 5/8 casing and placed permanent bridge at 1435' (In
dunkard sand) and placed plug. - Installed permanent bridge at
962'-30" below Pittsburgh Coal Seam and filled with cement
to 906'-20" above Pittsburgh Coal Seam, and from this point
Manner in which coal was plugged:
to the surface the hole was filled with mud and clay.
