Manner in which said well was plugged: Filled with clay from bottom of about 2540' to 2545'... a mud plug and 10' cement on top of plug... Continued to fill from 2545' to 2550' with mud plug... 10' cement on top of plug... Continued to fill with clay from depth 2550' to 2555'... a mud plug and 10' cement on top of plug... Filled 5-1/2" casing at a depth of 2555' and before cementing same declined to fill with clay from 2555' to 2560'... a mud plug and 10' cement on top of clay... Manner in which coal was plugged

5-1/2" casing and placed a permanent bridge at 511' bottom of Big Barbara... a mud plug and 10' cement on top of plug... left 527 feet of open hole as requested by Coal Company, also left 378 feet of 10" casing in place for you and the Coal Company.

Description of monument: Top of 10" casing was reduced to 2" with extension of 6' of 2" in the air perforated and a piece of cement of monument was placed around 10" casing 10" x 10" square.
