"Answering your kind favor of the 6th inst., would advise that I have to-day received the shipment referred to in your letter, for all of which I am very grateful and you will please accept thanks for the "extras". As to location of the well known as the Seventh Day Baptist Church lot well, would state that it is located about one mile southeast of Lost Creek Station, Harrison County, Post-Office, Lost Creek, W. Va.

"Referring to the "fifty-foot" and its location will say that while it would seem out of place yet I note by comparison with the log of an adjoining well located only about 150 ft. from our well that their drillers also place the fifty-foot at about the same location, while another well about 300 yards in another direction and drilled in by the Hope Gas Co. showed a sand also termed the 50-ft. at about the same elevation. Would state also for your information that this "fifty-foot", as we term it, produced in our well, quite a nice showing of oil, perhaps would pump 15 to 25 bbls. per day, the oil being the same as that found in the 50-ft. in the Shinnston field. wells around it, however, are making gas in this 50-ft. sand, the one above mentioned as being 300 yds. away making something like 4,000,000 ft. per day so I was told by the drillers. I do not know the quantity produced in this sand in the near-by well but know it to be a well producing from 4,000,000 to 6,000,000 ft. per day in the several sands. Trusting this will be of some information to you and again thanking you, I am,"
