I, Earl Stewart, now living at 900 Adams Avenue, Ravenswood, West Virginia, do hereby state that I have many years of experience in the Oil & Gas Industry. I have been in charge of producing numerous wells for myself and other companies including taking care of the wells drilled in the Ravenswood area by Management Control Corporation. The Pullins Wells, located off Ravenswood Pike, Ravenswood District, Jackson County, were originally drilled by Management Control Corporation and later purchased by Burdette Oil & Gas Co., Inc.

I hereby certify that Burdette Oil & Gas Co., Inc. had me to run an open flow test through a meter with a back pressure regulator installed to maintain 100 pounds pressure. This was to see if the wells would produce into Kaiser's gas system which operates at approximately 100 pounds. The result of the test was affirmative and I do certify that production in commercial quantities was found by the test. This production would amount to several thousands of dollars to the operator with the current price of gas and I recommend that any well with these capabilities should not be plugged or abandoned.





Concerning the two notices of violation of Code 22-4-7 on wells #47-035-1286 & 1287, and the violation of Code 22-4-12B on well #47-035-1531, I would like to explain the position of our company. I agree that the Pullins wells located in Ravenswood District, Jackson County, have not been in production for some time. The main reason for this is because these wells were contracted to Columbia Gas Transmission Corp. and dedicated to Interstate Commerce. The wells produced up until the pressure of the wells depleted below that of Columbia's gas line pressure which made us unable to produce. I then talked with KEM Gas about purchasing gas from us. They informed me that I would have to get the wells released from FERC so that they would no longer be dedicated to interstate commerce. I then began to take the appropriate steps to release the wells on August 13, 1980. December 22, 1980, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission issued an order in which these wells were released from their jurisdiction. After this time, I contacted Earl Stewart, a qualified production man, to test the wells, bucking the amount of pressure that would be on Kaiser's gas line. He did test the production and we found that the production was around 300,000 MCF per day. We realised that even though the pressure was somewhat depleted, the volume of gas is still very much there.

I will obtain for your files an affidavit from Earl Stewart concerning this production and also a letter from Kaiser verifying our intentions of selling gas to them in the near future. At the present time, there are three families using gas from these wells. They have been getting gas for years. One elderly gentlemen is receiving gas and has no other source of heating unless he reverts back to burning wood.

Our primary goal in this country is to explore and find natural gas in paying quantities, not to plug those wells which are able to supply gas to residents as well as industry.

The violation of Code 22-4-12B, which is to comply with

the reclamation requirements, is one we will correct as soon as we can. I would like to ask the Office of Oil & Gas to give us a thirty (30) day extension from the time stipulated on the violation. Our reclamation crew is at this time working on the installation of a new gas pipeline. We should be finished with the line and able to reclaim the well site of #47-035-1531 with the thirty day extension.

I hope that we may be able to resolve these problems without another hearing. I will do my best to encourage our company to comply with any and all Department of Mine Oil and Gas regulations.

Following the order of the Department of March 21, 1983, wherein Burdette Oil & Gas was required to act diligently in placing the above wells in production, the following has occurred:

- 1. Burdette has attempted to secure ratification of the pertinent leases by tendering to the royalty ownership a sum of money insufficient to pay the several years of rental which are in arrears; and
- Talked purchase of the production of the wells with KemGas of Ravenswood.

We have learned that, while appropriate interstate authority has been acquired by Burdette, they have taken no substantive action with regard to negotiating a purchase agreement with KemGas. For whatever reason, it appears that Burdette only intends to delay production of the wells while giving the appearance that it is doing otherwise. 




