# WELL WORK PERMIT

## Rework-Brine Disposal

This permit, API Well Number: 47-3902210, issued to VIKING ENERGY CORPORATION, is evidence of permission granted to perform the specified well work at the location described on the attached pages and located on the attached plat, subject to the provisions of Chapter 22 of the West Virginia Code of 1931, as amended, and all rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, and to all conditions and provisions outlined in the pages attached hereto. Notification shall be given by the operator to the Oil and Gas Inspector at least 24 hours prior to the construction of roads, locations, and/or pits for any permitted work. In addition, the well operator shall notify the same inspector 24 hours before any actual well work is commenced and prior to running and cementing casing. Spills or emergency discharges must be promptly reported by the operator to 1-800-642-3074 and to the Oil and Gas inspector.

Please be advised that form WR-35, Well Operators Report of Well Work is to be submitted to this office within 90 days completion of permitted well work, as should form WR-34 Discharge Monitoring Report within 30 days of discharge of pits, if applicable. Failure to abide by all statutory and regulatory provisions governing all duties and operations hereunder may result in suspension or revocation of this permit and, in addition, may result in civil and/or criminal penalties being imposed upon the operators.

In addition to the applicable requirements of this permit, and the statutes and rules governing oil and gas activity in WV, this permit may contain specific conditions which must be followed. Permit conditions are attached to this cover letter.

Per 35CSR-4-5.2.g this permit will expire in two (2) years from the issue date unless permitted well work is commenced. If there are any questions, please feel free to contact me at (304) 926-0499 ext. 1654.

# PERMIT CONDITIONS

West Virginia Code §22-6-11 allows the Office of Oil and Gas to place specific conditions upon this permit. Permit conditions have the same effect as law. <u>Failure to adhere to the specified permit conditions may result in enforcement action.</u>

#### CONDITIONS

- 1. If the operator encounters an unanticipated void, or an anticipated void at an unanticipated depth, the operator shall notify the inspector within 24 hours. Modifications to the casing program may be necessary to comply with W. Va. Code §22-6-20, which requires drilling to a minimum depth of thirty feet below the bottom of the void, and installing a minimum of twenty (20) feet of casing. Under no circumstance should the operator drill more than fifty (50) feet below the bottom of the void or install less than twenty (20) feet of casing below the bottom of the void.
- Pursuant to 35 CSR 4-19.1.a, at the request of the surface owner all water wells or springs within 1000 feet of the proposed well that are actually utilized for human consumption, domestic animals or other general use shall be sampled and analyzed.
- 3. Pursuant to 35 CSR 4-19.1.c, if the operator is unable to sample and analyze any water well or spring with one thousand (1,000) feet of the permitted well location, the Office of Oil and Gas requires the operator to sample, at a minimum, one water well or spring located between one thousand (1,000) feet and two thousand (2,000) feet of the permitted well location.
- 4. All pits must be lined with a minimum of 20 mil thickness synthetic liner.
- 5. In the event of an accident or explosion causing loss of life or serious personal injury in or about the well or while working on the well, the well operator or its contractor shall give notice, stating the particulars of the accident or explosion, to the oil and gas inspector and the Chief within twenty-four (24) hours.
- 6. During the surface casing and cementing process, in the event cement does not return to the surface, or any other casing string that is permitted to circulate cement to the surface and does not return to the surface, the oil and gas inspector shall be notified within twenty-four (24) hours
- 7. Well work activities shall not constitute a hazard to the safety of persons.
- 8. Operator shall provide the Office of Oil & Gas notification of the date that drilling commenced on this well. Such notice shall be provided by sending an email to DEPOOGNotify@wv.gov within 30 days of commencement of drilling.

### **INSTRUCTIONS TO SURFACE OWNERS NAMED ON PAGE WW2-A / 3A**

The well operator named on page WW-2A / 3A is applying for a permit from the State to do oil or gas well work. (Note: If the surface tract is owned by more than three persons, then these materials were served on you because your name appeared on the Sheriff's tax ticket on the land or because you actually occupy the surface tract. In either case, you may be the only owner who will actually receive these materials.) See Chapter 22 of the West Virginia Code. Well work permits are valid for 24 months. If you do not own any interest in the surface tract, please forward these materials to the true owner immediately if you know who it is. Time Limits and methods for filing comments. The law requires these materials to be served on or before the date the operator files his Application. You have FIFTEEN (15) DAYS after the filing date to file your comments. Comments must be filed in person or received in the mail by the Chief's office by the time stated above. You may call the Chief's office to be sure of the date. Check with your postmaster to ensure adequate delivery time or to arrange special expedited handling. If you have been contacted by the well operator and you have signed a "voluntary statement of no objection" to the planned work described in these materials, then the permit may be issued at any time.

<u>Comments must be in writing.</u> Your comments must include your name, address and telephone number, the well operator's name and well number and the approximate location of the proposed well site including district and county from the application. You may add other documents, such as sketches, maps or photographs to support your comments.

The Chief has the power to deny or condition a well work permit based on comments on the following grounds:

- 1) The proposed well work will constitute a hazard to the safety of persons.
- 2) The soil erosion and sediment control plan is not adequate or effective;
- 3) Damage would occur to publicly owned lands or resources;
- 4) The proposed well work fails to protect fresh water sources or supplies;
- 5) The applicant has committed a substantial violation of a previous permit or a substantial violation of one or more of the rules promulgated under Chapter 22, and has failed to abate or seek review of the violation...".

If you want a copy of the permit as it is issued or a copy of the order denying the permit, you should request a copy from the Chief.

<u>List of Water Testing Laboratories.</u> The Office maintains a list of water testing laboratories which you can hire to test your water to establish water quality prior to and after drilling. Contact the Chief to obtain a copy.

#### NOTICE TO SURFACE OWNERS

The well operator named below is preparing to file for a permit from the state to drill a new well. 

Reason for Work-over; A pressure test was attempted on the Wallace Inj. Well as it appeared that the packer had failed

### Remedial procedure to date;

- 1) Packer was released and tripped out of hole and rebuilt.
- 2) Packer was made up to the tubing and tripped in hole. It was set at 2500 ft, an annular test performed. Test held. Tripping in was resumed at 1000 ft intervals setting packer and annular testing to ensure tubing string was good. The pressure test failed at 4500 ft. After the test failed the packer was released and reset in stages with subsequent pressure tests. It was found that the test held at 4381 but failed at 4413 ft. Results indicate a leak in the 5 1/2 casing between 4381 and 4413 ft.

#### Proposed remedial operations

- 1) Run in hole and set a drillable bridge plug at 4450 (+/-) ft. (not to be set in a collar)
- 2) Perform a squeeze cement job as follows;
  - Establish an injection rate with fresh water.
  - Calculate cement volume (not to be less than 50 sks.) based on casing capacity, injection rate a
    pressure
  - 3) Mix and pump cement, drop wiper plug and displace to a maximum depth of 4381 ft.
  - 4) Wait on cement 8 hrs minimum.
- 3) Rig up power swivel and related equipment
- 4) Trip in hole with 4 7/8 bit and drill out cement.
- 5) Pressure test casing (bridge plug is still in place)
- 6) If test is sucessful. Drill out drillable bridge plug and run to bottom.
- 7) Run in hole and set packer at +/- 5450 ft notify state inspector 24 hrs in advance and conduct an N
- 8) Return well to service

Note: if pressure test after squeeze in step 5 fails locate the additional leak using the packer isolation p again. At that point if it is determined the leak has been satisfactorily located perform a second squeez repeat process, steps 2 through 5 Setting the bridge plug below the located leak. Or if determined, a lin may be required to be run. Exact procedure would have to be determined after squeezing. Initial design follows.

- 1) Set bridge plug in 5 1/2 @ +/- 5475 ft
- 2) Run 3 1/2 pipe to plug pick up one ft and cement back 500 ft.
- 3) Run CBL

- 4) Drill out cement and packer
- 5) Run pipe and a packer and set 10 ft from bottom of 3 1/2
- 6) Notify State inspector 24 hrs in advance and perform MIT test
- 7) Return well to service
