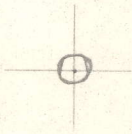

**AFFIDAVIT**

Wealey S. Carrier and Cecil L. Kittle  
 being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging  
 and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Reserve Gas Company, well operator,  
 and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the  
11th day of July, 1935, and that the well was plugged and filled in  
 the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged:  
 Filled hole with clay mud to 2535' and run 5" wood plug and cement plug. Installed  
 permanent bridge at 2200' and filled with clay to 2092' and placed 6" wood plug and  
 cement plug. Installed permanent bridge at 1990' and filled with clay to 1830' and  
 placed 6" wood plug and cement plug. Installed permanent bridge at 1525' placed 6"  
 wood plug and cement plug. Removed 1356' 6-5/8" casing. Installed permanent bridge  
 at 1277' and filled with clay to 947' and placed 8 1/2" wood plug, filled to 440' and  
 placed 8 1/2" wood plug and cement plug. Installed permanent bridge and placed 10"  
 wood plug at 136'; removed 80' of 10" casing. Hole was then filled to the surface  
 Manner in which coal was plugged:  
 with clay and concrete monument erected over the hole.

Description of monument: 8" x 8"- extending 32" above ground and enough below the  
 surface to make it permanent.
