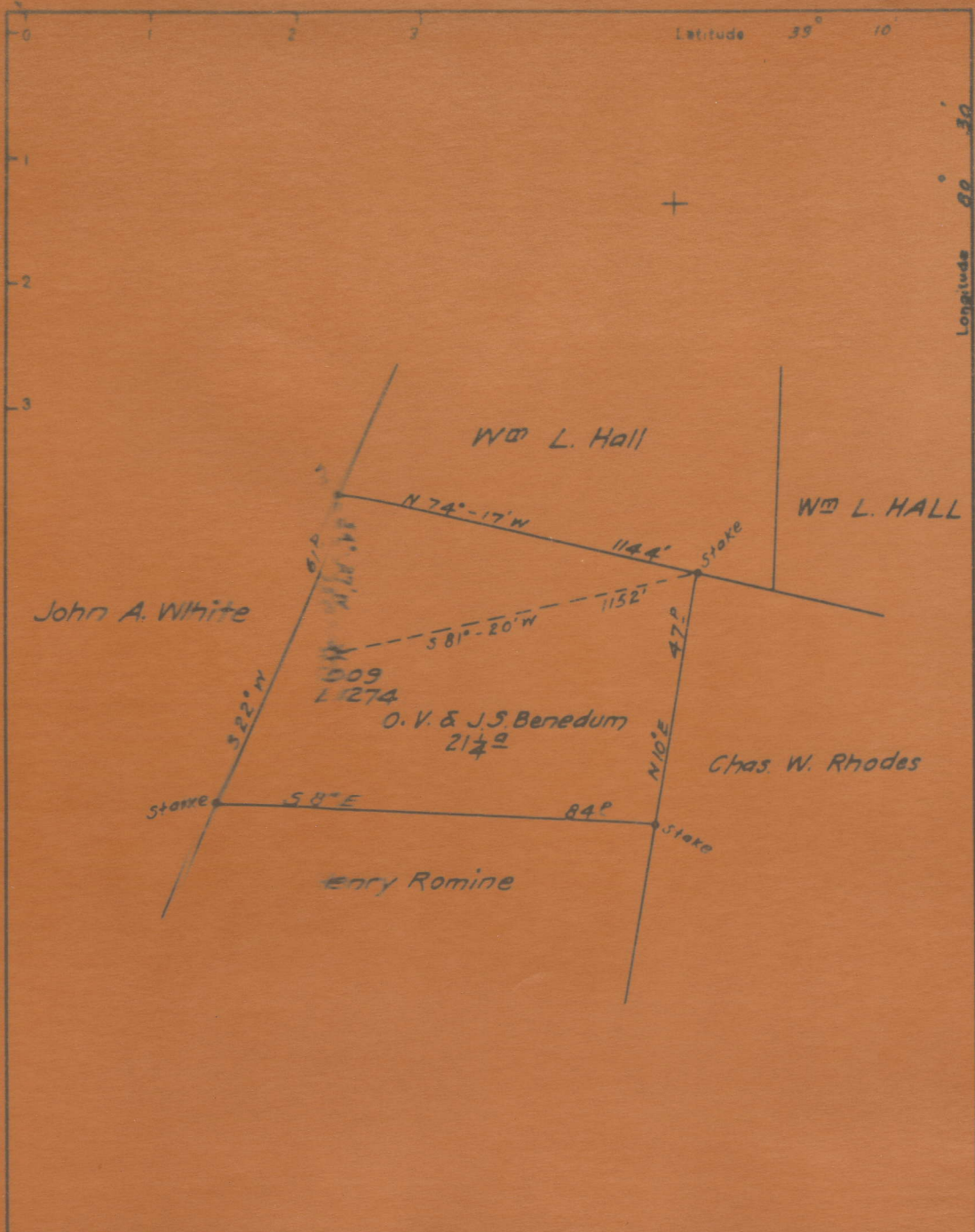

and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Hope Natural Gas Company, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the

20 day of July, 1936, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged:

Filled with clay to 2645 and set wood plug, drove lead plug 2639- clay to 2614- 20' above 4th. sand and set cement plug. Clay to 2515- 20' above Gordon sand and set cement plug bridged at 2084 clay to 2046 and set wood plug- drove lead plug at 2044 clay to 1955- 20' above Big Injun sand and set cement plug- bridged 1450- 20' below salt sand clay to 1320 and set cement plug to 1320- bridged 1008 and drove lead plug 1008 clay to 470 and cement from 470 to 412 being 20' above coal, clay to surface.

Manner in which coal was plugged: Cemented from 470 to 412.
