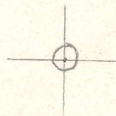

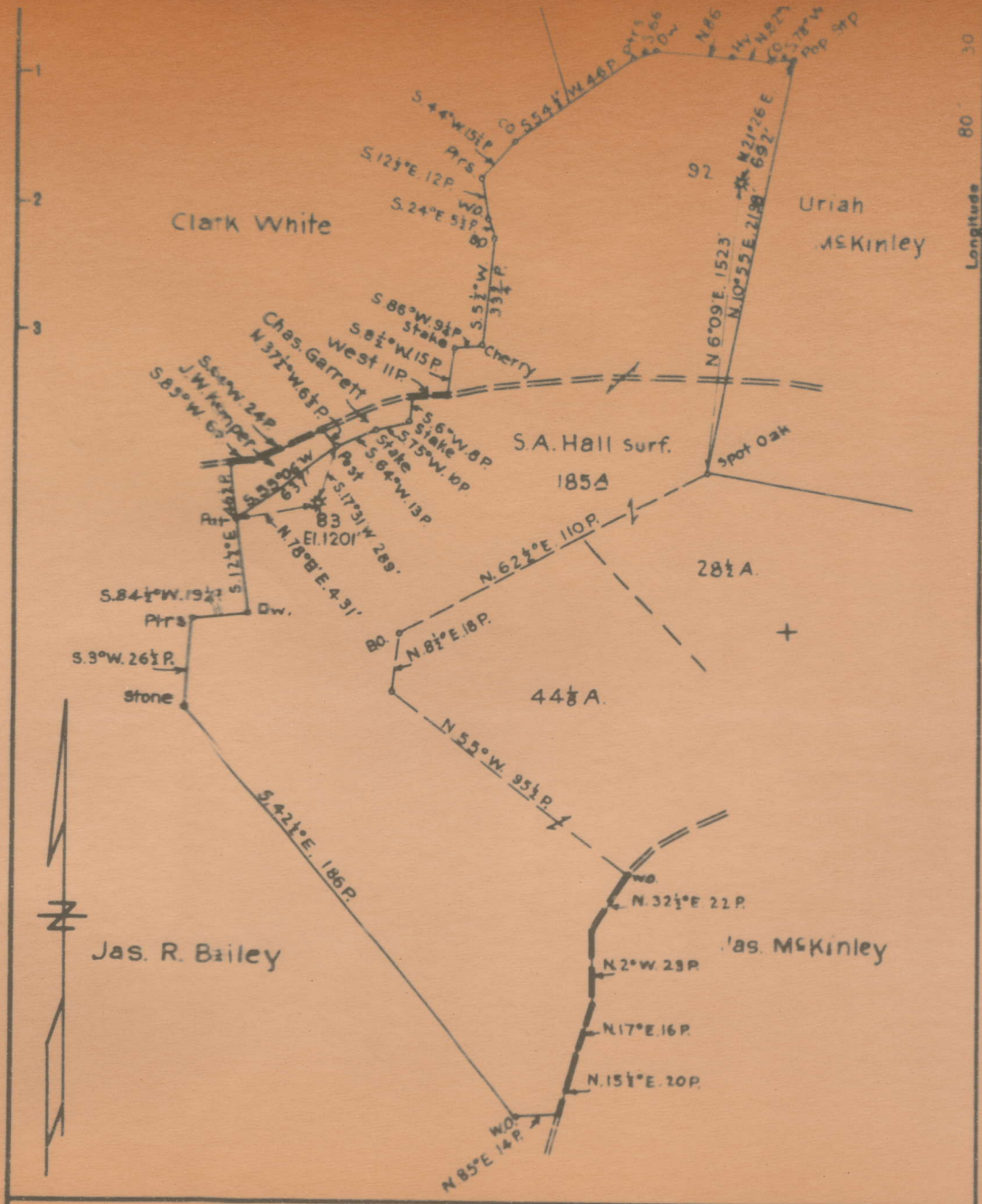

Charles E. Taylor and Russell E. Taylor
being first day sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging
and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Reserve Gas Co. well operator,
and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the
8th day of September, 19 36, and that the well was plugged and filled in
the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged:

Pulled 5" tubing and filled with clay mud to 2220' and run 5" wood plug with one sack cement on top of plug. Installed bridge and placed 5" wood plug at 2080', with one sack cement on top of plug. Attempted to yull 8-8/16" casing, would not pull, ripped same 38' from bottom of pipe. Then pulled out 1674', leaving 354' in well. Hole then caved and was unable to place plug or bridge at 1595'. Hole caved and filled up to 1055'. Filled solid with clay dirt to 459'. Run one 10" Wood plug with two sacks cement at 459'. Filled hole solid to 270' and run one 10" wood plug with two sacks cement. Filled from 270' to surface with clay mud and erected concrete monument over hole.

Description of monument:

Concrete monument with well No and Company on same, extending 26" above surface of ground.
