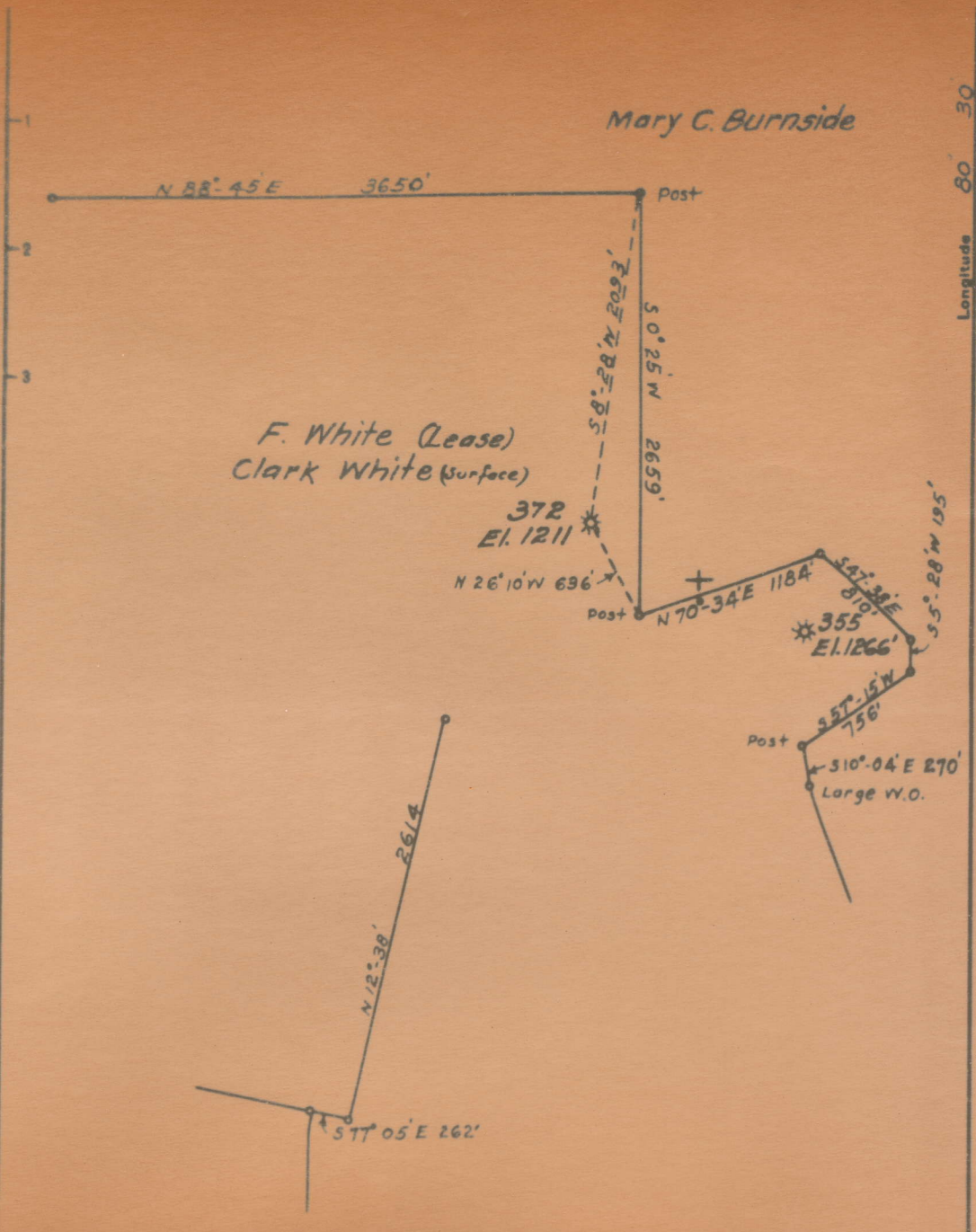

being first duly sworn according to law do, swear and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by RESERVE GAS COMPANY, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 27th day of JULY, 1936, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged: Filled hole with clay to 2353ft. and place a plug at 2353 ft. Installed permanent bridge at 2204 ft. filled with clay to 2135 ft. and place a plug at 2135ft. Filled hole with clay to 2085 ft. and place a cement plug at 208ft. Installed bridge at 1750ft. and filled to 1698 ft. and placed a cement plug at 1602 ft. filled hole with clay to 1555 ft. and placed a cement plug at 1555 ft. Installed bridge at 1175 ft. filled hole with clay to 690 ft. and placed a cement plug at 580 ft. Installed bridge at 400 ft. and filled hole solid to surface.

Manner in which coal was plugged: BELOW COAL.

Description of monument: 8" x 5 ft. CONCRETE MONUMENT R.O.CO.# 378.
