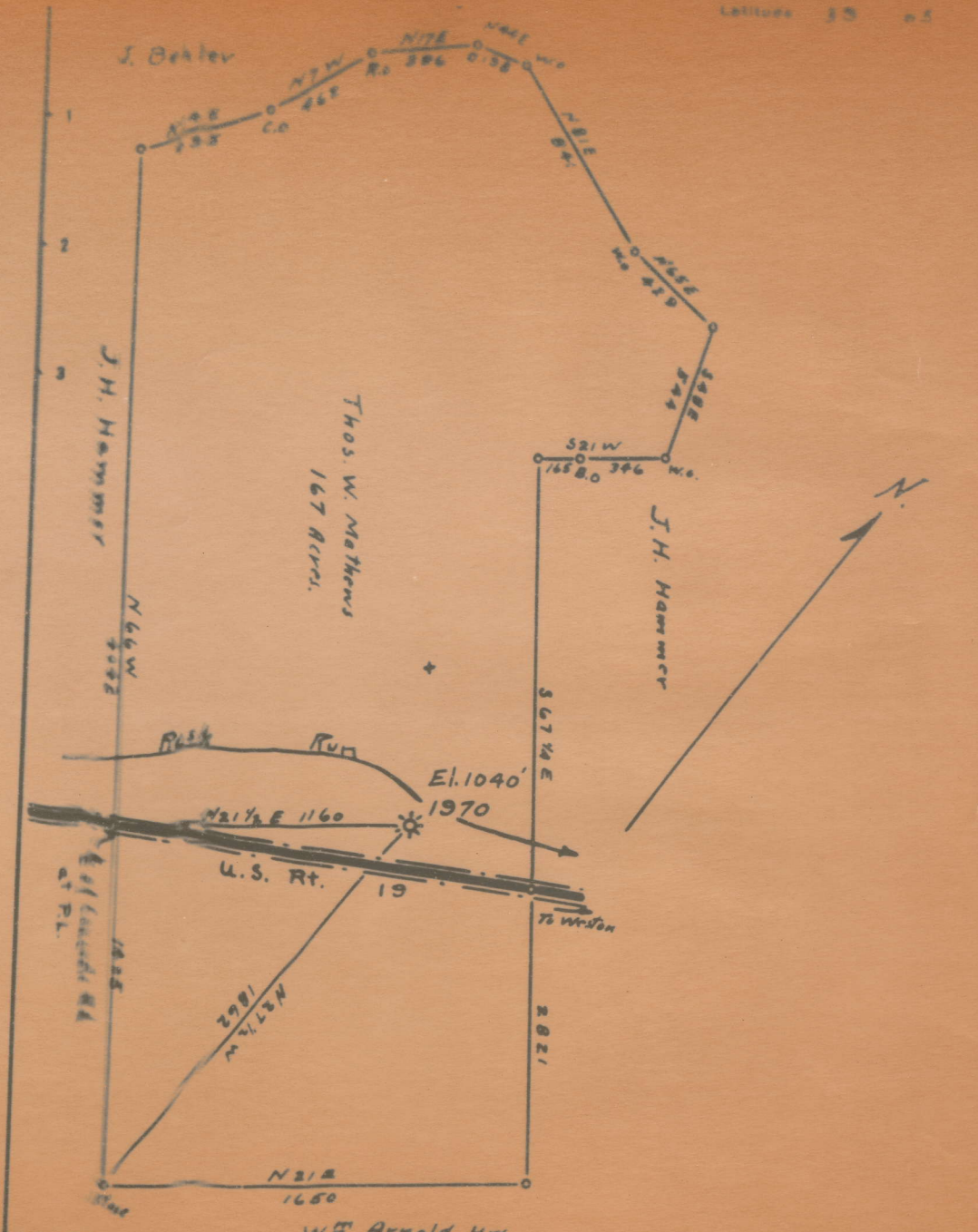

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Pgh.&W.Va. Gas Company, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 12th day of August, 19 36, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged

Previously filled to 2614 feet. Clay 2614 to 2570. Cement 2570 to 2560. Clay 2560 to 2185. Cement 2185 to 2175. Hole bridged at 2020. Clay 2020 to 1878. Wood plug 1878 to 1875. Cement 1875 to 1865. Hole bridged at 1520. Clay 1520 to 990. Hole bridged at 849. Clay 849 to 780. Cement 780 to 770.

Manner in which coal was plugged

Hole bridged at 185. Cement 185 to 85. Clay 85 to 5. Cement 5 feet to surface.

Description of monument

Cement and iron pipe, with cast iron plate, lettered Pgh.&W.Va. Gas Co. Well No. 1970.

Work of plugging and filling said well was completed on the 22nd day of September.
