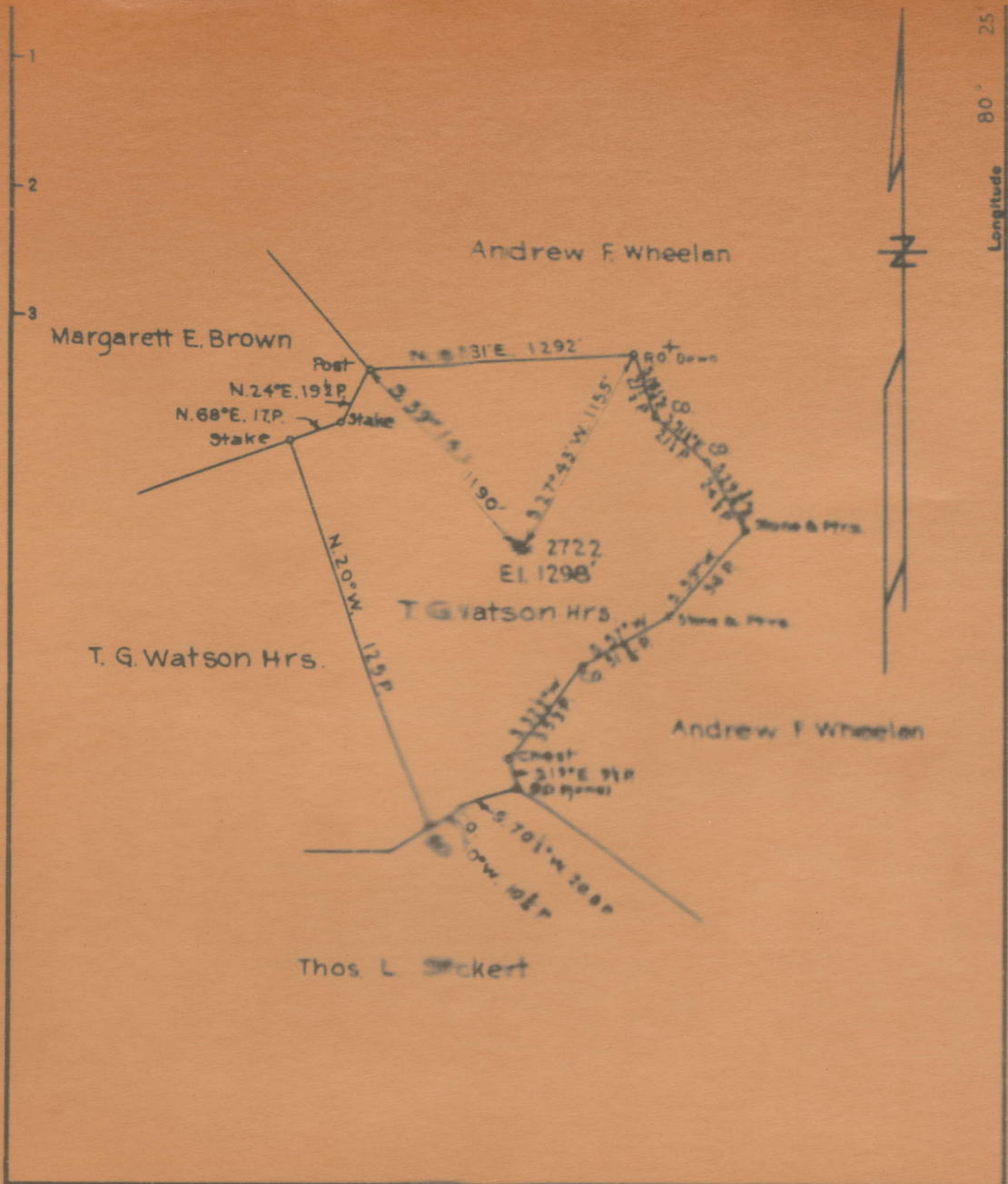

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging

and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Hope Natural Gas Co., well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the

17th day of November, 19 36, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which said well was plugged: Commenced filling at 2840 and filled to 2727 with clay. Hit in stone from 2727 to 2717. Drove 6 5/8" wood plug at 2714 to 2717. Filled with clay from 2714 to 2595 and stone to 2585. Drove 6 5/8" wood plug at 2585. Filled with clay up to 2327. Filled with stone 2327 to 2317 and drove 6 5/8" wood plug. Filled with clay to 2067 and with stone from 2067 to 2057. Drove 6 5/8" wood plug at 2037. Drove 6 5/8" lead plug on top of wood plug at 2032 to 2034. (Did not entirely shut off gas). Filled with stone to 2027 and drove 6 5/8" wood plug. Drove 6 5/8" lead plug from 2024 to 2022. (Gas not entirely shut off). Put in 200 lb. of lead wool on top of lead plug which shut gas entirely off. (Would not light through 1/4" opening). Could not start 6 5/8" casing. Split collar at 1323 and started pipe. Palled casing up to 1200 ft. and filled hole with clay to 1200 ft. and put in cement plug. Palled casing up to 845, filled hole with clay and put in another cement plug. Palled casing filled with clay to 268. Put in cement from 268 to 200. Filled to top of hole with clay.

Description of monument: Concrete block 5 ft. long, 8" square, with 3" hole extending through the center from end to end. Extends 30" above and 30" below the surface. Inscription - " H. N. G. 2722 "
