and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Lima Gas Co. well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the

10th day of May 19 37 and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged: Filled with clay from bottom 2659' to 2617' 21' above the Barea Sand. Wood plug to 2614'. Cement to 2604'. Permanent bridge set at 2494'. Red clay to 2285'. Wood plug to 2282'. Cement to 2272'. Permanent bridge at 2110'. Clay to 2050'. Wood plug to 2047'. Cement to 2037'. Sealing Exxon Sand. Permanent bridge set at 1660'. Red clay to 1415'. Wood plug to 1412'. Cement to 1402'. Sealing Salt Sand. Permanent bridge at 1035'. Clay to 800'. Wood plug to 797'. Cement to 792'. Sealing hole. Permanent bridge set at 150' and filled to surface with clay.

1 piece 6" pipe set in cement block extending above surface about 36"
