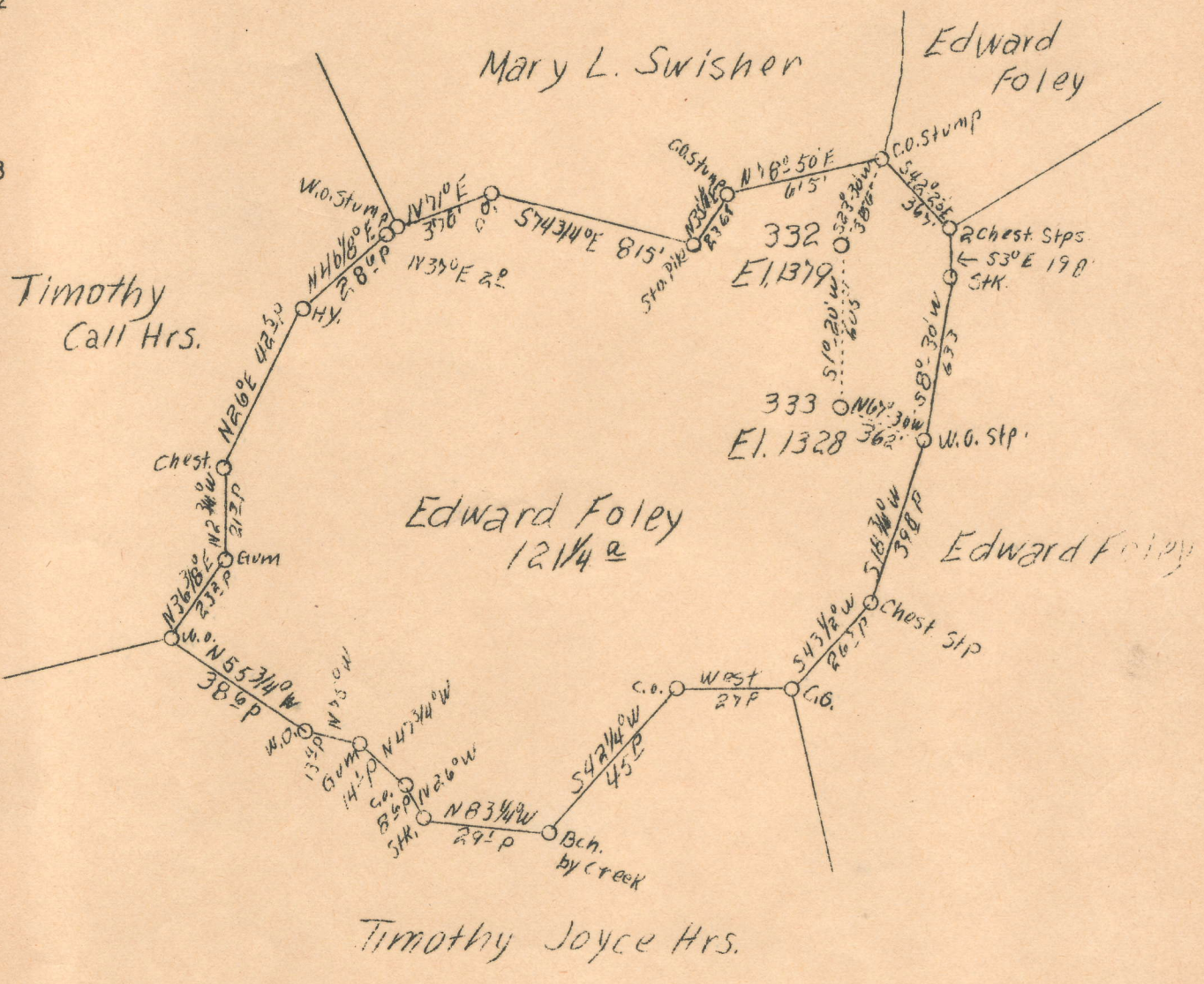

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by *Head & Kiser* well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the *10th* day of *Aug.* 193*5*, 19*35*, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged: Filled with clay from *244'-254'-20'* above
Pig Injun Sand Wood plug *234'-234'*
Cemented *234'-234'* - Sealing *Pig Injun*
Pulled *6-5/8" casing* Filled with clay from *1333'-1400'* Bottom of Salt sand
Wood plug *1400'-1477'* and on each of cement on plug.
clay from *1477'-1705'-10'* below *6" casing* Wood plug *1705'-1702'*

Manner in which coal was plugged: Cemented *1702'-1697'*
as casing lifted continued to cement *1692'*
filled with clay from *1692'-1333'*
PLACED A PERMANENT BRIDGE *1333'-922'-30'* below *Pittsburgh Coal* seam
Block of cement on bridge and cemented from *922'-860'* 20' above
Pittsburgh Coal : Clay from *860'-250'* cemented *250'-240'* and
from this point to the surface the hole was filled with clay.

Description of monument:
A cement marker such as is required by Rule 10,
1931 regulations to be ERECTED.
