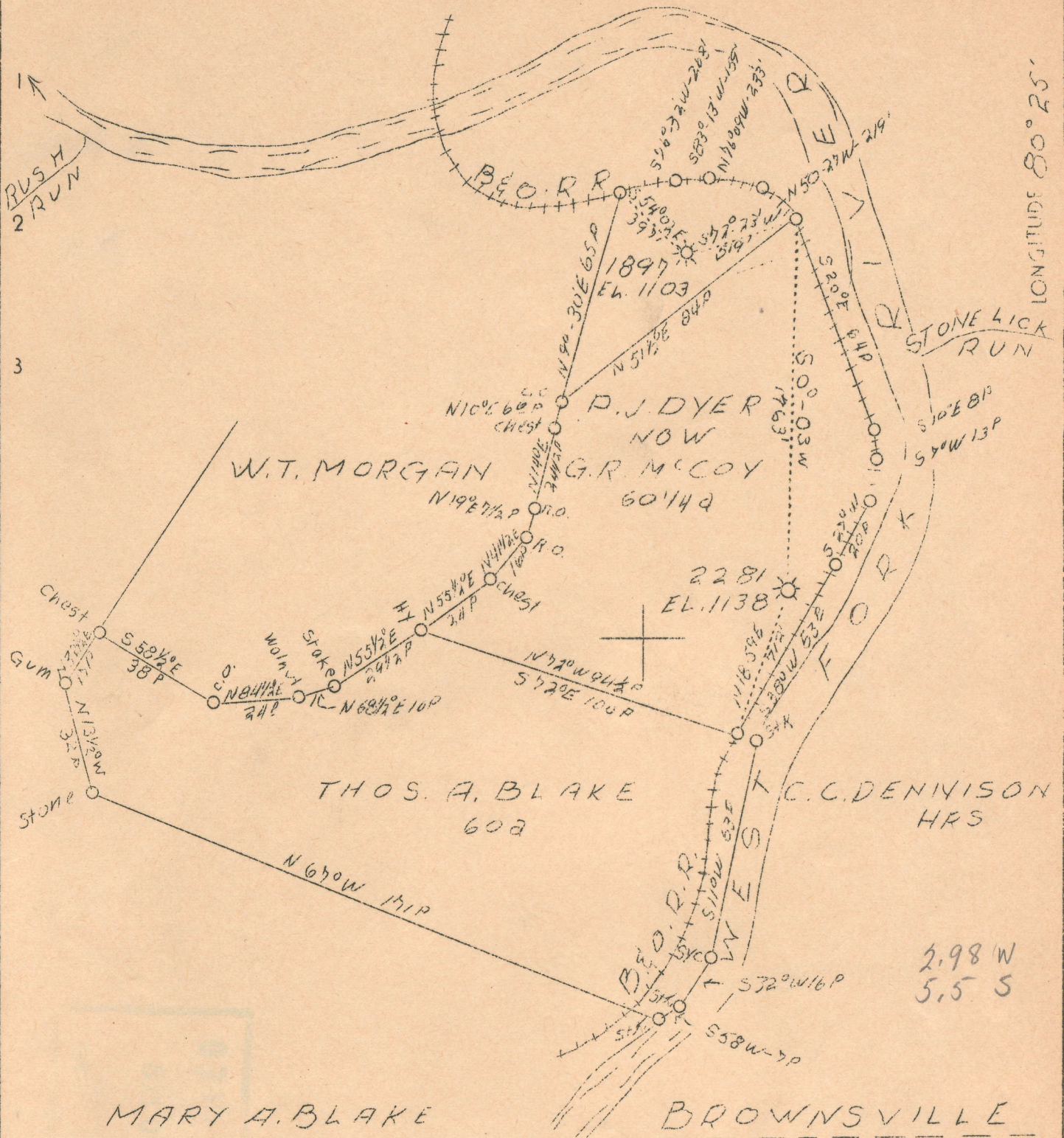

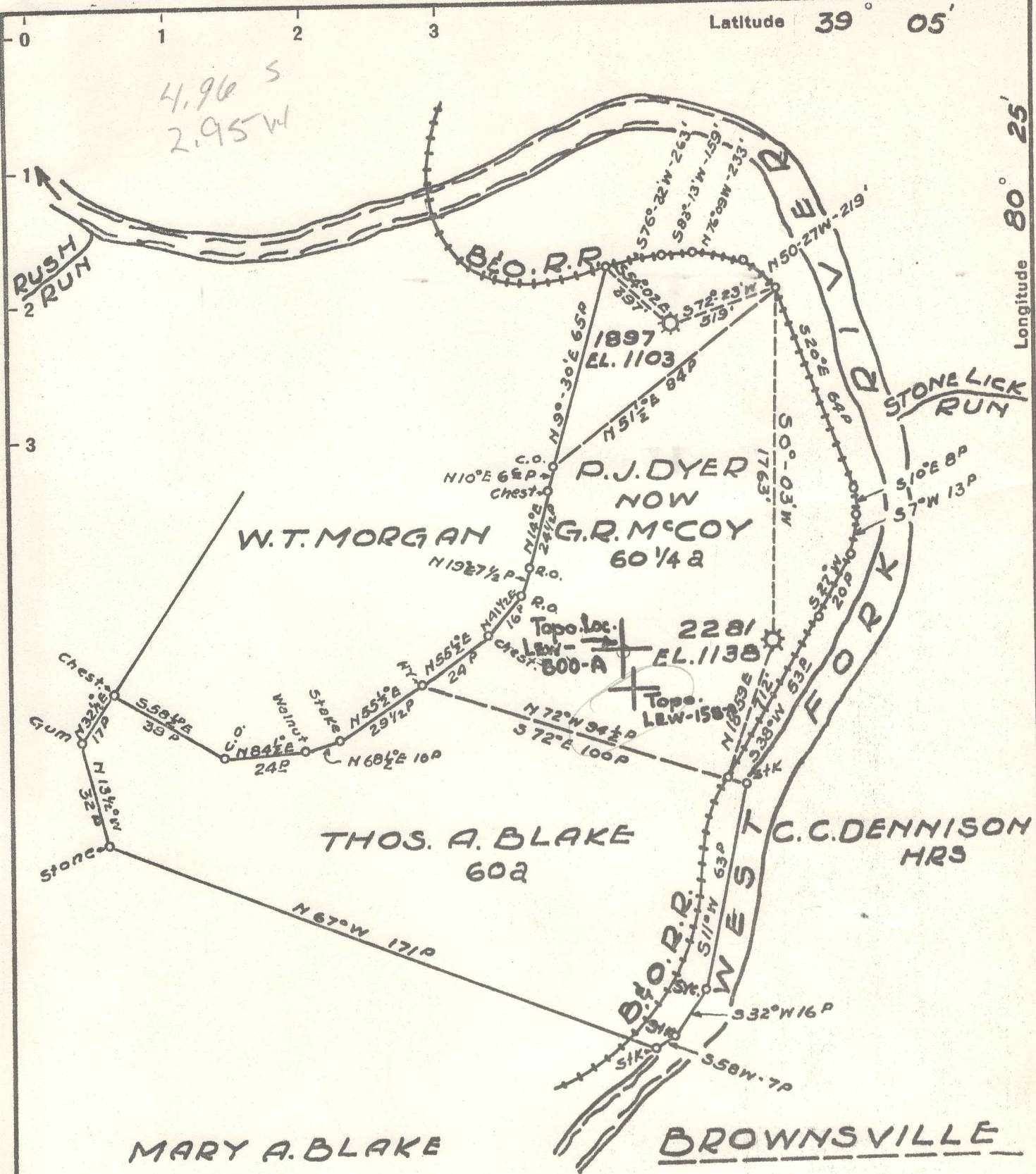

best duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of

plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Hope Natural Gas Company, operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work

commenced on the 12th day of September, 19 38, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged:

Total depth 2302. Filled with clay to 2192 and drove 6" wood plug. Installed bridge at 2054 and filled to 1930 with clay. Drove 6 5/8" lead plug at 1930. Pulled 145 ft. of 6 5/8" casing leaving 464 ft. hole. Filled to 1850 with clay. Ran cement plug at 1850. Installed bridge at 1860. Filled with clay to 1700 and run cement plug. Bridged hole at 1550 ft. and run cement plug. Filled with clay to 145 ft. and cemented solid from 155 to 100 ft. Filled to top with clay. All gas entirely shut off (24 hr. test).

Manner in which coal was plugged:

Description of monument: Concrete block 5 ft. long, 8" square, with 3" hole extending through center from end to end. Extends 30" above and 30" below surface. Inscription " H. N. G. No. 2261 "
