F. P. McKeen and
being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging

and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by South Penn Oil Company, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the

8 day of October, 1929, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which said well was plugged: Well was filled up with casing and tools to a depth of 1856', drove 8 1/2"x3' wood plug in top of 8 1/2" casing at a depth of 1856', filled up with rock, sand and clay to a depth of 1710', then pulled 169' 9" of 8 1/2" casing. Drove 10"x3' wood plug to bridge at a depth of 971', filled up with rock, sand and clay to a depth of 782', then drove another 10"x3' wood plug at a depth of 782', filled up with rock and sand to a depth of 744', then run 11' of perforated tubing below packer to a depth of 744', top of packer 730', then filled hole with cement and sand to a depth of 629', then parted and pulled 159' of 10" casing, 782' tubing on top of packer with upright perforation 8' above floor of derrick, hole filled up with rock and sand to a depth of 8' below ground, then cemented up hole with cement and sand to top of ground. Used cleaning out tools to do plugging.
