Gentlemen,-

Your letter of the 21st instant, asking for records and plugging data on well #376 on the Sax farm, in Marion County,

We have examined our records and find a record as to the log of the well, which I herewith enclose. This well was dry, and abandoned at the time it was drilled. The well was done by a contractor, John M. Crawford. Our records enclose a certificate as to the manner in which the well was abandoned. The only production discovered in the well was light gas at 1755 feet. The well was completed in September, 1925.

We regret that we are unable to furnish you with information other than that contained in the enclosed record. In sending a copy of this letter, together with the log of the well, to the Department of Mines.
