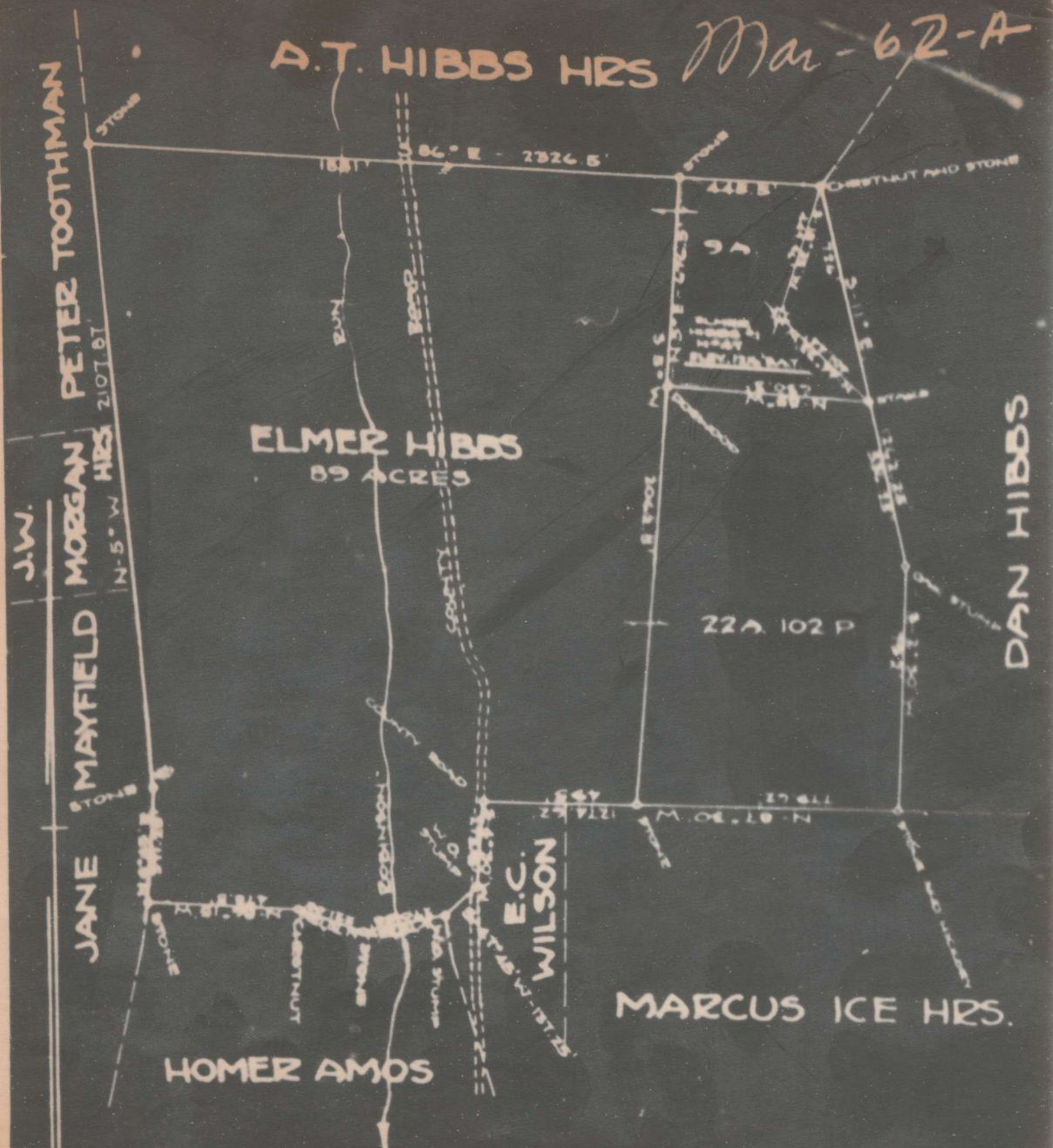

This well was started Nov. 6th, 1912. The wire line sawed a hole in the 6-5/8" casing, causing the cable to break and the tools were lost at 950' on Nov. 20th. The rig was skidded 25 ft. and a new hole started on January 16, 1913.

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging
Monongahela West Penn
and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Public Service Company, well operator,
and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the

22nd day of June, 1933, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Filled hole with red mud from the bottom 2977 ft. to 2800 ft. Drove white pine plug at 2800 ft. Filled hole with mud and clay from 2800 ft. to 1820 ft. Drove white pine plug at 1820 ft. Filled hole with mud and clay from 1820 ft. to 1415 ft. Drove white pine plug at 1415 ft. Filled hole with mud and clay from 1415 ft. to 920 ft. Drove white pine plug at 920 ft. Put in cement plug on top of wooden plug from 920 ft. to 915 ft. sealing hole completely. Open hole from 915 ft. to 600 ft.

Manner in which coal was plugged: Suspended in the hole at 600 ft. a string of 2" tubing (vent pipe) with soft rope packer on the end. Ran small amount of red mud on soft rope packer and then enough cement when set to anchor 2" vent. Filled hole with red mud from this point to 584 ft. 30 ft. below Pittsburgh Coal. Cemented from 584 ft. to 525 ft. (Pittsburgh Coal) mixture 1 to 1. Filled hole with mud and clay from 525 ft. to 470 ft. Cemented from 470 ft. to 415 ft. (Sewickley Coal) mixture 1 to 1. Filled hole with mud and clay from 415 ft. to 184 ft. Cemented from 184 ft. to 122 ft. (Waynesburg Coal) mixture 1 to 1. Filled hole with mud and clay to surface.

Description of monument:
Erected permanent concrete marker at surface. Marker is 60" long extending above the ground approximately 26". It is 18" x 18" at the top and marked "Elmer Hibbs #1".

Well to be plugged and filled as follows:

Hole to be filled with mud or clay from the bottom, 2977 ft. to 2775 ft., 20 ft. above 4th Sand. Suitable plugging to be set at 2775 ft. to seal hole completely. Hole to be filled with mud or clay from 2775 ft. to 1820 ft., 20 ft. above the Big Injun Sand. Suitable plugging to be set at 1820 ft. to seal hole completely. Hole to be filled with mud or clay from 1820 ft. to 1415 ft., 20 ft. above Second Salt Sand. Suitable plugging to be set at 1415 ft. to seal hole completely. Hole to be filled with mud or clay from 1415 ft. to 910 ft., 20 ft. above Little Dunkard Sand. Suitable plugging to be set at 910 ft. to seal hole completely.

Two inch vent pipe with soft rope packer on end, to be suspended in hole at 610 ft. Small amount of red mud to be run on soft rope packer, and then a sufficient amount of cement, when set, to anchor 2" vent pipe.

Hole to be filled with red mud from this point to 584 ft., 30 ft. below Pittsburgh Coal.

Hole to be filled with cement around 2" vent pipe from 584 ft. to 525 ft., 20 ft. above Pittsburgh Coal.

Hole to be filled with mud or clay from 525 ft. to 470 ft., 30 ft. below Sewickley Coal.

Hole to be filled with cement from 470 ft. to 415 ft., 20 ft. above Sewickley Coal.

Hole to be filled with mud or clay from 415 ft. to 184 ft., 30 ft. below calculated depth of Waynesburg Coal.

Hole to be filled with cement from 184 ft. to 129 ft., 20 ft. above Waynesburg Coal.

Hole to be filled with mud or clay from 129 ft. to the surface.

Standard marker to be erected at surface.
