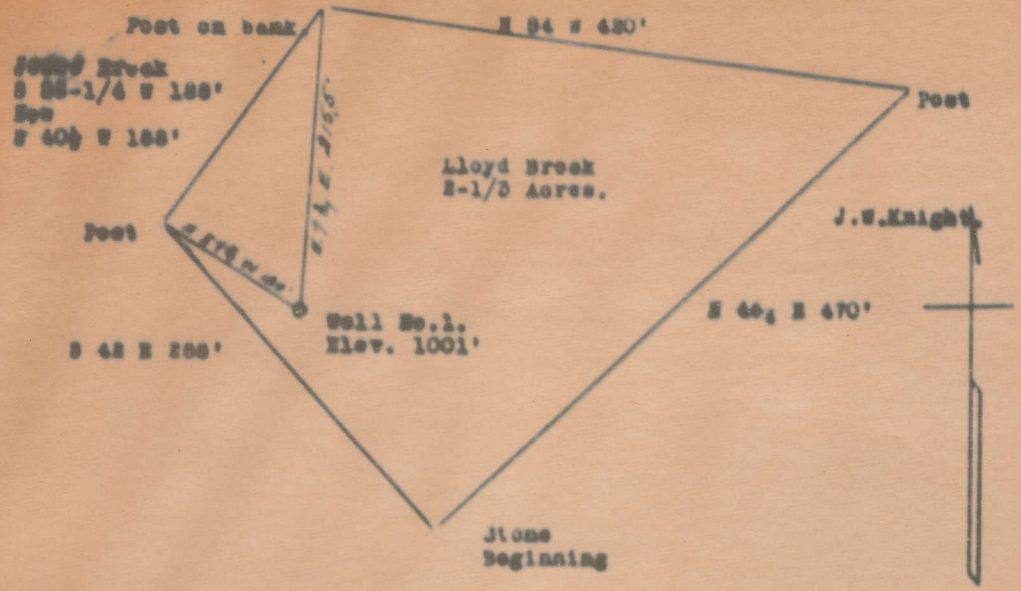

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by I. H. Boren, Contractor for well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 17th day of February, 1937, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Filled hole with clay from bottom 2198' to 2122'-20' above Gantz Sand  
Set wood plug 2122' to 2119'  
Cemented 2119' to 2109' sealing hole completely  
Filled hole with clay 2109' to 1625' -20' above Big Injun  
Set wood plug 1625' to 1622'  
Cemented 1622' to 1612' sealing hole  
Removed 6 5/8" casing.  
Anchored a permanent bridge at 1440' -30' below End Salt Sand.  
Cemented 1440' to 1430'  
Manner in which seal was plugged:  
Filled hole with clay 1430' to 1180' -20' above Salt Sand.  
Set wood plug 1180' to 1177'  
Cemented 1177' to 1167' sealing Salt Sand  
Anchored a permanent bridge at 918' -30' below Big Dunkard Sand horizon  
Filled hole with clay 918' to 873' -20' above Moundsville Sand horizon  
Set wood plug 873' to 870'  
Cemented 870' to 860' sealing hole completely.  
Left 10" casing in hole, which had been previously run in well and cemented through seal  
Description of monument: at time well was drilled.  
Erected marker according to regulations.

WORK ORDER PREPARED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES:

Remove tubing from well.  
Fill hole with clay from bottom 2198' to 2122'-20' above Gantz Sand.  
Set wood plug 2122' to 2119'  
Cement 2119' to 2109' sealing hole completely.  
Fill hole with clay 2109' to 1625'-20' above Big Injun  
Set wood plug 1625' to 1622'  
Cement 1622' to 1612' sealing hole  
Remove 6 5/8" casing.  
Anchor a permanent bridge at 1440'-30' below 2d Salt Sand.  
Cement 1440' to 1430'  
Fill hole with clay 1430' to 1180'-20' above Salt Sand.  
Set wood plug 1180' to 1177'  
Cement 1177' to 1167' sealing Salt Sand.  
Anchor a permanent bridge at 918'-30' below Big Ankard Sand horizon  
Fill hole with clay 918' to 673'-20' above Moundville Sand horizon  
Set wood plug 673' to 670'  
Cement 670' to 660' sealing hole completely.  
Remove 10" casing.  
Anchor a string of 2" tubing having a morning-glory or other suitable packer attached to its lower end at 338'-30' below Pittsburgh Coal--said tubing (vent pipe) extending to the surface and terminating as prescribed by the law.  
Cement around said vent pipe from said packer 660' to 282'-20' above Pittsburgh Coal.  
Fill hole with clay 282' to 216'-30' below Mapletown coal  
Cement 216' to 162'-20' above Mapletown Coal.  
Fill with clay to surface and erect a marker ~~such~~ as is described in Rule 18, 1931 Regulations.  
All be done in workman-like manner.
