Well was drilled June 9, 1920, to July 30, 1920.

Elevation, 1096' L.

16" casing, 16' : 10", 500'; 6-5/8", 1684'; 3" tubing, 1858'.

Hester hook wall packer, 6-5/8" x 3" x 16, set at 1752'.

3" tubing perforated at 1837-1842' and 1853-1857'.

Coal was encountered at 8-12, 308-315, and 415-421'.

Abandonment reported to Dept. of Mines April 13, 1935.

Well was shot at 1824-1865'.

Fresh water at 315 and 423'.

Gas well.
