Notification shall be given by the operator to the Oil and Gas Inspector at least 24 hours prior to the construction of roads, locations, and/or pits for any permitted work. In addition, the well operator shall notify the same inspector 24 hours before any actual well work is commenced and prior to running and cementing casing. Spills or emergency discharges must be promptly reported by the operator to 1-800-642-3074 and to the Oil and Gas Inspector.

Please be advised that form WR-35, Well Operators Report of Well Work is to be submitted to this office within 90 days of completion of permitted well work, as should form WR-34 Discharge Monitoring Report within 30 days of discharge of pits, if applicable. Failure to abide by all statutory and regulatory provisions governing all duties and operations hereunder may result in suspension or revocation of this permit and, in addition, may result in civil and/or criminal penalties being imposed upon the operators.

PERMIT CONDITIONS

West Virginia Code § 22-6A-8(d) allows the Office of Oil and Gas to place specific conditions upon this permit. Permit conditions have the same effect as law. Failure to adhere to the specified permit conditions may result in enforcement action.

CONDITIONS

- 1. This proposed activity may require permit coverage from the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE). Through this permit, you are hereby being advised to consult with USACE regarding this proposed activity.
- 2. If the operator encounters an unanticipated void, or an anticipated void at an unanticipated depth, the operator shall notify the inspector within 24 hours. Modifications to the casing program may be necessary to comply with W. Va. Code § 22-6A-5a (12), which requires drilling to a minimum depth of thirty feet below the bottom of the void, and installing a minimum of twenty (20) feet of casing. Under no circumstance should the operator drill more than one hundred (100) feet below the bottom of the void or install less than twenty (20) feet of casing below the bottom of the void.
- 3. When compacting fills, each lift before compaction shall not be more than 12 inches in height, and the moisture content of the fill material shall be within limits as determined by the Standard Proctor Density test of the actual soils used in specific engineered fill, ASTM D698, Standard Test Method for Laboratory Compaction Characteristics of Soil Using Standard Effort, to achieve 95 % compaction of the optimum density. Each lift shall be tested for compaction, with a minimum of two tests per lift per acre of fill. All test results shall be maintained on site and available for review.
- 4. Operator shall install signage per § 22-6A-8g (6) (B) at all source water locations included in their approved water management plan within 24 hours of water management plan activation.
- 5. Oil and gas water supply wells will be registered with the Office of Oil and Gas and all such wells will be constructed and plugged in accordance with the standards of the Bureau for Public Health set forth in its Legislative rule entitled *Water Well Regulations*, 64 C.S.R. 19. Operator is to contact the Bureau of Public Health regarding permit requirements. In lieu of plugging, the operator may transfer the well to the surface owner upon agreement of the parties. All drinking water wells within fifteen hundred feet of the water supply well shall be flow tested by the operator upon request of the drinking well owner prior to operating the water supply well.
- 6. Pursuant to the requirements pertaining to the sampling of domestic water supply wells/springs the operator shall, no later than thirty (30) days after receipt of analytical data provide a written copy to the Chief and any of the users who may have requested such analyses.
- 7. 24 hours prior to the initiation of the completion process the operator shall notify the Chief or his designee.
- 8. During the completion process the operator shall monitor annular pressures and report any anomaly noticed to the chief or his designee immediately.
- 9. If any explosion or other accident causing loss of life or serious personal injury occurs in or about a well or well work on a well, the well operator or its contractor shall give notice, stating the particulars of the explosion or accident, to the oil and gas inspector and the Chief, within 24 hours of said accident.
- 10. During the casing and cementing process, in the event cement does not return to the surface, the oil and gas inspector shall be notified within 24 hours.

ORDER ISSUED UNDER WEST VIRGINIA CODE, CHAPTER 22, ARTICLE 6A

INTRODUCTION

This Order (hereinafter "Order") is issued by the Office of Oil and Gas (hereinafter "OOG"), by and through its Chief, pursuant to the authority of W. Va. Code §§ 22-1-1, 22-6-1 and 22-6A-1 et seq. to Chevron Appalachia, LLC (hereinafter "Chevron" or "Operator"), collectively the "Parties."

FINDINGS OF THE CHIEF

In support of this Order, the Chief hereby finds the following:

- OOG, an office within the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, is the agency
 with the duty and authority to execute and enforce W. Va. Code §22-6-1 and §22-6A-1 et seq., and
 the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder.
 - 2. Chevron is a "person" as defined by W. Va. Code §22-6-1(n), with a corporate address as 800 Mountain View Drive, Smithfield, Pennsylvania.
 - 3. On April 24, 2017, Chevron submitted well work permit applications identified as API#s 47-051-01926, 47-051-01927, 47-051-01928, 47-051-01929, 47-051-01930, 47-051-01931, 47-051-01932 and 47-051-01933. The eight proposed wells are to be located on the Hines Pad in Washington District of Marshall County, West Virginia.
 - 4. On April 24, 2017, Civil and Environmental Consultants, Inc. (CEC), on behalf of Chevron, requested a waiver for Wetlands 2A, 2B, 3A, and 3B outlined in Attachment 1, from well location restriction requirements in W. Va. Code §22-6A-12(b) for the well work permit applications identified as API#s 47-051-01926, 47-051-01927, 47-051-01928, 47-051-01929, 47-051-01930, 47-051-01931, 47-051-01932 and 47-051-01933. Wetlands 3A and 3B will be excluded from this waiver due to being located outside the area of the pad LOD.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. West Virginia Code §22-1-6(d) requires, in part, that "[i]n addition to other powers, duties and responsibilities granted and assigned to the secretary by this chapter, the secretary is authorized and empowered to...(3) Enter private lands to make surveys and inspections for environmental protection purposes; to investigate for violations of statutes or rules which the Office of Oil and Gas is charged with enforcing; to serve and execute warrants and processes; to make arrests; issue orders, which for the purposes of this chapter include consent agreements; and to otherwise enforce the statutes or rules which the Office of Oil and Gas is charged with enforcing."
- 2. West Virginia Code §22-6A-2(a)(6) requires, in part, that "Concomitant with the broad powers to condition the issuance of well work permits, the secretary should also have broad authority to waive certain minimum requirements of this article when, in his or her discretion, such waiver is appropriate: *Provided*, That the secretary shall submit a written report of the number of waivers granted to the Legislature commencing January 1, 2013, and each year thereafter."
- 3. West Virginia Code §22-6A-12(b) requires, in part, that "[n]o well pad may be prepared or well drilled within one hundred feet measured horizontally from any perennial stream, natural or artificial lake, pond or reservoir, or a wetland, or within three hundred feet of a naturally reproducing trout stream. No well pad may be located within one thousand feet of a surface or ground water intake of a public water supply. The distance from the public water supply as identified by the Office of Oil and Gas shall be measured as follows: (1) For a surface water intake on a lake or reservoir, the distance shall be measured from the boundary of the lake or reservoir. (2) For a surface water intake on a flowing stream, the distance shall be measured from a semicircular radius extending upstream of the surface water intake. (3) For a groundwater source, the distance shall be measured from the wellhead or spring. The Office of Oil and Gas may, in its discretion, waive these distance restrictions upon submission of a plan identifying sufficient measures, facilities or practices to be employed during well site construction, drilling and operations to protect the waters of the state. A waiver, if granted, shall impose any permit conditions as the secretary considers necessary."

ORDER

West Virginia Code §22-6A-12(b) requires, in part, that "[n]o well pad may be prepared or well drilled within one hundred feet measured horizontally from any perennial stream, natural or artificial lake, pond or reservoir, or a wetland. The Office of Oil and Gas grants the request for a waiver for Wetlands 2A and 2B from well location restriction requirements in W. Va. Code §22-6A-12(b) for the well work permit applications identified as API#s 47-051-01926, 47-051-01927, 47-051-01928, 47-051-01929, 47-051-01930, 47-051-01931, 47-051-01932 and 47-051-01933. The Office of Oil and Gas hereby **ORDERS** that Chevron shall meet the following site construction and operational requirements for the Hines Well Pad:


- a. A berm shall be constructed around the perimeter of the pad to contain any potential spills and storm water runoff. Berm is to be at least twenty-four inches (24") in height;
- b. Erosion control blankets shall be installed on all slopes and down gradient locations of the pad as erosion and sediment controlling BMPs;
- c. Wetland 2A shall have two layers of eighteen-inch (18") compost filter sock trap to prevent sediment from reaching the wetlands.
- d. Wetland 2B shall have two layers of twenty-four inch (24") compost filter sock trap to prevent sediment from reaching the wetlands.
- e. Disturbed areas not used for operations shall be seeded and mulched per the seeding tables in the WVDEP-OOG Erosion and Sediment Control Manual;
- f. Drill cuttings and associated drilling mud shall be disposed of in a permitted landfill;
- g. Waste generated by the flowback treatment systems shall be sent to offsite disposal at a permitted landfill;
- h. Weekly site inspections shall be conducted to monitor and maintain the integrity of the BMP storm water controls;
- i. Weekly storm water and spill prevention inspections shall be conducted focusing on storm water and spill prevention BMPs and maintenance of these BMPs;
- j. Inspections of the storm water and spill prevention measures shall be conducted after any major storm event defined as a half inch (½") rain within any twenty-four (24) hour period;
- k. Pad inspections shall be conducted no less than once a week to identify and mitigate potential deficiencies;
- l. All records from inspections shall be maintained on site for the life of the project and be available upon request.

1.0 INTRODUCTON

On behalf of Chevron Appalachia, LLC (Chevron), Civil & Environmental Consultants, Inc. (CEC) is submitting a Wetland and Perennial Stream Waiver Request form pursuant to Chapter 22 Article 6A Section 12 of the West Virginia Code. Chevron is requesting a waiver to construct a natural gas well pad within 100 feet of four (4) palustrine emergent wetlands for their proposed Hines Well Pad Project located in Washington District, Marshall County, West Virginia.

Chevron is proposing to construct a natural gas well pad and associated access road. The total limit of disturbance (LOD) for the project is approximately 19 acres. The waiver request form is included in Attachment A. The following figures are included in Attachment B: Site Location Map, Aquatics Impact Map, and Wetland Waiver Request Figure. The Erosion & Sediment Control (E&S) Plan is included in Attachment C. Existing wetlands and streams were delineated by qualified CEC biologists on September 9, 2015 and October 18, 2016. The following section provides additional information as required by the waiver.

2.0 WETLAND WAIVER REQUEST

Question 1: Describe the proposed project location, including unique identifying names of all wetlands, and the names of perennial streams for which the waiver is sought.

The proposed Hines Well Pad Project is located off Campbell Hill Road in Washington District, Marshall County, West Virginia southeast of the City of Moundsville, as shown on the Site Location Map. The project's proposed LOD is located within 100 feet of four (4) wetlands shown on the Aquatic Impacts Map. The approximate distance of each wetland to the nearest boundary of the LOD is as follows:

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- Wetland 2A 44 linear feet;
- Wetland 2B 0.4 linear feet;
- Wetland 3A 25 linear feet; and
- Wetland 3B 41 linear feet.

No perennial streams are located within 100 feet of the project LOD. A waiver is not being requested for the wetlands and the ephemeral stream located within the LOD, which includes Wetlands 1A and 1B and an unnamed tributary (UNT) 1 to Toms Run. Chevron is requesting authorization from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Pittsburgh District for impacts to these features. A copy of the Nationwide Permit 39 Application to the USACE for these impacts is included in Attachment D.

Question 2: Justify the proposed activity by describing alternatives to this project that were considered.

a. Include a No-Action Alternative as to show "the future without the project".

The No-Action alternative represents "no alteration" of the existing environment, meaning the site would not be developed and no immediate environmental impacts would occur. Oil and gas extraction would not occur at this site, and Chevron would be required to find an alternative site. This option is highly undesirable and would not fulfill the project's purpose and need.

b. Location alternatives must be shown.

The current single well pad and access road design approach of the Hines Well Pad combines three separate well pads and access roads that were conceptually planned by Chevron in the vicinity of the Hines Well Pad location. The overall earth disturbance of three separate projects would have been greater than the current one pad and access road project. Further, on the Hines property, the current location is the primary desired location due to the size of the proposed well pad and the steep topography of the surrounding area. Minor adjustments to the dimensions of the proposed well pad were made during the conceptual planning phase of the project; however, the current location of the well pad has remained unchanged due to the limitations listed about the steep topography of the well pad is optimized for the extraction and production equipment that will be steep topography of the well pad is optimized for the extraction and production equipment that will be steep topography of the well pad is optimized for the extraction and production equipment that will be steep topography of the well pad. 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c. Must demonstrate why a one hundred foot buffer cannot be maintained.

Maintaining a 100-foot buffer from all on-site wetlands is not feasible due to topographic constraints and locations of the existing features. The four (4) wetlands that are located within 100 feet of the LOD are located on the southern side of the proposed well pad and access road. In order to maintain a 100-foot buffer from the four (4) wetlands, the well pad and access road would need to be shifted north, which is not feasible due to the steep topography located to the north of the proposed well pad. In addition, shifting the access to the north would cause the LOD to be within 100 feet of Wetland 5.

The other alternative to meet the setback requirements would be a reduction in the project's footprint; however, the proposed design represents the minimum footprint required to meet the project's purpose and need. A reduction in the well pad's limits would mean the project could not be developed.

d. Describe how the proposed project is the least environmentally damaging practicable alternative.

As stated above, the current Hines Well Pad has been designed to take the place of three separate well pad and access road projects. As such, the singular well pad and access road will have less earth disturbance than the three separate projects. The current proposed Hines Well Pad design represents the alternative which reduces permanent impacts to the greatest degree practicable. Shifting the proposed well pad south or north would create higher fill slopes, and greater disturbance to existing streams and wetlands.

Question 3: Identify sufficient measures, facilities or practices to be employed during well site construction, drilling and operations to protect waters of the state. This description should include all additional erosion and sediment control measures and devices that will be used.

As part of the well pad permitting process, Pad project which stipulates implementations to reduce soil erosion, compactor, sedimentation of receiving streams and wetlands. The following measures will be left presented of Oil and Gas

• Compost filter sock traps will be positioned downslope of larger drainage areas and

Compost time some upslope of the existing wetlands and/or epnemeral success.

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- Orange construction fence will be erected along the edge of the LOD to clearly mark and help protect the wetlands from being impacted during construction operations;
- Erosion control blanket will be placed on slopes greater than 3 Horizontal to 1 Vertical (3H:1V) to limit erosion and promote vegetative growth;
- Riprap aprons will be constructed at the outfalls of pipes to dissipate runoff:
- Disturbed areas within the LOD shall be stabilized within 21 days of construction activity temporarily or permanently ceasing; and
- The ephemeral stream located within the LOD and downgradient of the proposed fill slope toe-key outlet drain will be restored to approximate original dimensions and lined with riprap.

Ouestion 4: Provide mapping, plans, specifications and design analysis for the preferred alternative to the project.

a. Specify in writing what additional controls, measures, devices, monitoring, etc. will be used to protect wetlands and/or perennial streams for which the waiver is sought.

Refer to the E&S Plan and details in Attachment C for locations of erosion control measures, specifications on installation and maintenance requirements, and the construction sequence.

Pursuant to W. Va. Code R. § 35-8-5.7.a, the operator shall provide the Well Site Safety Plan to the surface owner and any water purveyor or surface owner subject to notice and water testing as provided in section 15 of this rule.

Pursuant to W. Va. Code R. § 35-8-15.2.c, this notice shall: (1) contain a statement of the surface owner's and water purveyor's right to request sampling and analysis; (2) advise the surface owner and water purveyor of the rebuttable presumption for contamination or deprivation of a fresh water source or supply; advise the surface owner and water purveyor that refusal to allow the operator to conduct a pre-drilling water well test constitutes a method to rebut the presumption of liability; (3) advise the surface owner and water purveyor of his or her independent right to sample and analyze any water supply at his or her own expense; advise the surface owner and water purveyor whether or not the operator will utilize an independent laboratory to analyze any sample; and (4) advise the surface owner and or water purveyor that he or she can obtain from the Chief a list of water testing laboratories in the subject area capable of and qualified to test water supplies in accordance with standard acceptable methods.

Well Location Restrictions

Pursuant to W. Va. Code § 22-6A-12, Wells may not be drilled within two hundred fifty feet measured horizontally from any existing water well or developed spring used for human or domestic animal consumption. The center of well pads may not be located within six hundred twenty-five feet of an occupied dwelling structure, or a building two thousand five hundred square feet or larger used to house or shelter dairy cattle or poultry husbandry. This limitation is applicable to those wells, developed springs, dwellings or agricultural buildings that existed on the date a notice to the surface owner of planned entry for surveying or staking as provided in section ten of this article or a notice of intent to drill a horizontal well as provided in subsection (b), section sixteen of this article was provided, whichever occurs first, and to any dwelling under construction prior to that date. This limitation may be waived by written consent of the surface owner transmitted to the department and recorded in the real property records maintained by the clerk of the county commission for the county in which such property is located. Furthermore, the well operator may be granted a variance by the secretary from these distance restrictions upon submission of a plan which identifies the sufficient measures, facilities or practices to be employed during well site construction, drilling and operations. The variance, if granted, shall include terms and conditions the department requires to ensure the safety and protection of affected persons and property. The terms and conditions may include insurance, bonding and indemnification, as well as technical requirements. (b) No well pad may be prepared or well drilled within one hundred feet measured horizontally from any perennial stream, natural or artificial lake, pond or reservoir, or a wetland, or within three hundred feet of a naturally reproducing trout stream. No well pad may be located within one thousand feet of a surface or ground water intake of a public water supply. The distance from the public water supply as identified by the department shall be measured as follows: (1) For a surface water intake on a lake or reservoir, the distance shall be measured from the boundary of the lake or reservoir. (2) For a surface water intake on a flowing stream, the distance shall be measured from a semicircular radius extending upstream of the surface water intake. (3) For a groundwater source, the distance shall be measured from the wellhead or spring. The department may, in its discretion, waive these distance restrictions upon submission of a plan identifying sufficient measures, facilities or practices to be employed during well site construction, drilling and operations to protect the waters of the state A waiver, if granted, shall impose any permit conditions as the secretary considers necessary. (c) Notwithstanding the foregon and secretary considers necessary. permit conditions as the secretary considers necessary. (c) Notwithstanding the foregon provisions which section, nothing contained in this section prevents an operator from conducting the activities permitted or authorized by a Colin Higher Act Section 404 permit or other approval from the United States Army Corps of Engineers within any waters of the state or within the respected areas referenced in this section. (d) The well location restrictions set forth in this section shall not apply to any well are an untiple well pad if at least one of the wells was permitted prior to the effective date of this article. (e) The secretary shall, by December 31, 2012, report to the Legislature on the noise, light, dust and volatile organic compounds generated by the dilling of horizontal wells as they relate to the well location restrictions regarding occupied dwelling structures pursuant to this direction, if any, by the secretary that the well location restrictions regarding occupied dwelling structures are inadequate or other wild expire alteration to address the items

examined in the study required by this subsection, the secretary shall have the authority to propose for promulgation legislative rules establishing guidelines and procedures regarding reasonable levels of noise, light, dust and volatile organic compounds relating to drilling horizontal wells, including reasonable means of mitigating such factors, if necessary.

Water Well Testing:

Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-10(d), notification shall be made, with respect to surface landowners identified in subsection (b) or water purveyors identified in subdivision (5), subsection (b) of this section, of the opportunity for testing their water well. The operator shall provide an analysis to such surface landowner or water purveyor at their request.

Water Testing Laboratories:

Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-10(i), persons entitled to notice pursuant to subsection (b) of this section may contact the department to ascertain the names and locations of water testing laboratories in the subject area capable and qualified to test water supplies in accordance with standard accepted methods. In compiling that list of names the department shall consult with the state Bureau for Public Health and local health departments. A surface owner and water purveyor has an independent right to sample and analyze any water supply at his or her own expense. The laboratory utilized by the operator shall be approved by the agency as being certified and capable of performing sample analyses in accordance with this section.

Rebuttable Presumption for Contamination or Deprivation of a Fresh Water Source or Supply:

W. Va. Code § 22-6A-18 requires that (b) unless rebutted by one of the defenses established in subsection (c) of this section, in any action for contamination or deprivation of a fresh water source or supply within one thousand five hundred feet of the center of the well pad for horizontal well, there is a rebuttable presumption that the drilling and the oil or gas well or either was the proximate cause of the contamination or deprivation of the fresh water source or supply. (c) In order to rebut the presumption of liability established in subsection (b) of this section, the operator must prove by a preponderance of the evidence one of the following defenses: (1) The pollution existed prior to the drilling or alteration activity as determined by a predrilling or prealteration water well test. (2) The landowner or water purveyor refused to allow the operator access to the property to conduct a predrilling or prealteration water well test. (3) The water supply is not within one thousand five hundred feet of the well. (4) The pollution occurred more than six months after completion of drilling or alteration activities. (5) The pollution occurred as the result of some cause other than the drilling or alteration activity. (d) Any operator electing to preserve its defenses under subdivision (1), subsection (c) of this section shall retain the services of an independent certified laboratory to conduct the predrilling or prealteration water well test. A copy of the results of the test shall be submitted to the department and the surface owner or water purveyor in a manner prescribed by the secretary. (e) Any operator shall replace the water supply of an owner of interest in real property who obtains all or part of that owner's supply of water for domestic, agricultural, industrial or other legitimate use from an underground or surface source with a comparable water supply where the secretary determines that the water supply has been affected by contamination, diminution or interruption proximately caused by the oil or gas operation, unless waived in writing by that owner. (f) The secretary may order the operator conducting the oil or gas operation to: (1) Provide an emergency drinking water supply within twenty-four hours; (2) Provide temporary water supply within seventy-two hours; (3) Within thirty days begin activities to establish a permanent water supply or submit a proposal to the secretary outlining the measures and timetables to be used in establishing a permanent supply. The total time in providing a permanent water supply may not exceed two years. If the operator demonstrates that providing a permanent replacement water supply cannot be completed within two years, the secretary may extend the time frame on case-by-case basis; and (4) Pay all reasonable costs incurred by the real property owner in securing a water supply. (g) A person as described in subsection (b) of this section aggrieved under the provisions of subsections (b), (e) or (f) of this section may seek relief in court... (i) Notwithstanding the denial of the operator of responsibility for the damage to the real property owner's water supply or the status of any appeal on determination of liability for the damage to the real property owner's water supply, the operator may not discontinue providing the required water service until authorized to do so by the secretary or a court of competent jurisdiction.

Time Limits and Methods for Filing Comments.

The law requires these materials to be served on or before the date the operator files its Application. You have **THIRTY** (30) **DAYS** after the filing date to file your comments. Comments must be filed in person or received in the mail by the Chief's office by the time stated above. You may call the Chief's office to be sure of the date. Check with your postmaster to ensure adequate delivery time or to arrange special expedited handling. If you have been contacted by the well operator and you have signed a "voluntary statement of no objection" to the planned work described in these materials, then the permit may be issued at any time.

Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-11(c)(2), Any objections of the affected coal operators and coal seam owners and lessees shall be addressed through the processes and procedures that exist under sections fifteen, seventeen and forty, article six of this chapter, as applicable and as incorporated into this article by section five of this article. The written comments filed by the parties entitled to notice under subdivisions (1), (2), (4), (5) and (6), subsection (b), section ten of this article shall be considered by the secretary in the permit issuance process, but the parties are not entitled to participate in the processes and proceedings that exist under sections fifteen, seventeen or forty, article six of this chapter, as applicable and as incorporated into this article by section five of this article.

Comment Requirements

Your comments must be in writing and include your name, address and telephone number, the well operator's name and well number and the approximate location of the proposed well site including district and county from the application. You may add other documents, such as sketches, maps or photographs to support your comments.

Disclaimer: All comments received will be placed on our web site http://www.dep.wv.gov/oil-and-gas/Horizontal-Permits/Pages/default.aspx and the applicant will automatically be forwarded an email notice that such comments have been submitted. The applicant will be expected to provide a response to comments submitted by any surface owner, water purveyor or natural gas storage operator noticed within the application.


Permit Denial or Condition

The Chief has the power to deny or condition a well work permit. Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-8(d), the permit may not be issued or be conditioned, including conditions with respect to the location of the well and access roads prior to issuance if the director determines that:

- (1) The proposed well work will constitute a hazard to the safety of persons;
- (2) The plan for soil erosion and sediment control is not adequate or effective;
- (3) Damage would occur to publicly owned lands or resources; or
- (4) The proposed well work fails to protect fresh water sources or supplies.

A permit may also be denied under West Virginia Code § 22-6A-7(k), the secretary shall deny the issuance of a permit if the secretary determines that the applicant has committed a substantial violation of a previously issued permit for a horizontal well, including the applicable erosion and sediment control plan associated with the previously issued permit, or a substantial violation of one or more of the rules promulgated under this article, and in each instance has failed to abate or seek review of the violation within the time prescribed by the secretary pursuant to the provisions of subdivisions (1) and (2), subsection (a), section five of this article and the rules promulgated hereunder, which time may not be unreasonable.

Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-10(g), any person entitled to submit written comments to the secretary pursuant to subsection (a), section eleven of this article, shall also be entitled to receive from the secretary a copy of the permit as issued or a copy of the order modifying or denying the permit if the person requests receipt of them as a part of the written comments submitted concerning the permit application. Such persons may request, at the time of submitting written comments, notice of the permit decision and a list of persons qualified to test water.


