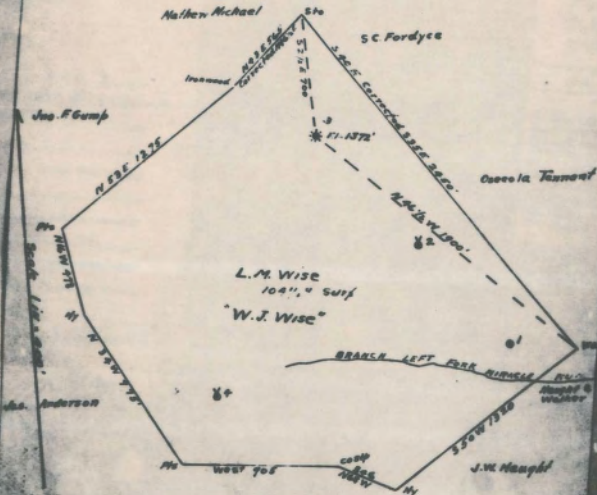

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging

and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by SOUTH FIRM OIL COMPANY, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 27th day of July, 1931, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which well was plugged: Well drilled to total depth of 3287' July 1930 and filled back up to 3450' at that time. Hole filled with stone from 3450' to 2764'. 5 3/16" x 3' Wood Plug drove to 2761'. Stone and red mud from 2761' to 2706'. 5 3/16" casing cut and pulled at 2398'. Cavings, Red Mud and stone from 2706' to 2319'. 6 5/8" x 3' Wood Plug drove to 2316'. Red mud from 2316' to 2315'. 6 5/8" x 3' Lead Plug drove to 2315'. Stone and Red Mud from 2315' to 2265'. 6 5/8" casing cut and pulled at 1890'. Stone from 2265' to 1110'. 2" Vent Pipe from 1110' to surface. Vent Pipe perforated from 1110' to 1099'. Morning Glory Fucker set at 1099'. Red Mud from 1099' to 1060'. Vent pipe encased in cement from 1060' to 1040'. Stone from 1040' to surface.

Description of monument: Concrete monument erected 8" x 8" top, 10" x 10" bottom, 44" high, bearing the following inscription, S. F. O. Co. W. J. Wise No. 3 Abd. Aug. 1931.

AND THE ABOVE DESCRIBED MONUMENT BEING IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 5, ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 23 OF THE CODE AND THAT THE WORK OF PLUGGING AND FILLING SAID WELL WAS COMPLETED ON THE 15th day of September 1931.
