
Gentlemen;

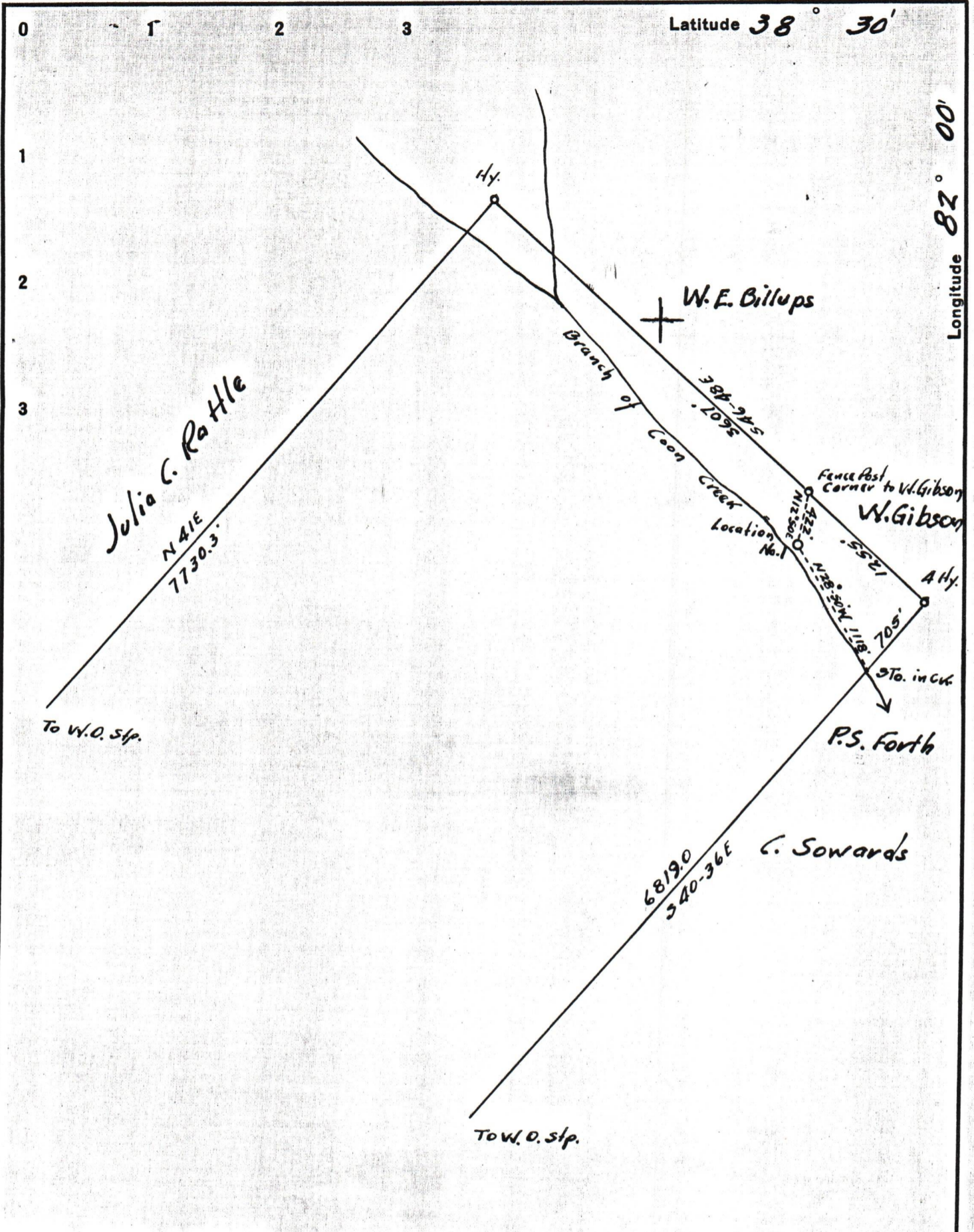
