PROPOSED MANNER OF PLUGGING AND FILLING WELL

(REQUIRED BY RULES AND REGULATIONS)

WEST VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF MINES

WORK ORDER

Well to be plugged and filled as follows:

Fill with clay from 1940 feet, bottom of hole, to 1843 feet; being 20 feet above squaw sand, here wooden plug will be driven with concrete on top of same.

Fill with clay from 1843 feet to 1738 feet, *Pucc 5 3/16"* being 20 feet above Keener Sand, here wooden plug will be driven with concrete on top of same.

Fill with clay from 1738 feet to 1673 feet, being 20 feet above Big Lime Sand, here wooden plug will be driven with concrete on top of same.

Fill with clay from 1673 feet to 1060 feet, being 20 feet above gas sand, here wooden plug will be driven with concrete on top. *Pucc 6 7/8 casing*

Fill with clay from 1060 feet to 150 feet being approximately 10 feet below largest string of casing, here a wooden plug will be driven, with concrete on top. *Pucc-10"*

Fill with clay from 150 feet to top of hole, here cement marker will be placed, at least 6" x 18".
