Said coal operators are further notified that forms for use in making such objections will be furnished to them by the Department of Mines promptly on request and that all such objections must set forth as definitely as is reasonably possible the ground or grounds on which such objections are based and indicate the direction and distance the proposed location should be moved to overcome same.

WORK ORDER SUPPLIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES:

Fill with clay from the bottom 2090' to 1979' - 20' above the Keener Sand.
Drive wood plug from 1979' to 1976'
Cement from 1976' to 1966' sealing the Keener and Big Injun Sands.

Continue to fill with clay from 1966' to 1915' - 3' below the
5-3/16" casing
Drive wood plug from 1915' to 1912'
PULL 5-3/16" casing set at 1912'

Fill with clay from 1912' to 1816' - 20' above the Maxon Sand.
Drive wood plug from 1816' to 1813'
Cement from 1813' to 1803' sealing the Maxon Sand, and below the Salt Sand.

Continue to fill with clay from 1803' to 1692' - 20' above the First
Salt Sand.
Cement from 1692' to 1682'

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 1155' - 30' below the Big Dunkard Sand.
Fill with clay from 1155' to 1123'
Drive wood plug from 1123' to 1120'
PULL 8-1/4" casing set at 1120' and
Fill with clay to 1110'

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 360'
Fill with clay from 360' to 340'
Drive wood plug from 340' to 337'
PULL ~~to~~ 10" casing set at 330' and

Fill with clay from 337' to the surface
