It was a dry hole through Berea formation, and we put it back to pumping in Injun sand, where we had small production.

The other Permit RIT-2774 for 120 acres W.A. Holt Hrs. lesse, issued July 8, 1963 has never been drilled. If I decide to drill in future, I can re-apply for this permit. I do hope this answers all your questions and that the two wells and permits are cleared.

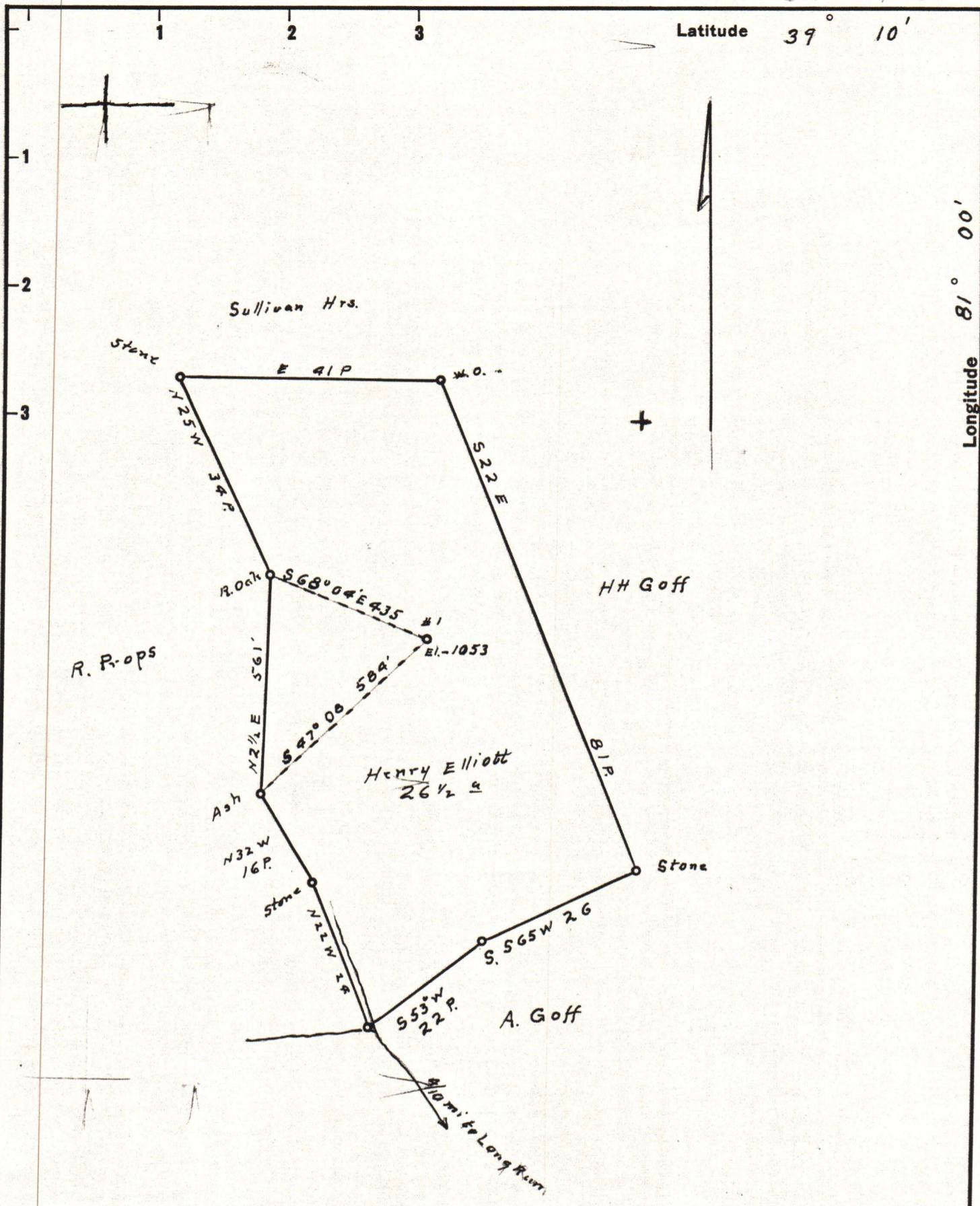

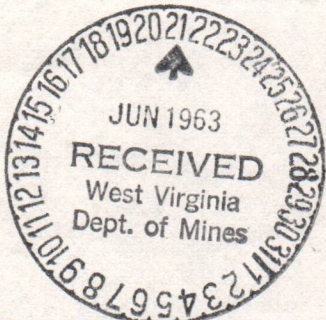

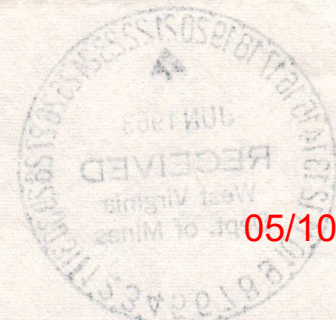

Section 3.
