Shot Dec. 22, 1915, with 20 qts. Top of shell, 2213'; bottom of shell, 2218'.

Big blown down February 1922.

Commenced pulling and plugging August 1923.

Filled up with red clay, 2025'. Put in plug and 25' more clay and pulled casing.

Abandoned August 18, 1923.
