June 19, 1910, total tube = 0.1" of water, = 39,210 cu. ft., per
 24 hrs. on a 1" pipe; multiply by 43.9 for 6" tube = 1,721,319
 cu. ft. per 24 hrs. at 32° F. For 60° F. add 2% = 1,755,245.

July 7 states pressure 450 lbs., falling to about 250 lbs. the well
 blew off.

Shot July 29, 1911, with 40 qts., at 1815-1840'; Apr. 25, 1917, with
 25 qts., at 1802-1815'.

June 6, 1917, shot hole filled with rock and red mud up 1777', last
 10' red mud, then plugged with 3' plug to 1777'; later hole
 filled with rock and dirt up to 1680'. 1 set old jars set on
 top of plug. Casing pulled June 15-16, 1917; hole caved.

13" casing, 14'; 10", 170'; 8½", 650'; 6½", 1675'.

Abandoned June 16, 1917.
