WELL WORK PLUGGING PERMIT

Plugging

This permit, API Well Number: 47-9100427, issued to ICG TYGART VALLEY, LLC, is evidence of permission granted to perform the specified well work at the location described on the attached pages and located on the attached plat, subject to the provisions of Chapter 22 of the West Virginia Code of 1931, as amended, and all rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, and to all conditions and provisions outlined in the pages attached hereto. Notification shall be given by the operator to the Oil and Gas Inspector at least 24 hours prior to the construction of roads, locations, and/or pits for any permitted work. In addition, the well operator shall notify the same inspector 24 hours before any actual well work is commenced and prior to running and cementing casing. Spills or emergency discharges must be promptly reported by the operator to 1-800-642-3074 and to the Oil and Gas inspector.

Upon completion of the plugging well work, the above named operator will reclaim the site according to the provisions of WV Code 22-6-30. The above named operator will also file, as required in WV Code 22-6-23, an affidavit on form WR-38 by two experienced persons in the operator's employment and the Oil and Gas inspector that the work authorized under this permit was performed and a description given. Failure to abide by all statutory and regulatory provisions governing all duties and operations here under may result in suspensions or revocation of this permit and in addition may result in civil and/or criminal penalities being imposed upon the operator.

EXHIBIT NO. 1

From the experience and technology developed since 1970 in plugging oil and gas wells for mining through, ICG Tygart Valley, LLC will utilize the following method to plug all future wells.

SOLID PLUG METHOD

- a) If active well: clean out to total depth and plug back according to state regulations to a minimum of 200 feet below lowest minable coal seam.
- b) If abandoned well: clean out to first plug 200 feet below lowest minable coal seam.
- c) Circulate through tubing or drill steel an expanding cement plug from a minimum of 200 feet below minable coal seam to a point 100 feet above minable coal.

Circulate through tubing or drill steel from 100 feet above coal seam to surface.

A monument will be installed with API No. and stating "solid plug".

Please keep in mind this plugging plan is based on the information taken from the Well Operator's Report of Well Work. If the information provided on the report is not correct it could change the plan to plug this well. Also, if well conditions are different than expected it could change the plugging plan as well.

Cleanout/Plugging Plan

- Day 1 Move to site, rig up, mix mud, drill rathole
- Day 2 Finish drilling rathole, start picking up 2 3/8" drill pipe and cleanout well with a 3 ¾" bit to total depth (T.D) at 5,613'.
- Day 3 Continue to pick up 2 3/8" drill pipe and cleanout to 5,613' (T.D.) Hecewed

 Trip out of the hole (T.O.H) with 2 3/8" drill pipe.

AUG 1 9 2015

- Day 4 Run cement bond log on 4 ½" casing, (calculations reached from
 the cement information taken from the report indicate the estimated
 top of the cement on the outside of the 4 ½" is 3,317"). No perforations or
 cuts are required by the State of WV since the 4 ½" casing is already
 perforated in the pay zones.
- Day 5 Trip in hole (T.I.H) with 2 3/8" drill pipe to T.D. Cement hole from 5,613' back to 3,317' with 190 sacks of Class A Cement with a gas

blocker additive. Circulate hole, condition mud, T.O.H.

- Day 6 T.I.H with 3 ¾" bit to tag top of cement plug at 3,317'. T.O.H,
 T.I.H with 4 ½" pressure pipe cutter, cut 4 ½" casing just above top
 of bonded casing at 3,317'. Lay down 2 3/8" drill pipe.
- Day 7 Continue to lay down 2 3/8" drill pipe. Rig up 4 ½" casing spear.
 Hook to 4 ½" casing at the surface, release slips from wellhead and attempt to work 4 ½" casing free to 3,317". Lay down 4 ½" casing.
- Day 8 Rig up 7 7/8" bit. Pick up drill collars and drill pipe, start cleaning hole to top of remaining 4 ½" casing at 3,317'.
- Day 9 Continue to clean hole with 7 7/8" bit to top of remaining 4 ½" casing at 3,317'. Circulate hole. T.O.H with 7 7/8" bit. T.I.H with open ended 3 ½" drill pipe.
- Day 10 Cement hole from 3,317' to within 50' of bottom of 8 5/8" casing at 1,174' with 1000 gallons of mud flush and 675 sacks of Class A cement with 4% gel. Circulate hole and condition mud. T.O.H Log hole (Caliper, Natural Gamma, Directional and Bond logs). Calculations reached from the cement information taken from the report indicates that the 8 5/8" casing was cemented to surface.
- Day 11 T.I.H with 8 5/8" section mill. Section mill 30' window in 8 5/8" casing through Lower Kittaning coal seam.
- Day 12 Continue to section mill 8 5/8" casing through Lower Kittaning coal seam.
- Day 13 Finish section milling 8 5/8" casing. T.O.H with 8 5/8" section mill. T.I.H with 7 7/8" bit.
- Day 14 Clean hole with 7 7/8" bit to top of cement plug at 1,174'.
 Circulate hole at 1,174'. T.O.H with 7 7/8" bit. Run caliper log to verify window in 8 5/8" casing. Lay down drill collars and fishing tools. Prepare to cement hole to surface.
- Day 15 Cement hole from 1,174' to surface using 262 sacks of Class A cement with 4% gel and 149 sacks of Thixatropic cement with Office of Oil & Gas green dye. Clean out mud tank. Rig down equipment and prepare to move rig to next site.


