Mr. Carder,

During file review, it was discovered that three wells permitted to Arsenal Resources LLC had previously been permitted and drilled by PDC Mountaineer LLC under the same name and location. As such, each of the following wells has two concurrent API numbers: Veltri 4HM, Veltri 5HM, and Veltri 6HM. In order to resolve this matter, the Office of Oil and Gas will revert all active documentation and records (including open permits issued 10/02/2017) from the second API to the original.
