70017 → On the crest of the Chestnut Ridge anticline, 1/4 mile southwest of McGee, two practically dry holes were drilled on the C. H. Curry (698) and John Williamson (699) farms to a depth of 2300 and 2200 feet respectively. The wells start over 600 feet below the horizon of the Pittsburgh coal; hence, both penetrated the Bayard sand and probably the horizon of the Elizabeth. A light flow of gas is reported from the Williamson boring.
