One mile seuthwest of Josephs Mills, the Centerville Oil & Gas Co. drilled a well to a depth of 1740 feet on the David W. Hess farm (T-199). A shewing of gas was encountered in the Big Injun Sand. The Washington Coal (3 feet thick) was struck at a depth of 23 feet. According to the interval given in the Mercer well above, the Pittsburgh Coal herizon should belong at near 485 feet, or 462 feet below the Washington bed, hence the authority for drawing the 350-feet structure contour on the Pittsburgh Coal to the west of this well.
