CNX Gas Company, LLC (CNX) is submitting the enclosed permit application as instructed by Laura Adkins of WVDEP in order to process the administrative change that would allow for the two above mentioned wells to be placed back into production well status.

Initially both wells were shallow production wells. Then, both wells were permitted to be converted to UIC wells. However, no physical changes were ever made to the wells in order to convert them to UIC wells. The wells both continued to produce gas as normal and CNX has been reporting the production volumes up to the current time. CNX wishes to change the classification of these wells with WVDEP from UIC back to production wells. As mentioned, it is the understanding of CNX that in order to do this, a new permit application must be submitted.
