#### WELL WORK PERMIT

#### Vertical Well

This permit, API Well Number: 47-9703853, issued to MOUNTAIN V OIL & GAS, INC., is evidence of permission granted to perform the specified well work at the location described on the attached pages and located on the attached plat, subject to the provisions of Chapter 22 of the West Virginia Code of 1931, as amended, and all rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, and to all conditions and provisions outlined in the pages attached hereto. Notification shall be given by the operator to the Oil and Gas Inspector at least 24 hours prior to the construction of roads, locations, and/or pits for any permitted work. In addition, the well operator shall notify the same inspector 24 hours before any actual well work is commenced and prior to running and cementing casing. Spills or emergency discharges must be promptly reported by the operator to 1-800-642-3074 and to the Oil and Gas inspector.

Please be advised that form WR-35, Well Operators Report of Well Work is to be submitted to this office within 90 days completion of permitted well work, as should form WR-34 Discharge Monitoring Report within 30 days of discharge of pits, if applicable. Failure to abide by all statutory and regulatory provisions governing all duties and operations hereunder may result in suspension or revocation of this permit and, in addition, may result in civil and/or criminal penalties being imposed upon the operators.

In addition to the applicable requirements of this permit, and the statutes and rules governing oil and gas activity in WV, this permit may contain specific conditions which must be followed. Permit conditions are attached to this cover letter.

Per 35CSR-4-5.2.g this permit will expire in two (2) years from the issue date unless permitted well work is commenced. If there are any questions, please feel free to contact me at (304) 926-0499 ext. 1654.

### **PERMIT CONDITIONS**

West Virginia Code § 22-6-11 allows the Office of Oil and Gas to place specific conditions upon this permit. Permit conditions have the same effect as law. <u>Failure to adhere to the specified permit conditions may result in enforcement action.</u>

#### **CONDITIONS**

- 1. If the operator encounters an unanticipated void, or an anticipated void at an unanticipated depth, the operator shall notify the inspector within 24 hours. Modifications to the casing program may be necessary to comply with W. Va. Code § 22-6-20, which requires drilling to a minimum depth of thirty feet below the bottom of the void, and installing a minimum of twenty (20) feet of casing. Under no circumstance should the operator drill more than fifty (50) feet below the bottom of the void or install less than twenty (20) feet of casing below the bottom of the void.
- 2. Pursuant to 35 CSR § 4-19.1.a, at the request of the surface owner all water wells or springs within 1000 feet of the proposed well that are actually utilized for human consumption, domestic animals or other general use shall be sampled and analyzed.
- 3. Pursuant to 35 CSR § 4-19.1.c, if the operator is unable to sample and analyze any water well or spring within one thousand (1,000) feet of the permitted well location, the Office of Oil and Gas requires the operator to sample, at a minimum, one water well or spring located between one thousand (1,000) feet and two thousand (2,000) feet of the permitted well location.
- 4. All pits must be lined with a minimum 30 mil thickness synthetic liner.

- 1 From exit 99 of I-79 proceed East on U.S. Route 33 & 119 for approximately 11.9 miles.
- 2 Take Buckhannon/Philippi Rt. 20 Exit off of U.S. Route 33 & 119.
- 3 Turn right on State Route 20 and follow for approximately 2.3 miles.
- 4 Turn left on County Route 9 (Tallmansville Road) and follow for approximately 3.4 miles.
- 5 Turn left on existing well access road flagged in orange and pink ribbon and follow for approximately 0.1 miles.
- 6 Turn left on proposed road following edge of field and follow for approximately 0.1 miles to proposed Roessing Well No.1/WV0457.

#### 12) Describe proposed well work in detail:

- 1. Construct the drilling location.
- 2. Drill a 16" hole to approximately 42'.
- 3. Run approximately 42' of 13-3/8" casing and fill around outside of casing with cuttings.
- 4. Drill a 12-1/4" hole to approximately 630'.
- 5. Run approximately 615' of 9-5/8" casing.
- 6. Cement the 9-5/8" casing back to surface.
- 7. Drill an 8-3/4" hole to the approximate depth of 1,825'.
- 8. Run approximately 1,800' of 7" casing.
- 9. Cement the 7" casing back to surface.
- 10. Drill a 6-1/4" hole to the estimated total depth of approximately 7,285'.
- 11. Run approximately 7,285' of 4-1/2" casing.
- 12. Cement the 4-1/2" casing back to a point above the anticipated perforations.
- 13. Perforate the Marcellus Shale formation.

If you have been contacted by the well operator and you have signed a "voluntary statement of no objection" to the planned work described in these materials, then the permit may be issued at any time.
Comments must be in writing. Your comments must include your name, address and telephone number, the well operator's name and well number and the approximate location of the proposed well site including district and county from the application. You may add other documents, such as sketches, maps or photographs to support your comments. The Chief has the power to deny or condition a well work permit based on comments on the following grounds:  1) The proposed well work will constitute a hazard to the safety of persons.  2) The soil erosion and sediment control plan is not adequate or effective;  3) Damage would occur to publicly owned lands or resources;  4) The proposed well work fails to protect fresh water sources or supplies;  5) The applicant has committed a substantial violation of a previous permit or a substantial violation of one or more of the rules promulgated under Chapter 22, and has failed to abate or seek review of the violation."

List of Water Testing Laboratories. The Office maintains a list of water testing laboratories which you can hire to test your water to establish water quality prior to and after drilling. Contact the Chief to obtain a copy.

#### NOTICE TO SURFACE OWNERS

The well operator named below is preparing to file for a permit from the state to drill a new well. Before a well work permit can be filed with the Chief of the Office of Oil and Gas, the well operator is required to have given notice of the right to request water well or spring analytical testing. This notice shall be given to the owners or occupants of land which have a water well or spring being utilized for human consumption, domestic animals, or other general use and which is located within 1000 feet of the proposed well site.

It has been brought to my attention that the aforesaid mentioned wells are spotted in an area where we could encounter a mine void. Please see below on our course of action in the event an open mine is encountered while drilling.

Mountain V Oil & Gas, Inc. would like to take this time to inform you that if in fact we encounter a mine void during the drilling of these particular wells then we will take the following actions:

- Run mine string to TD
- Balance cement to shut off bottom using Class A cement with 3% cacl2 50% excess
- Place cement basket above mine or void fill basket to surface down outside of casing to surface
- Class A cement 3% cacl2
