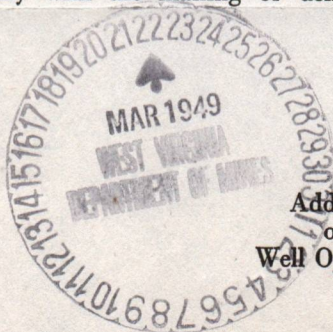

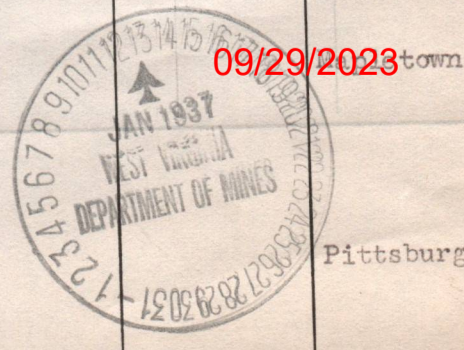

- Fill with clay 600 - 425

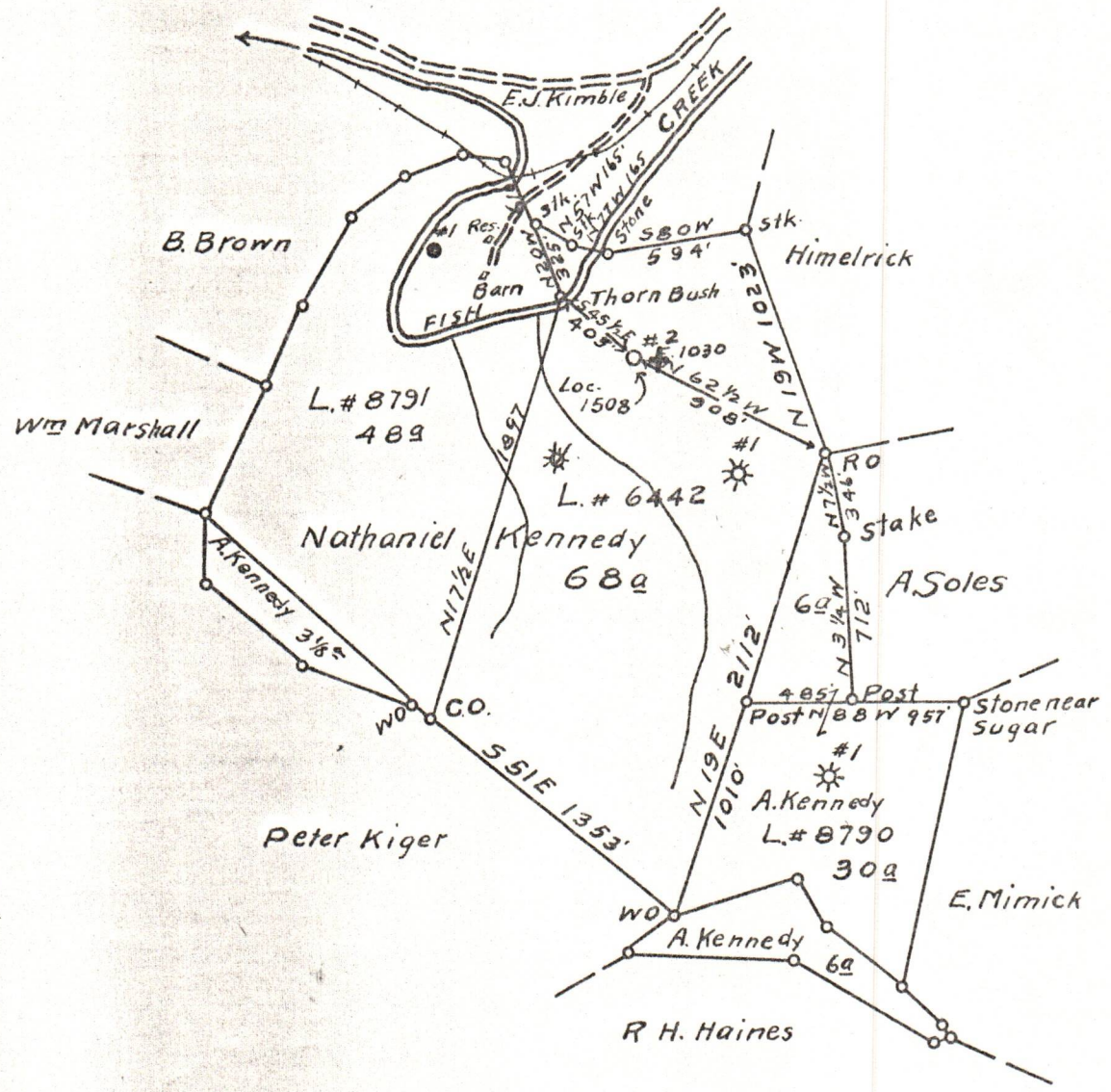
