Install permanent bridge at 2690'-fill to 2310'-place a suitable plug, remove 6-5/8" casing, fill to 2100' and place suitable plugs and remove 8 1/2" casing.

Install permanent bridge at 1875'-fill with mud, clay or cavings to 1650' and place a cement or other suitable plug.
