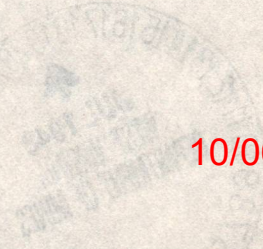

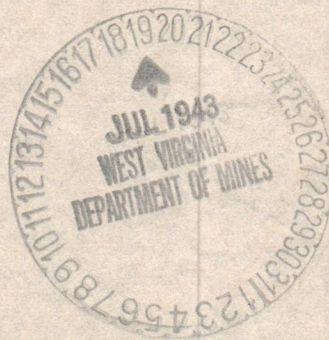

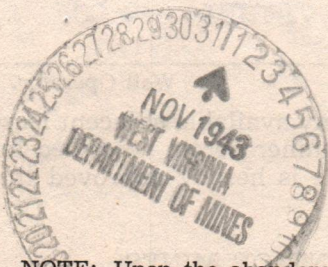

Wood plug 2580' - 2577' - (in "hard" sand)
Neat cement 2577' - 2567' - sealing Gordon Stray.

Set a permanent bridge at 2027' - in bottom of Big Injun.
One sack neat cement on bridge.
Fill with red clay or other non-porous material to 1782'
As 6-5/8" casing is lifted (1782')
Drive wood plug on casing seat (since this is a new well).
Neat cement 1779' - 1769' - sealing hole in Big Lime.
Remove all of 6-5/8" casing.

Set a permanent bridge at 1380' - top of Second Salt Sand, and 34' below water in First Sand
One sack neat cement on bridge.

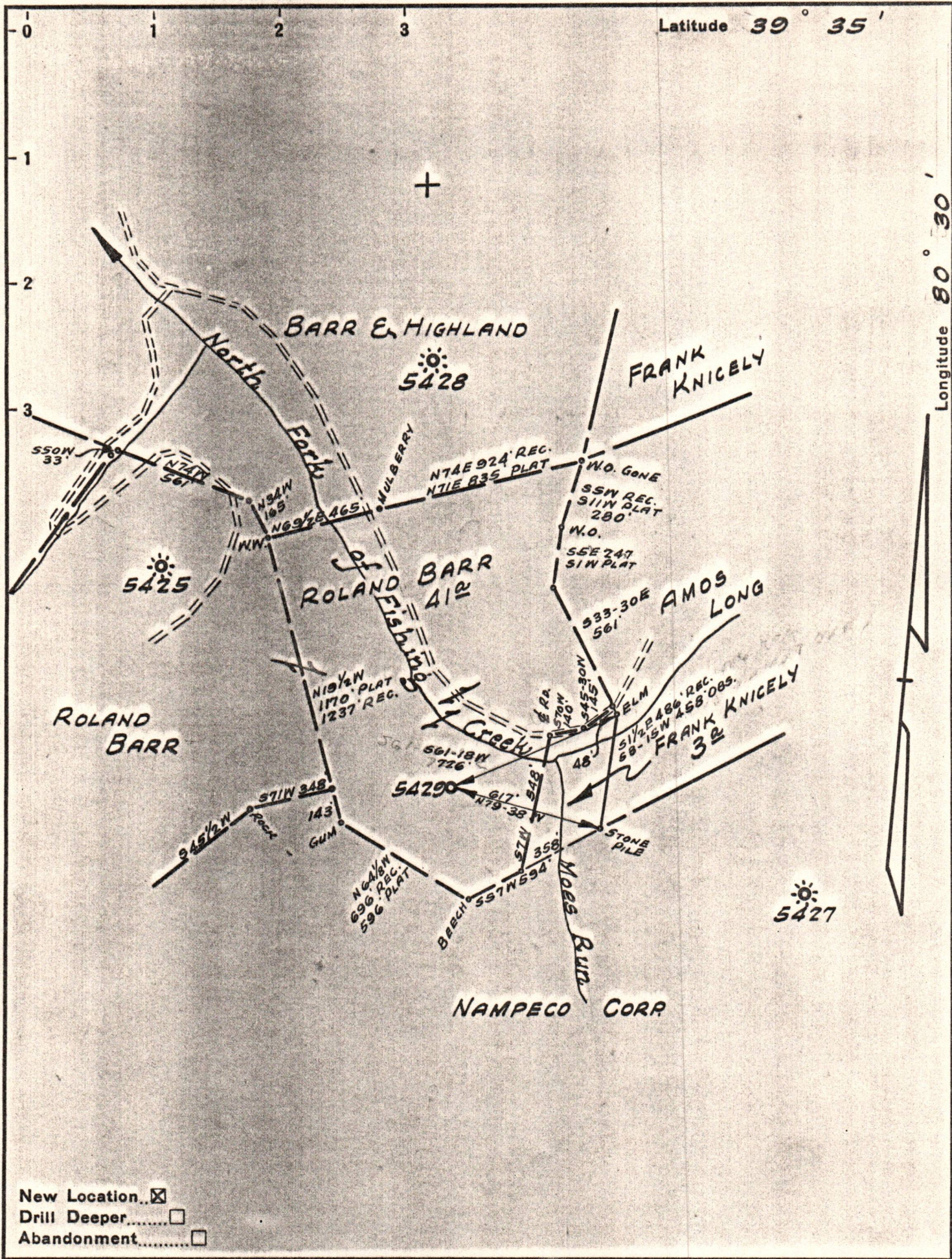
