Well drilled in 1924 by Rockport Oil & Gas Co., Denver, W. Va.,
and sold to Denver Oil & Gas Co., July 12, 1930.

Elevation, 940' B.

1 1/2" conductor, 16'; 10" casing, 158'; 8 1/2", 1102'; 6-5/8", 1925'.

No packer.

Coal was encountered at 750-755'.

Liner was put in from 283 1/4 to 208 1/4', in three sections of 250 feet
each. Well first produced gas from Big Injun and was later
drilled to Gordon.

Abandonment reported to Dept. of Mines Aug. 29, 1934.

Well was shot at 2815-2825'.

Salt water at 1760', one bailer per hour.

Producing a little oil and gas.
