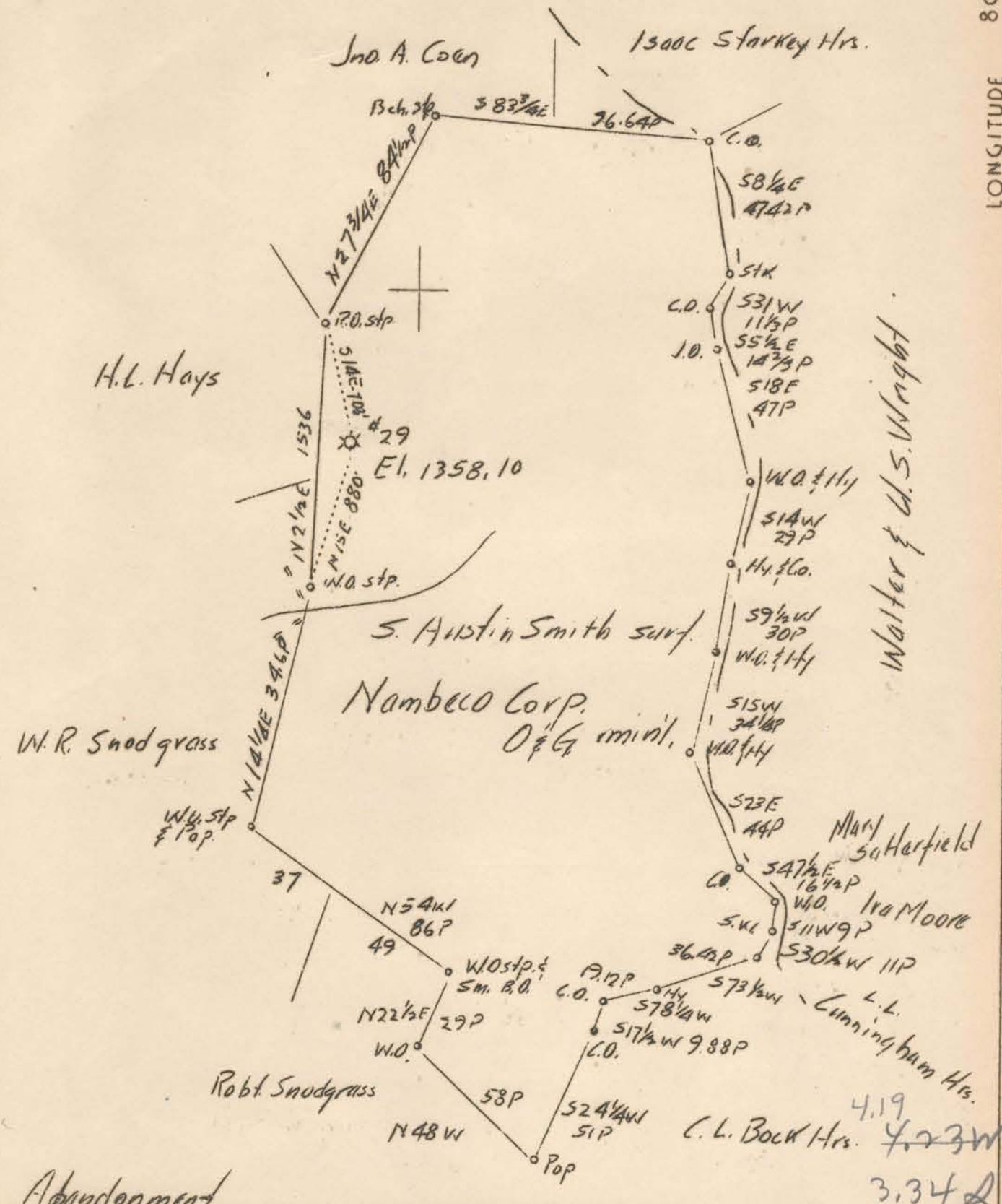

WELL LOCATION MAP

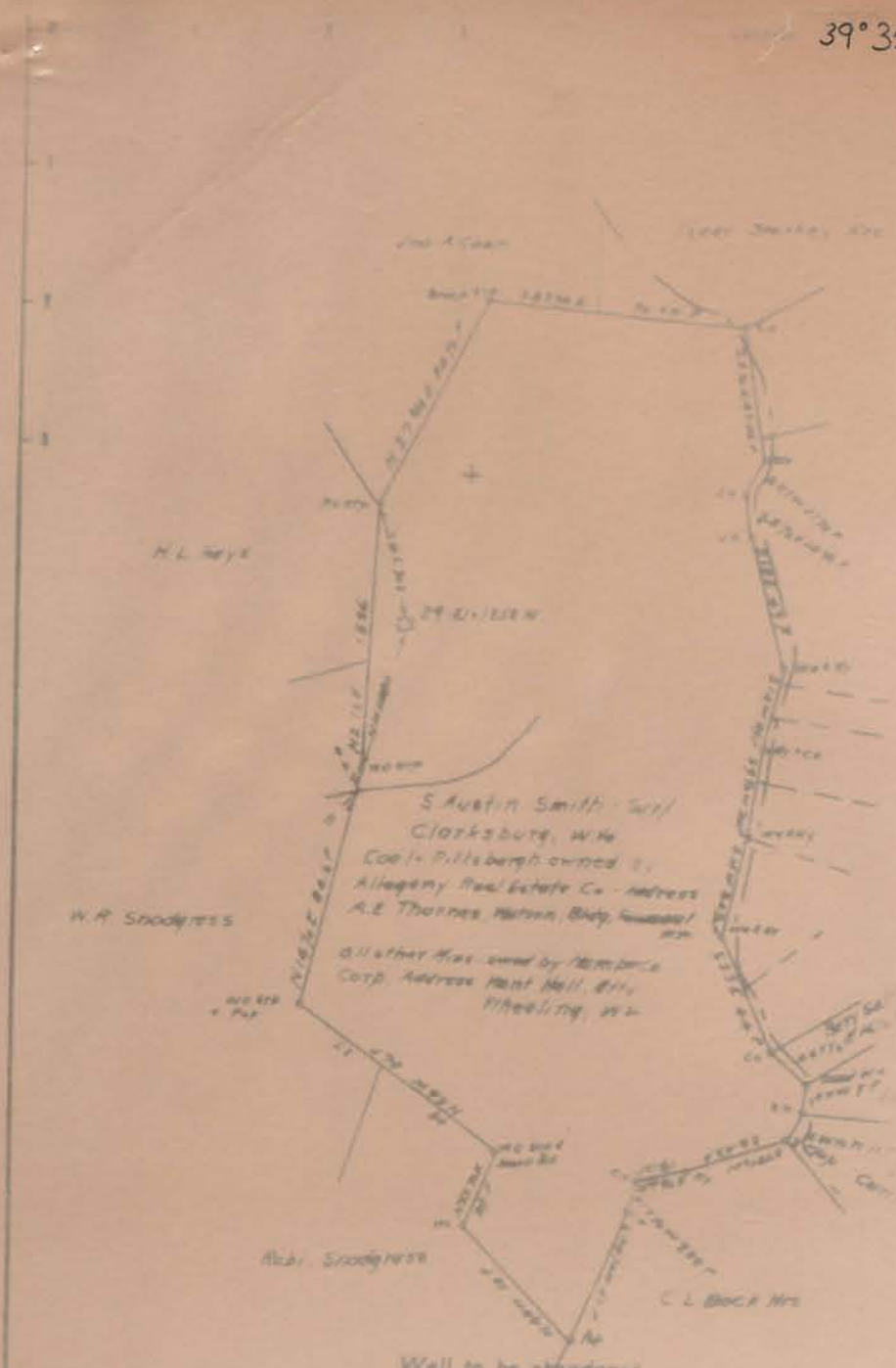

AFFIDAVIT

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by South Penn Oil Company as operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was completed on the

10th day of September 1937 and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which said well was plugged:

Total depth 3330'. 6-3/16" casing would not pull, and was cut at 3239' pulled, leaving 41' in hole below out. Filled with stone and red clay to 3274'. Set 5-3/16" wood plug at 3274' to 3171'. Set cement plug at 3271' to 3261'. Filled with stone and red clay to 3208'. Set 6-5/8" wood plug at 3208' to 3205'. Set cement plug at 3205' to 3195'. Filled with stone and red clay to 3150'. 6-5/8" casing would not pull, and was cut at 3130', and found that it would pull. Filled with stone and red clay to 3130'. Set 6-5/8" wood plug at 3130' to 3127'. Set cement plug at 3127' to 3117'. Filled with stone and red clay to 3117'. Set 6-5/8" wood plug at 3117' to 3107'. Set cement plug at 3107' to 3097'. Filled with stone and red clay to 3097'. Set 6-5/8" wood plug at 3097' to 3077'. Set cement plug at 3077' to 3067'. Bridged hole at 3014'. Filled with stone and red clay to 1214'. (Pittsburgh Coal 1160' to 1164'.) Set Morning Glo Packer at 1194' with 80' of 2" perforated pipe below packer, and 1" vent pipe from packer to top of ground. Cemented vent pipe from 1194' to 1140'. Pulled 80' of 6-5/8" casing, leaving 1830' in hole below out. Filled with stone and red clay solid from 1140' to top of ground.

Description of monument: Erected monument at top of ground with closed top 2" perforated nipple in accordance with rule 18, 1931 regulations.
NOTE:- 270' of 10" casing and 600' of 6-1/4" casing was pulled when well was drilled, leaving 1110' of 6-1/4" casing in hole.
