When this well was drilled in, it made 5 bbls. of water per hour. The oil varied greatly, some days she made 2 bbls., other days, 4 to 6 bbls. When we stopped pumping her on the 29th March after 6 weeks continuous pumping, she was producing 1/2 bbl. of very light oil which evaporated like gasoline, 1 bbl. water per hour and a big increase of gas. When drilled in she would make 1 gas light about 2 ft. high from a one-inch pipe. When we quit she would make 3 lights 7 feet high from 1 in. pipe.

This derrick is 17 feet below No. 1 Bonner location and is up Turkey Run about 700 feet from where the run crosses the road side of Fishing Creek.
