Well tested 12/10 Mercury through 2" opening from the Gordon Sand, May 6th, 1919, or 650,000 cu.ft. Well tubed and shut in May 9, 1919. Rock pressure, 24 hours, 500 lbs. Larkin Anchor Packer used 2" x 5" and set at 2727 feet. Anchor below packer 43' 5", perforated one foot below packer for 7 feet.
