Continue to fill with clay from 857' to 773' - 3' below the 6" casing

Drive wood plug from 773' to 770'

PULL 6-5/8" casing and Fill with clay to 700'

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 145'

Fill with clay from 145' to 125'

Drive wood plug from 125' to 122'

PULL 8-1/4" casing and

Fill with clay from 122' to the surface

Erect a marker such as is described in Rule 18, 1931 Regulations.

All be done in a workman-like manner.

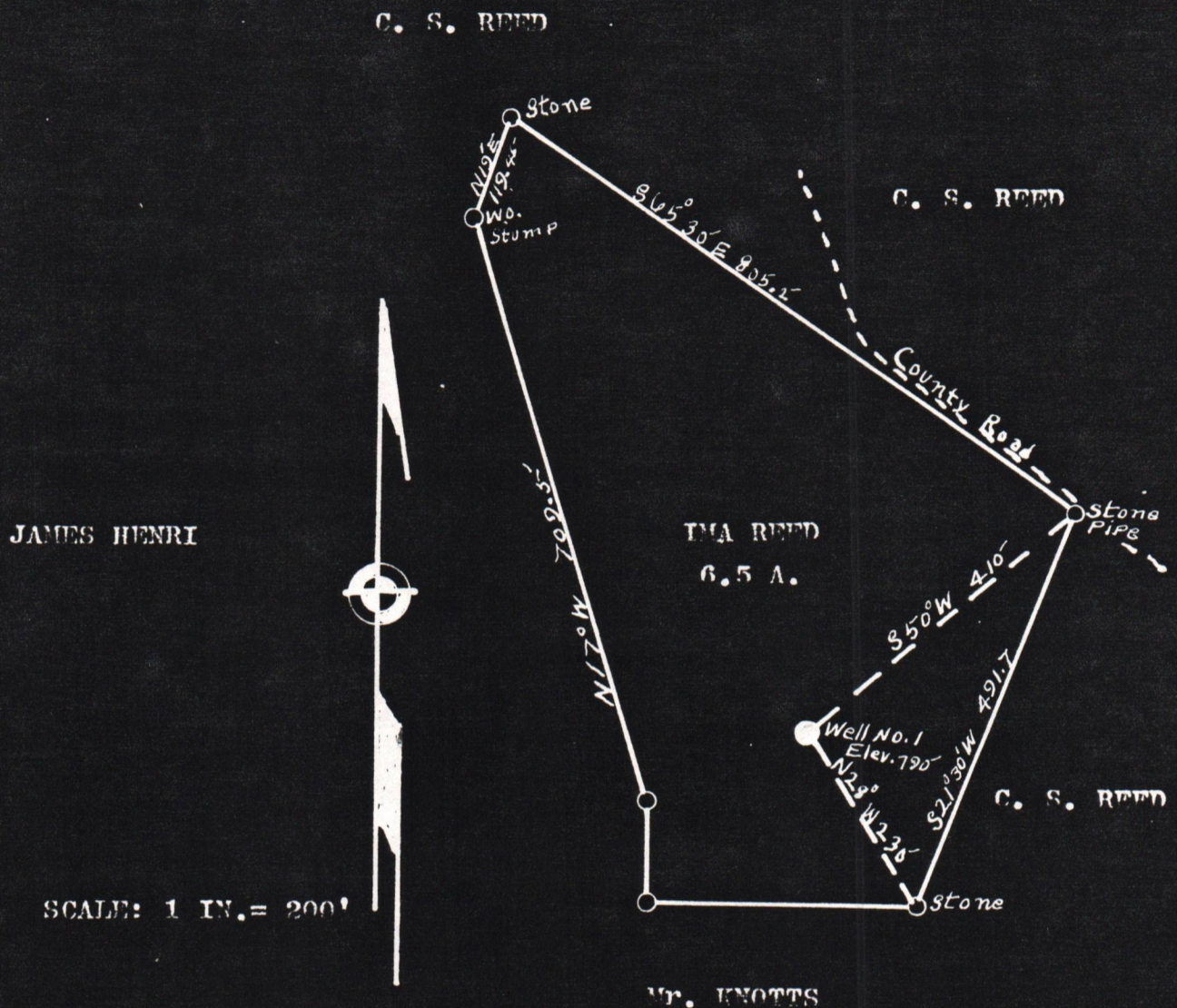
