Fill from bottom hole to 1970 ft. 20 ft. below bottom of Injun sand with non-porous material. Set wooden plug and cement. Pull 6 5/8" casing. Drive tapered plug in reduced hole. Fill with non-porous material to 1704 ft. top of Injun sand. Set plug and cement. Fill with non-porous material to 1180 ft. Pull 8 1/4" casing. Drive tapered plug. Fill with non-porous material to 210 ft. Pull 10 1/2" casing. Fill to top with non-porous material.

WORK ORDER INTERPOSED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES:

Fill the hole from the bottom 2350' with clay to 2009' - 30' below the Big Injun Sand. Drive wood plug from 2009' to 2006' Cement from 2006' to 1996'

Cemented from 1681' to 1671' sealing Big Injun sand. Set a permanent bridge at 1525' - 30' below the salt sand. Filled with clay from 1525' to 1440' - 20' above the salt sand. Cemented from 1440' to 1430' sealing salt sand. Filled with clay from 1430' to 1362'.

Manner in which coal was plugged: 20' above gas sand. Cemented from 1362' to 1352'. Set a permanent bridge at 1201' - 30' below Big Dunkard sand. Filled with clay from 1168' to 1148'. Set a permanent bridge at 425'. Filled with clay from 425' to 200' - 4' below 10" casing. Drove tapered wood plug from 200' to 197'. Pulled 10" casing and filled with clay to surface.

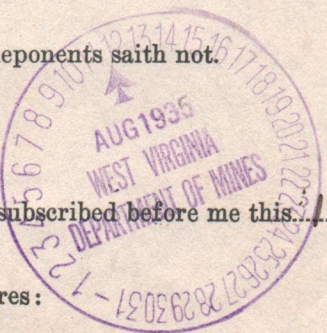

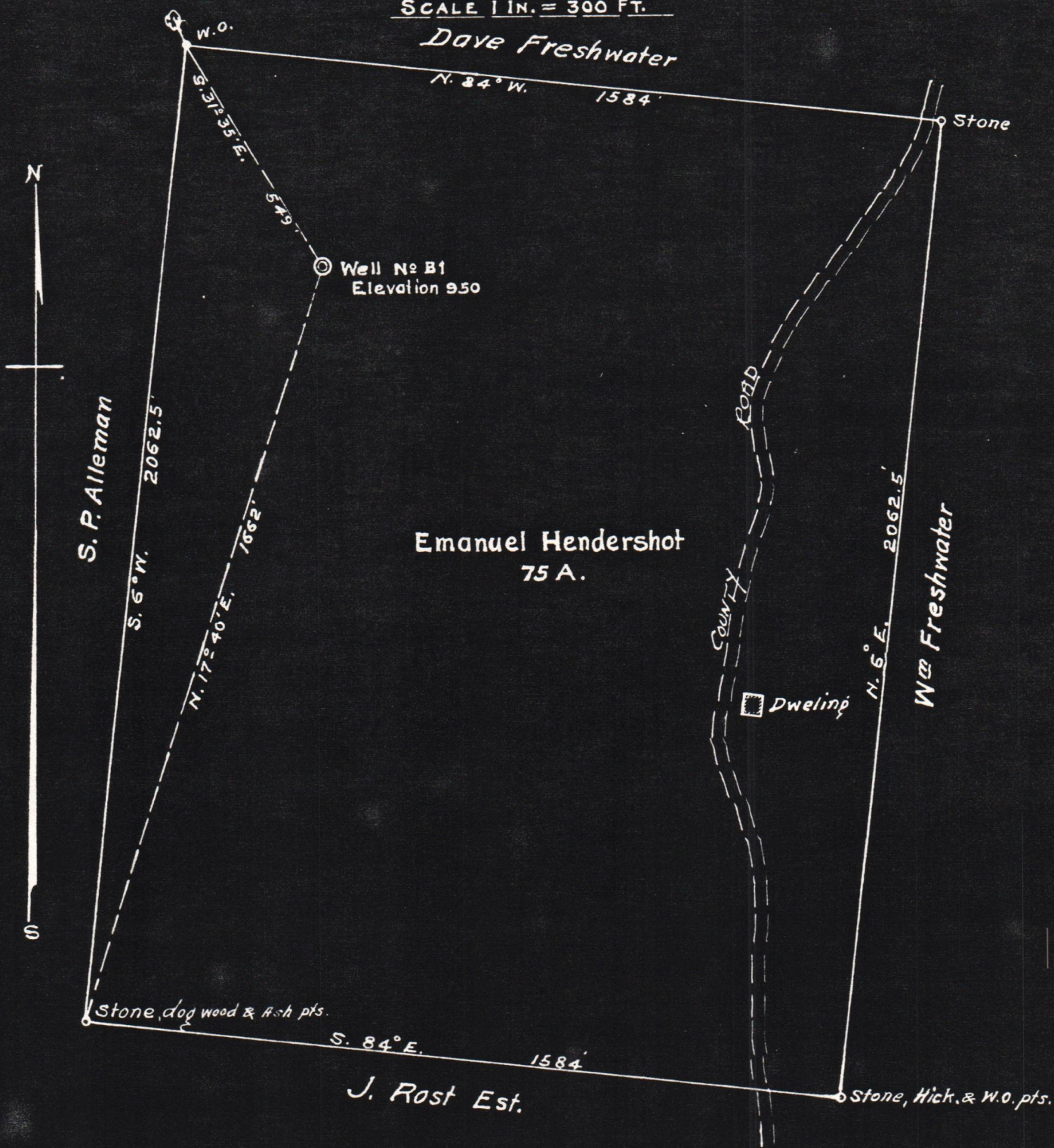
