Diagrammatic cross section of the general lithologic framework of the Acadian clastic wedge showing the relationship of the Price-Rockwell and Catskill delta complexes and the Venango, Bradford, and Elk plays defined in this atlas. The Bradford play represents all the coarse-grained clastic reservoirs occurring between the horizons of maximum regional transgression within the Chadakoin Formation of northern Pennsylvania (equivalent to the informal Warren shale of West Virginia) and the shales just below the Kane sandstone of Pennsylvania (roughly equivalent to the shales immediately overlying the Benson sandstone in northern West Virginia).
