2370	2383	13	Shale, dark-brown, almost black (Sunbury Shale)
2383	2393	10	Sandstone, light-gray, fine, non-calcareous, with strong concentration of pyrite at top (Farea Sandstone); thickness may be a little less than 10 feet, since sample from 2383 to 2393 contains some of the underlying shale

Devonian Shales, 235^{1/2} feet

2393	2408	15	Shale, gray, with gray micaceous siltstone
2408	4661	2253	Shale, gray to black with gray siltstone in upper part; samples not examined in detail
4661	4703	42	Shale, dark-gray, pyritic, slightly calcareous; a little gray limestone in sample from 4683 to 4690'
4703	4745	42	Shale, black, calcareous, pyritic; sample from 4727 to 4735 contains some brown limestone; no sample 4735 to 4745'

Huntersville Chert, 5+ feet

4745	4750	5	Limestone, brown, cherty, containing a little sphalerite; about 10 per cent of siltstone with much biotite
